About DMXzone Slider

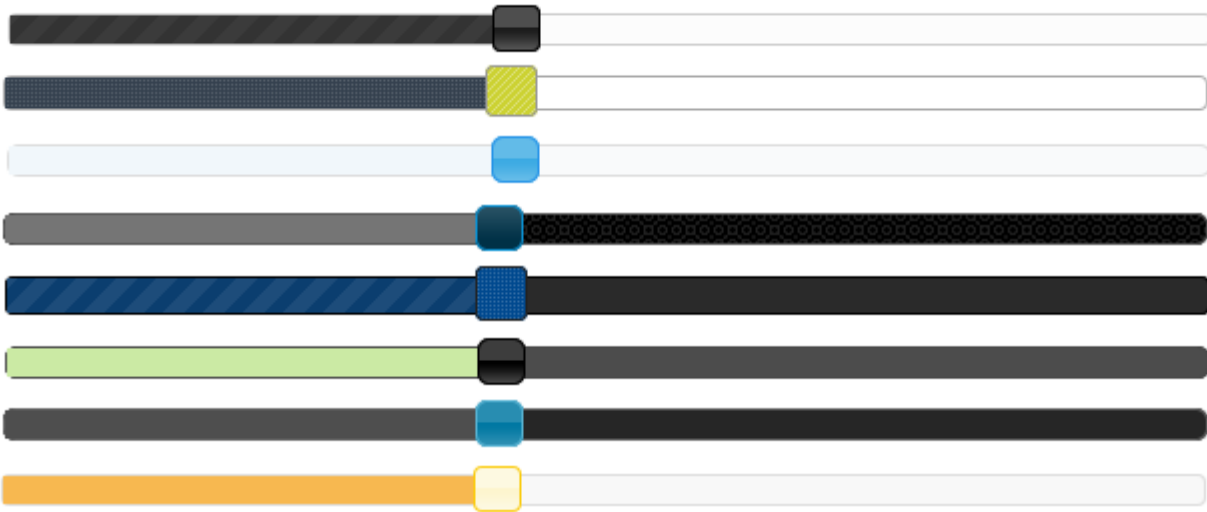
Enrich your website forms with **DMXzone Slider** by adding awesome sliders as user controls for optimal experience, usability and data validation! Select horizontal or vertical orientation and follow the creation process directly in Dreamweaver. It is supplied with 24 CSS designs, fully customizable and easy to select with our built in style picker.

Adding values to your **DMXzone Slider** dynamically is an easy job, just choose them from any dynamic data. Additionally, you can set range option to capture a range of values with two drag handles that can also be stored in hidden fields, when using the slider as form element.

Fully resizable and optimized for touch devices, the DMXzone Slider can control other DMXzone extensions such as [Ajax Datagrid](#), [HTML5 Slideshow](#) and [Advanced CSS Animator](#) through the **Behavior Connector**.

Features in Detail

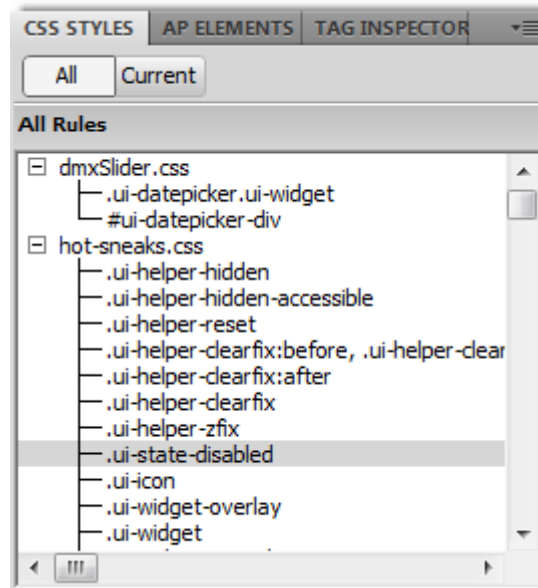
- **24 CSS Designs included** - You can simply choose one of the 24 amazing styles available or edit them through the CSS to fit your website perfectly.



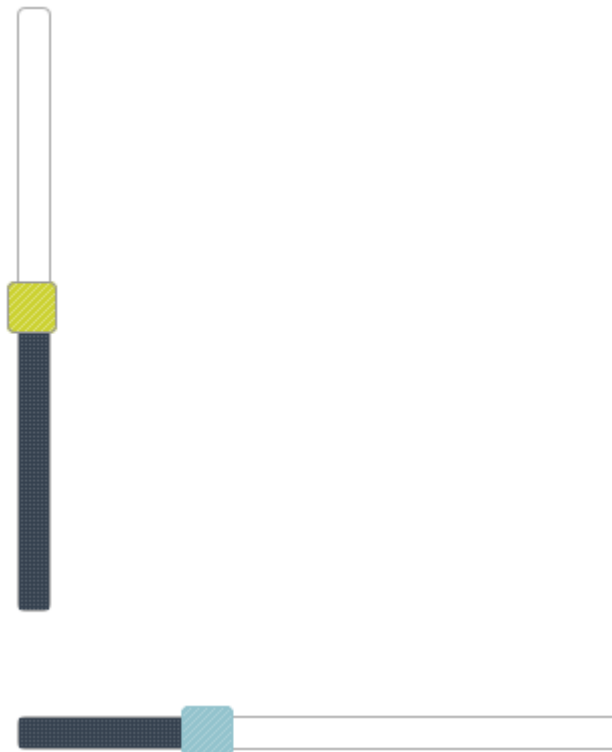
- **Easy to choose style picker** - We've included a style picker where you can see a preview of the chosen design.



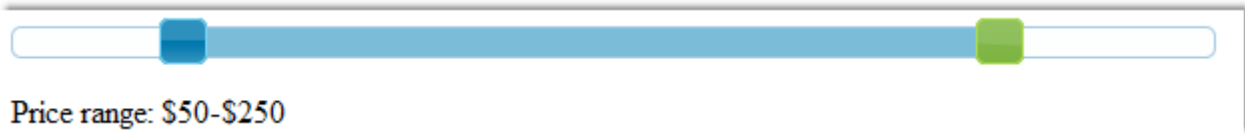
- **Fully customizable styles** - Our slider is CSS based so you can easily make your own adjustments in the CSS from within Dreamweaver's CSS editor.



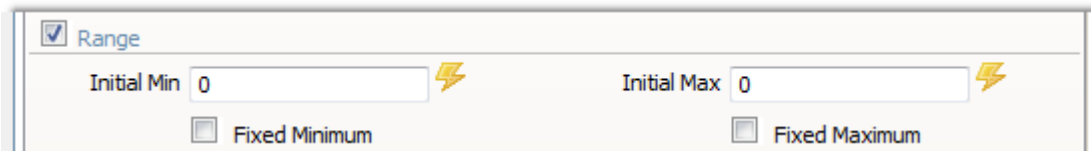
- **Horizontal and Vertical sliders** - Change the orientation of the slider to horizontal or vertical your choice.



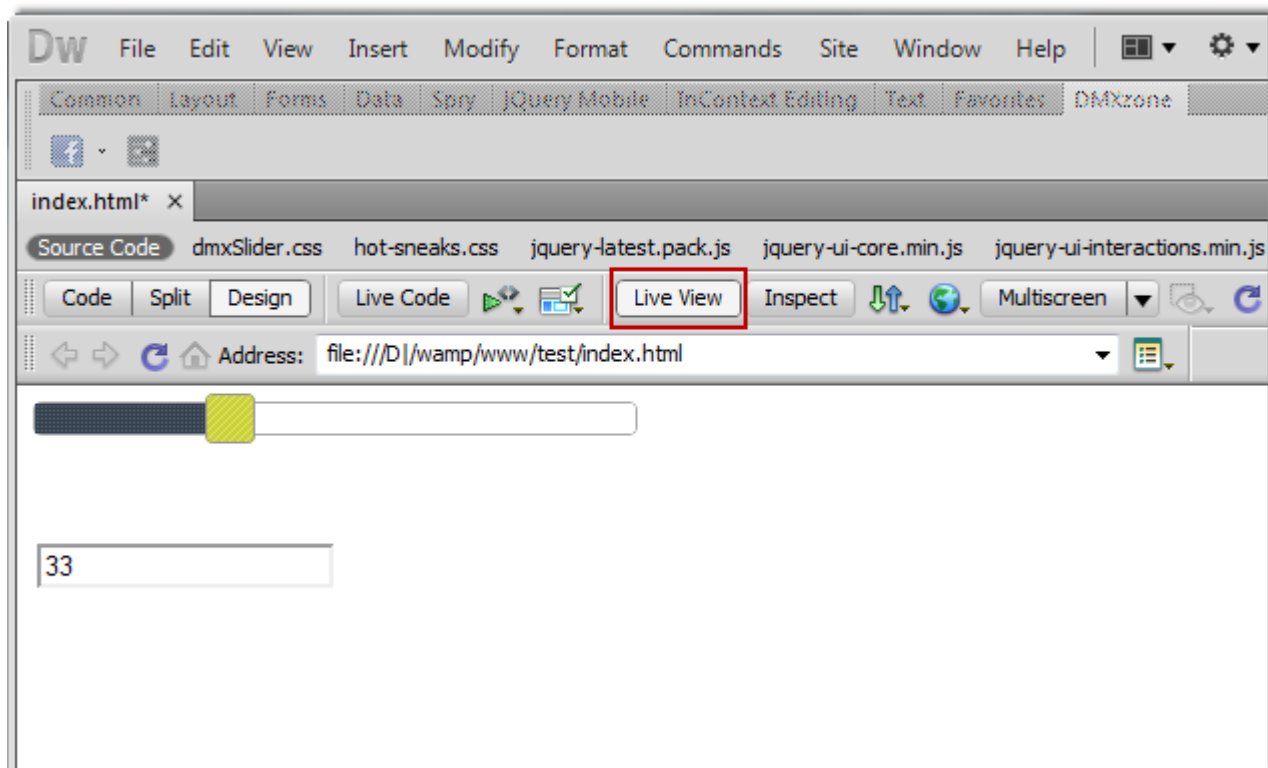
- **Range slider** - Set the range option to capture a range of values with two drag handles. The space between the handles is filled with a different background color to indicate that those values are selected.



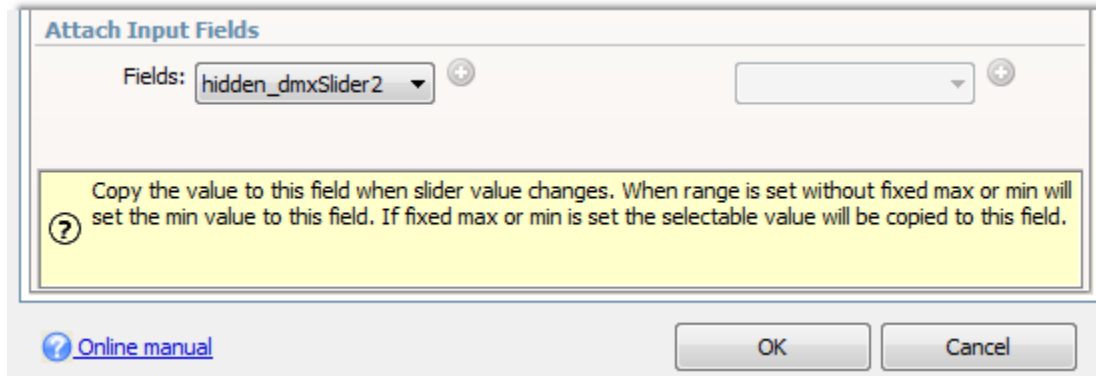
- **Range slider with fixed minimum** - Set the range minimum so your users can only select value to the maximum.
- **Range slider with fixed maximum** - Set the range maximum so your users can only select a minimum value.



- **The slider can be navigated in Dreamweaver Live view!** Note that this feature requires Dreamweaver CS3+



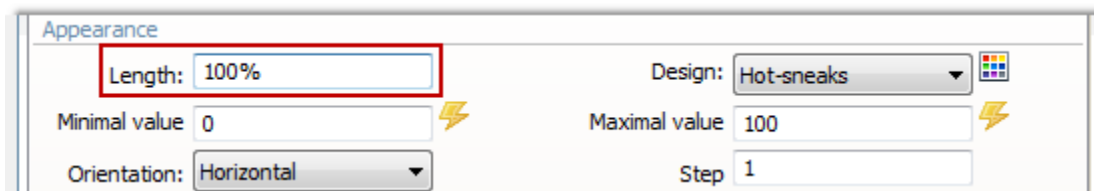
- **Bind slider values to hidden fields** - It allows you to automatically assign values to and from the slider to specified hidden fields. Very useful when using the slider as form element and saving the output to a database with for example insert or update record server behavior.



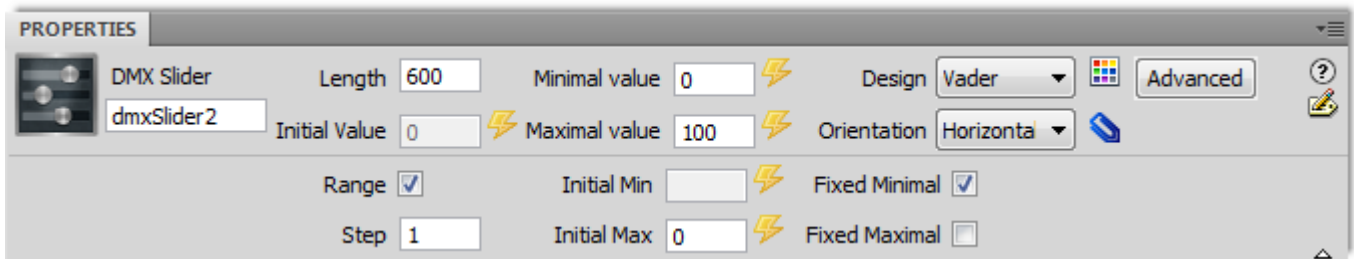
- **Dynamic slider** - Add values to your DMXzone Slider dynamically! Choose min and max value from any recordset.



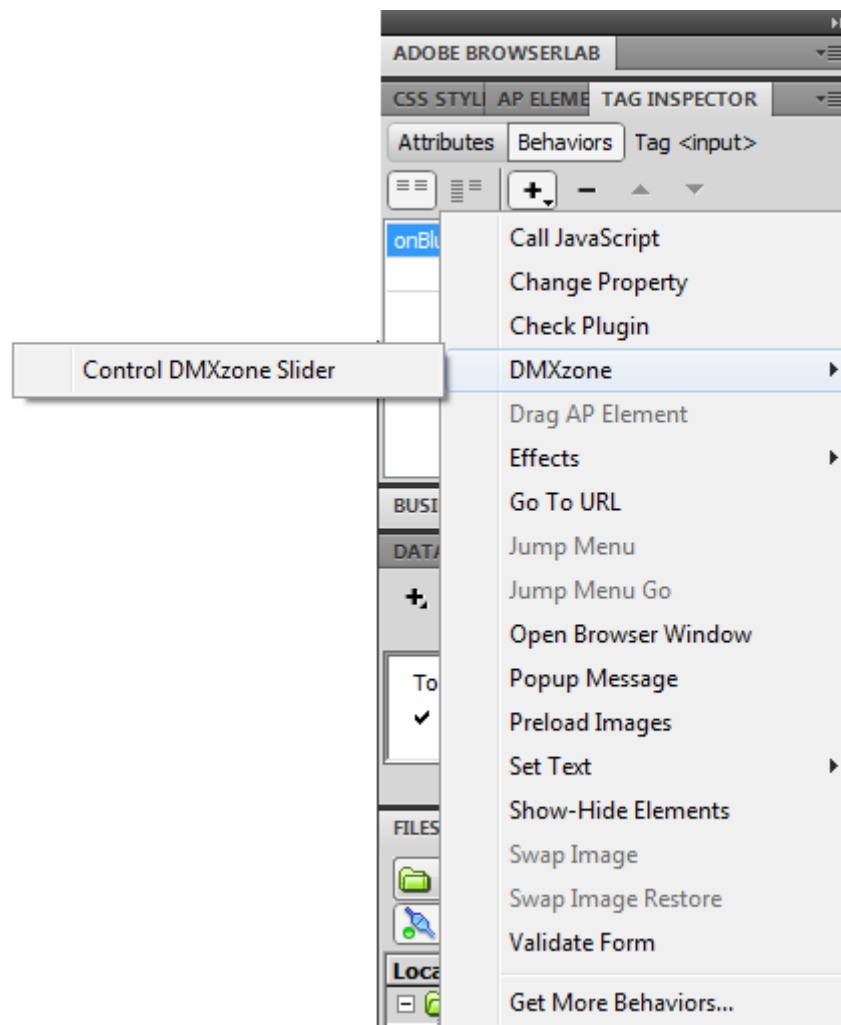
- **Fully resizable** - The length of the slider expands depending on the container that it's in if set to 100% but also it can be set manually.

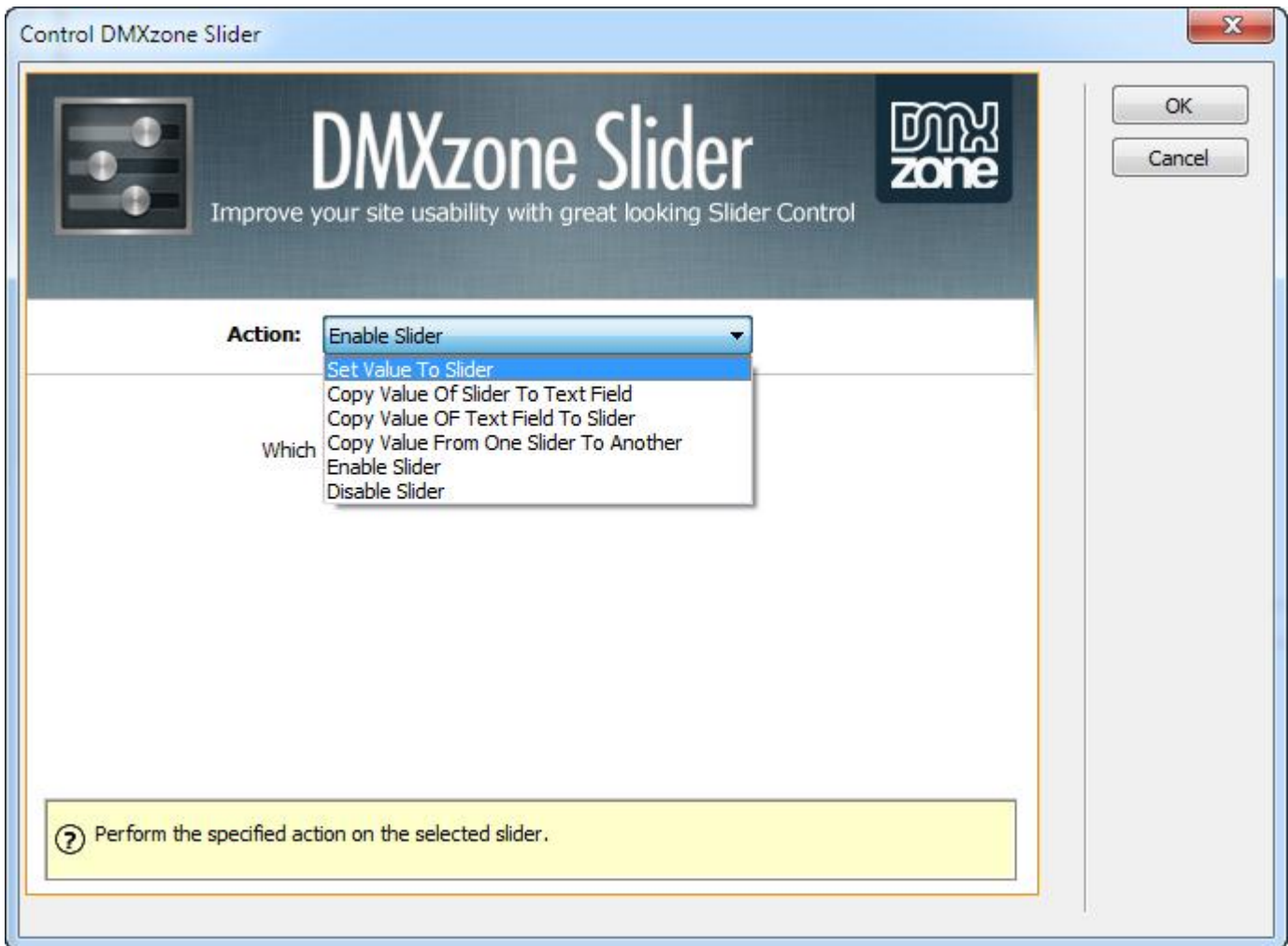


- **Optimized for Touch devices** - Now you can drag the slider with your thumb on touch devices like iPad and iPhone and it will respond directly!
- **Inline property inspector** - You can easily change all the visual options later on

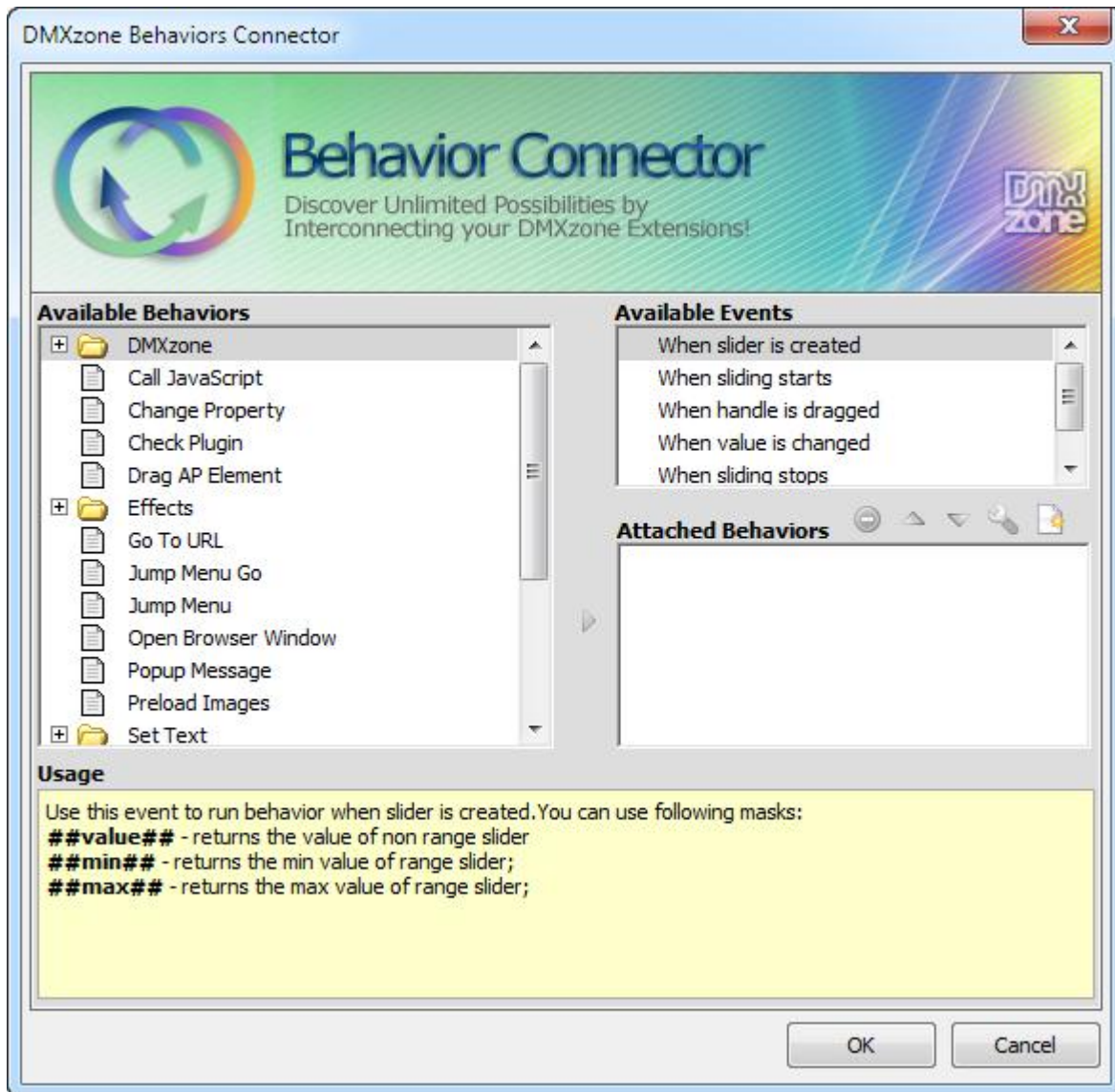


- **Fully controllable by behaviors** - If you want to enable/disable the slider, set value, copy value of slider to text field and more - it can be easily done with the Control DMXzone Slider behavior.





- **Full support for the DMXzone Behavior Connector** - You can easily bind other DMXzone extensions like Advanced CSS Animator, Sliding Billboard, HTML5 MP3 player and Universal CSS Transforms to your slider.

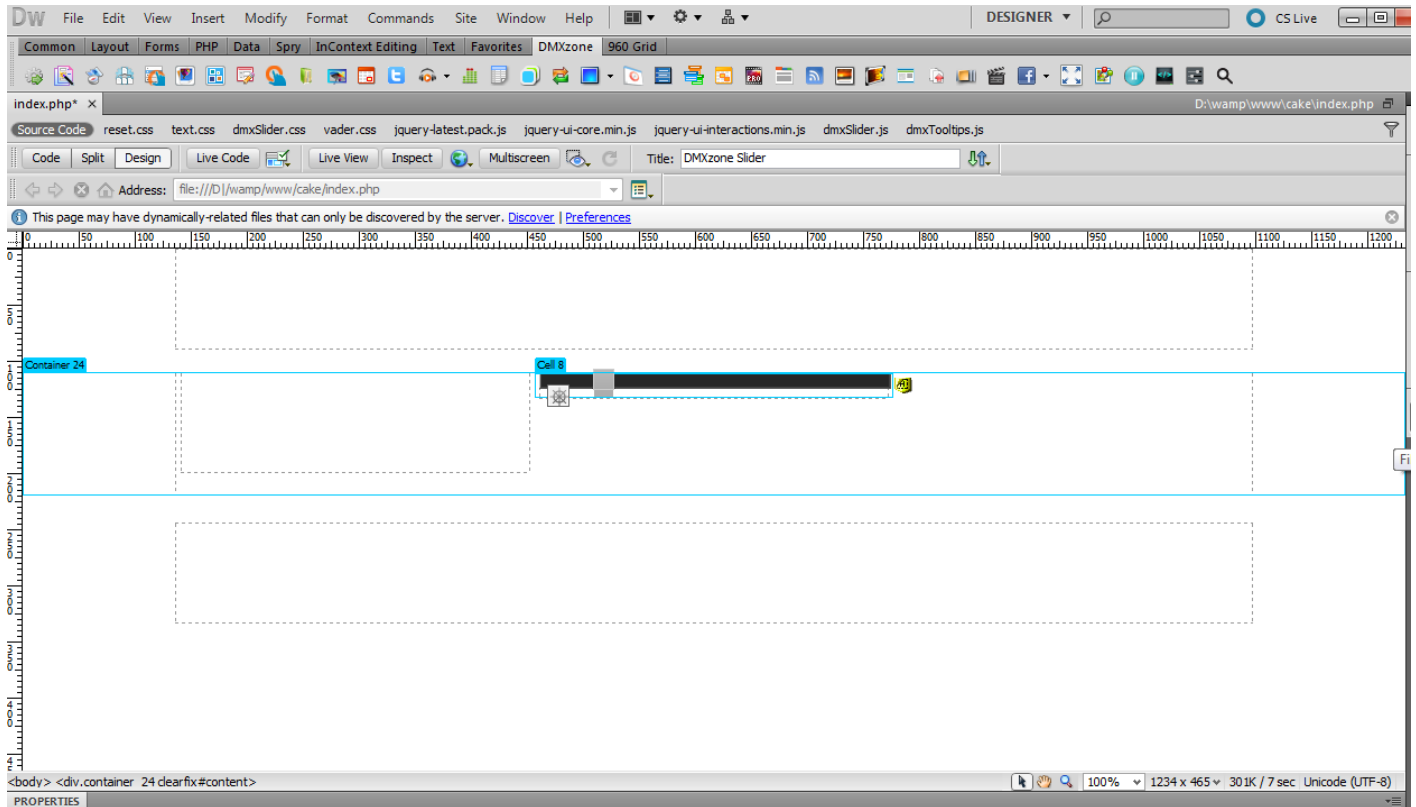

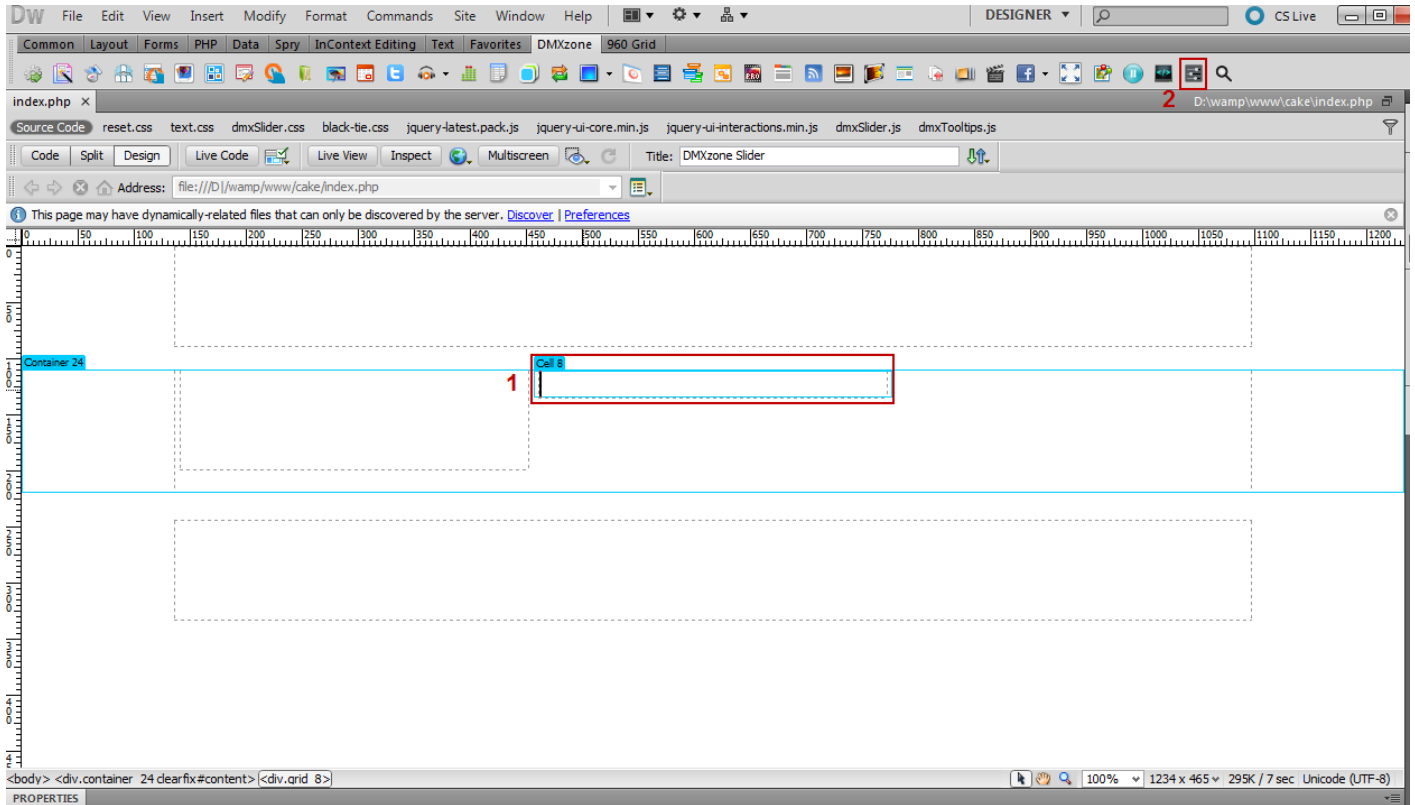

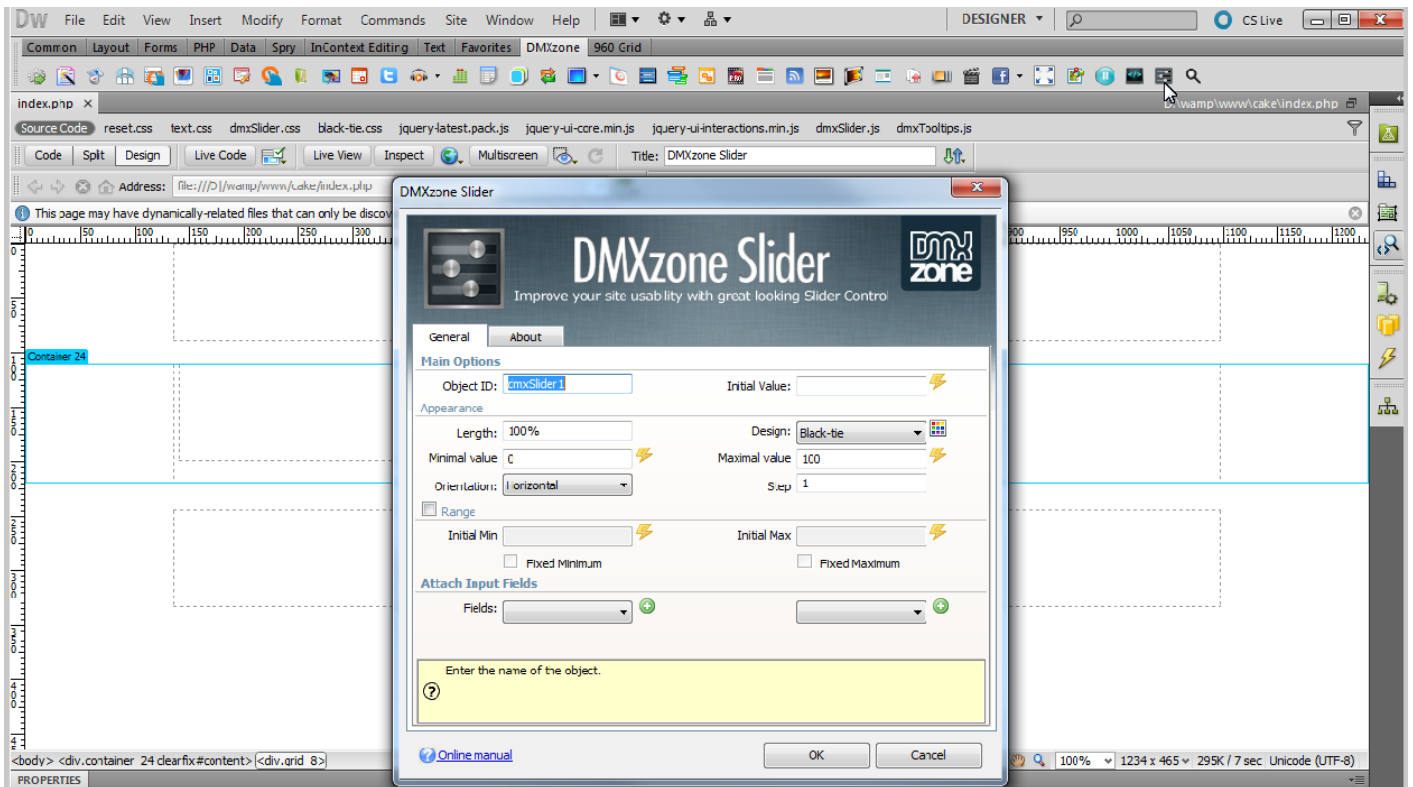


How to do it

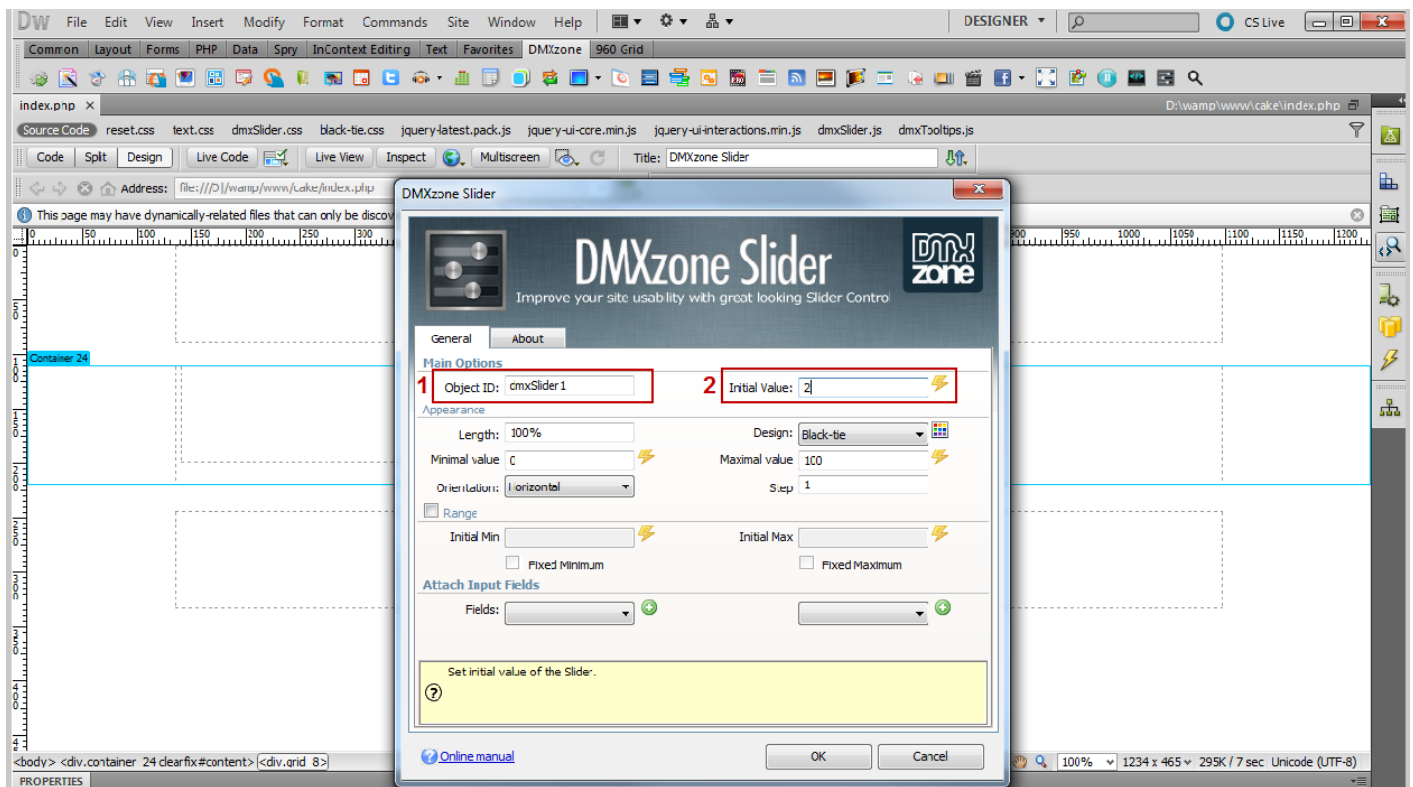
1. We've already created our page layout. In order to insert the **DMXzone Slider**, click **(1)** on **your page** and **hit (2)** the **DMXzone Slider icon**.



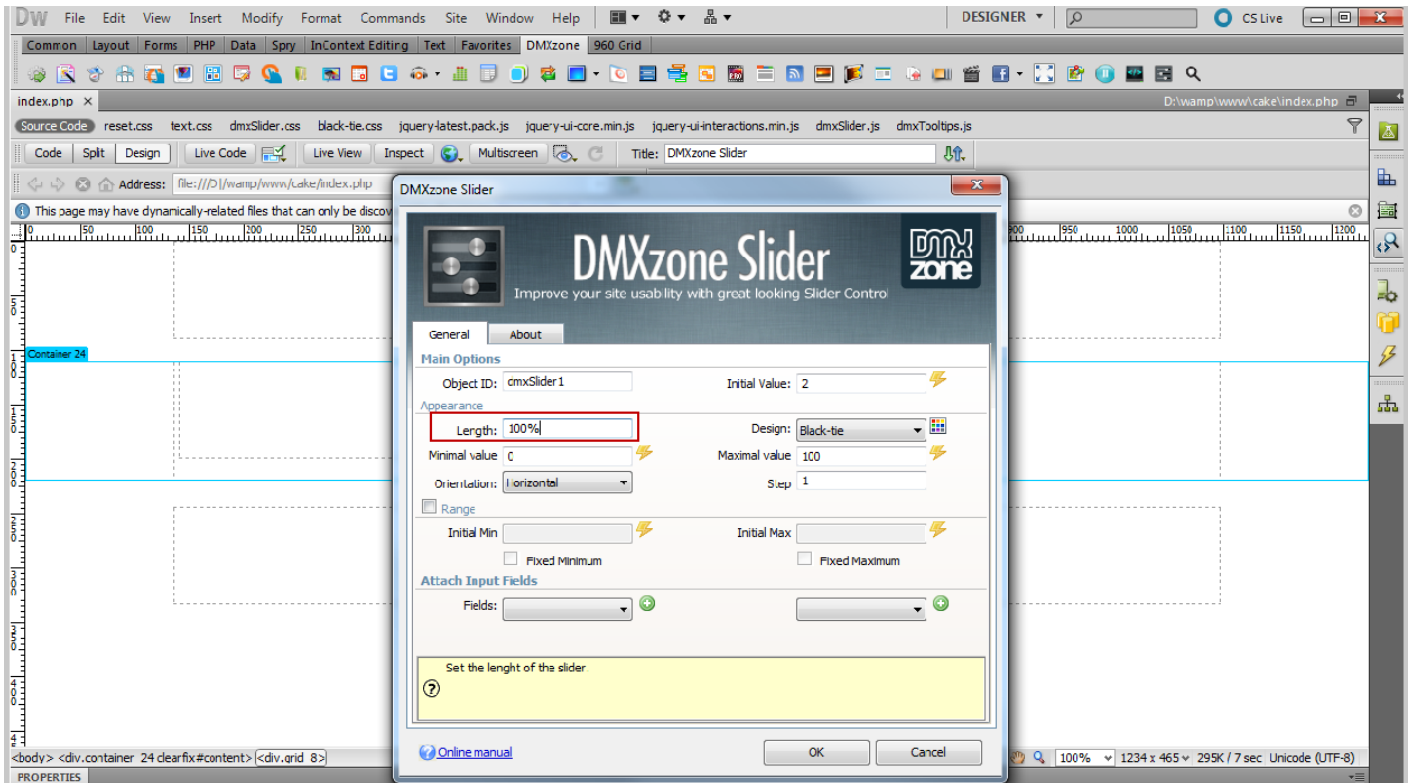
2. The **DMXzone Slider** window opens.



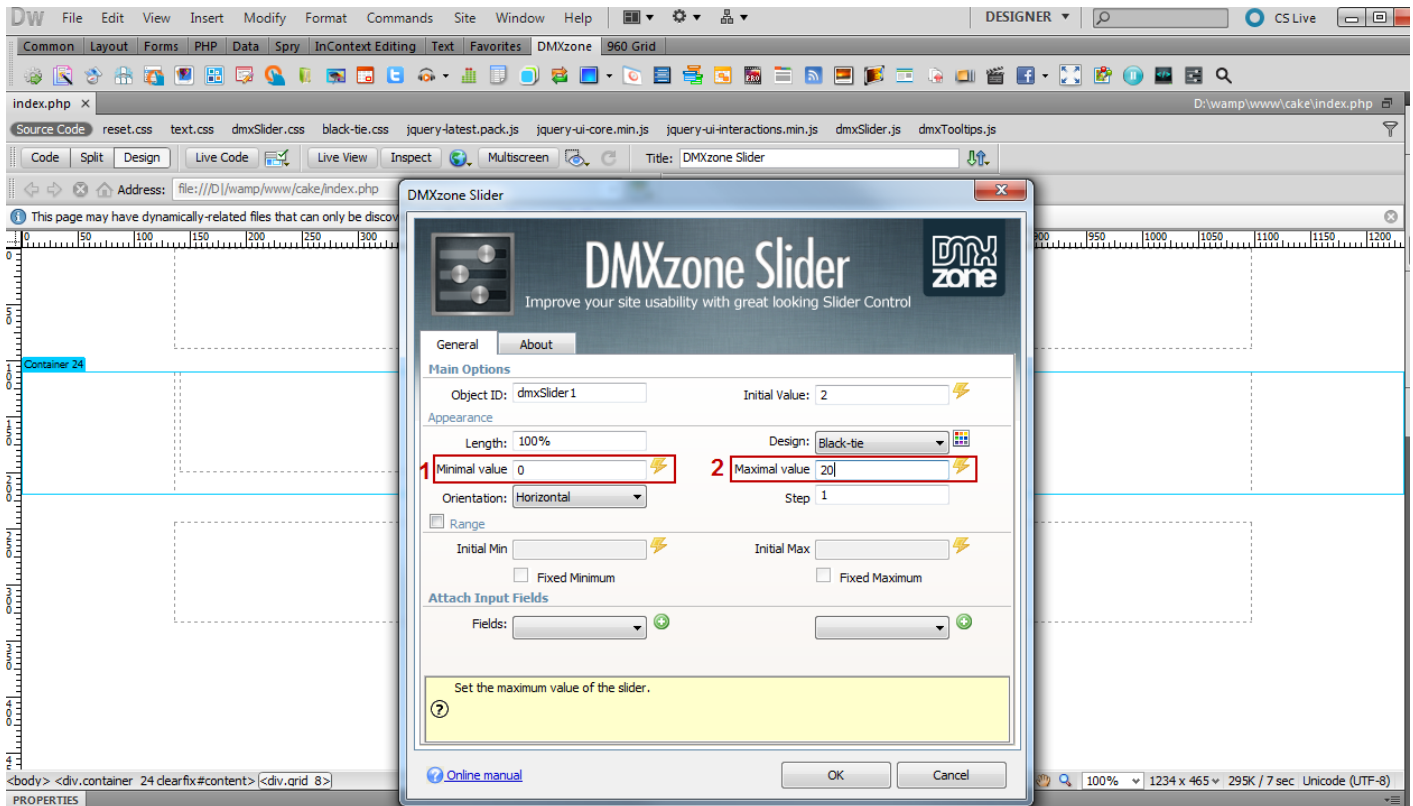
- For our tutorial we will **use the default ID (1)** for our Slider and will set the **Initial value to 2 (2)**. You can leave this field blank if you want your initial value to be 0.



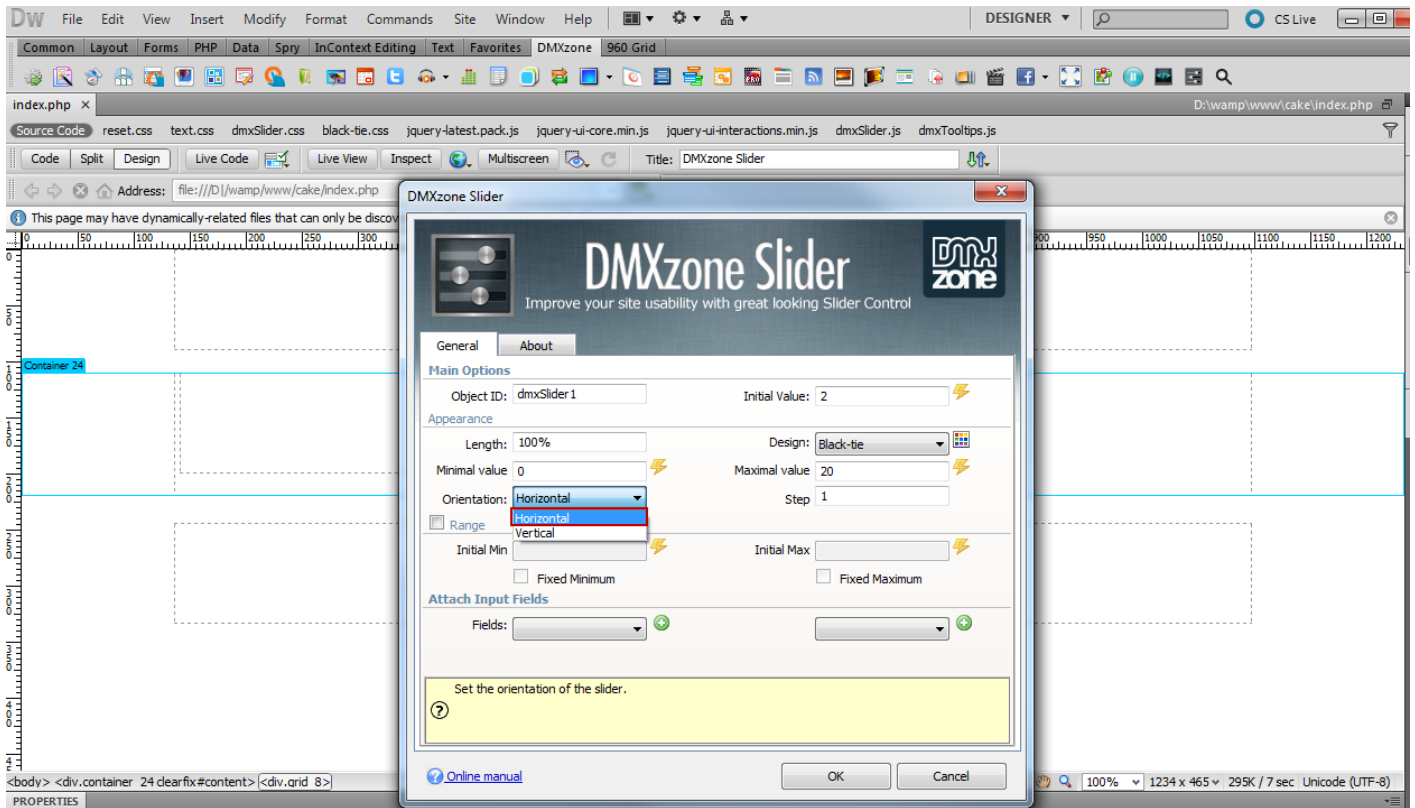
- Use numbers in order to **specify the size** in pixels: 150 or percent for percent: 100%. We'll leave the length at **100%**.



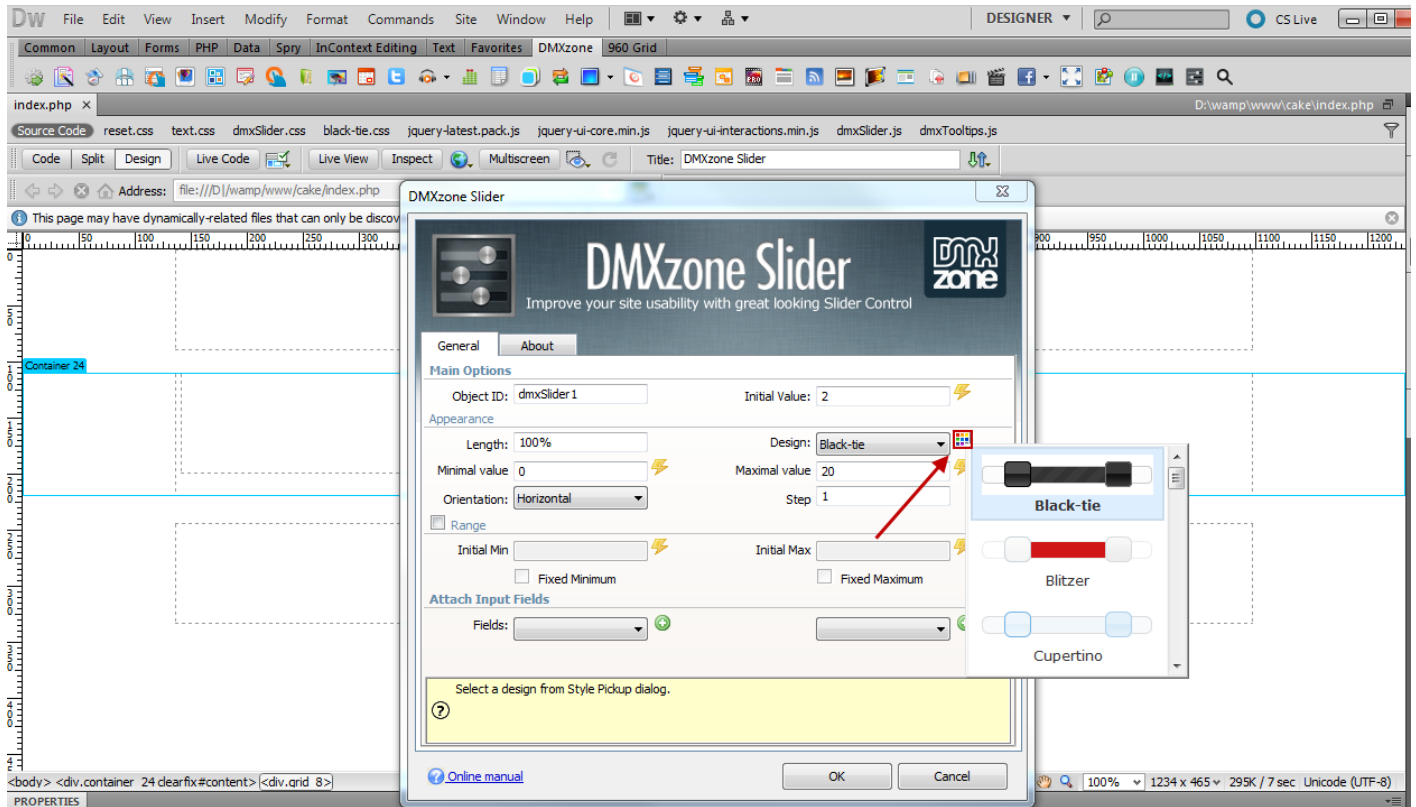
5. The **minimal value** is set at 0 **(1)** and the **maximal** we change at 20 **(2)**.



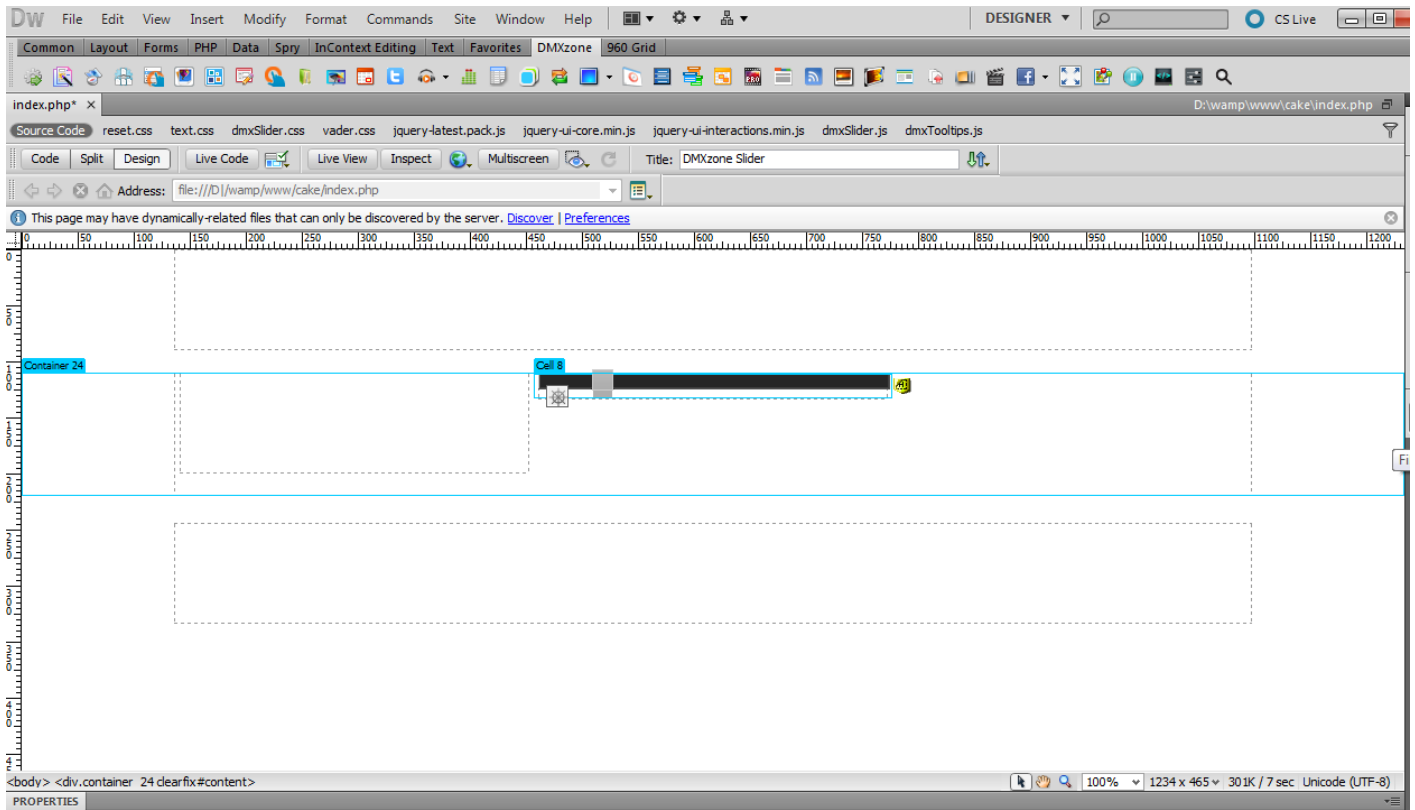
- The **DMXzone Slider** orientation can be horizontal or vertical. For our tutorial we choose the **horizontal** one.



- Choose one of the **predefined designs** packed in the **DMXzone Slider** that matches your website design perfectly. For the design preview, **click the style picker**. Click the OK button when you're done.



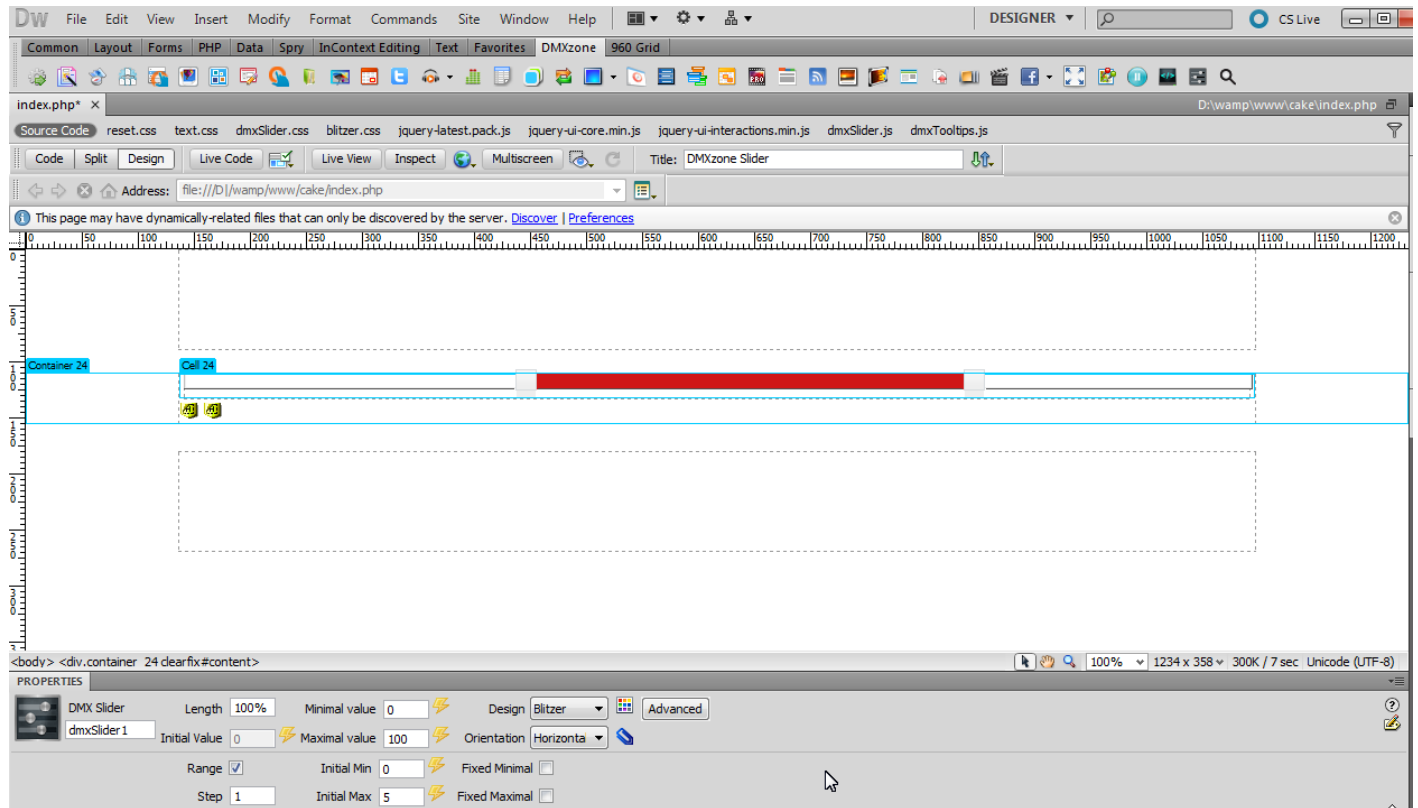
- This is how easily you can add a **DMXzone Slider** on your page. Now you can save your work and preview the result in your browser.

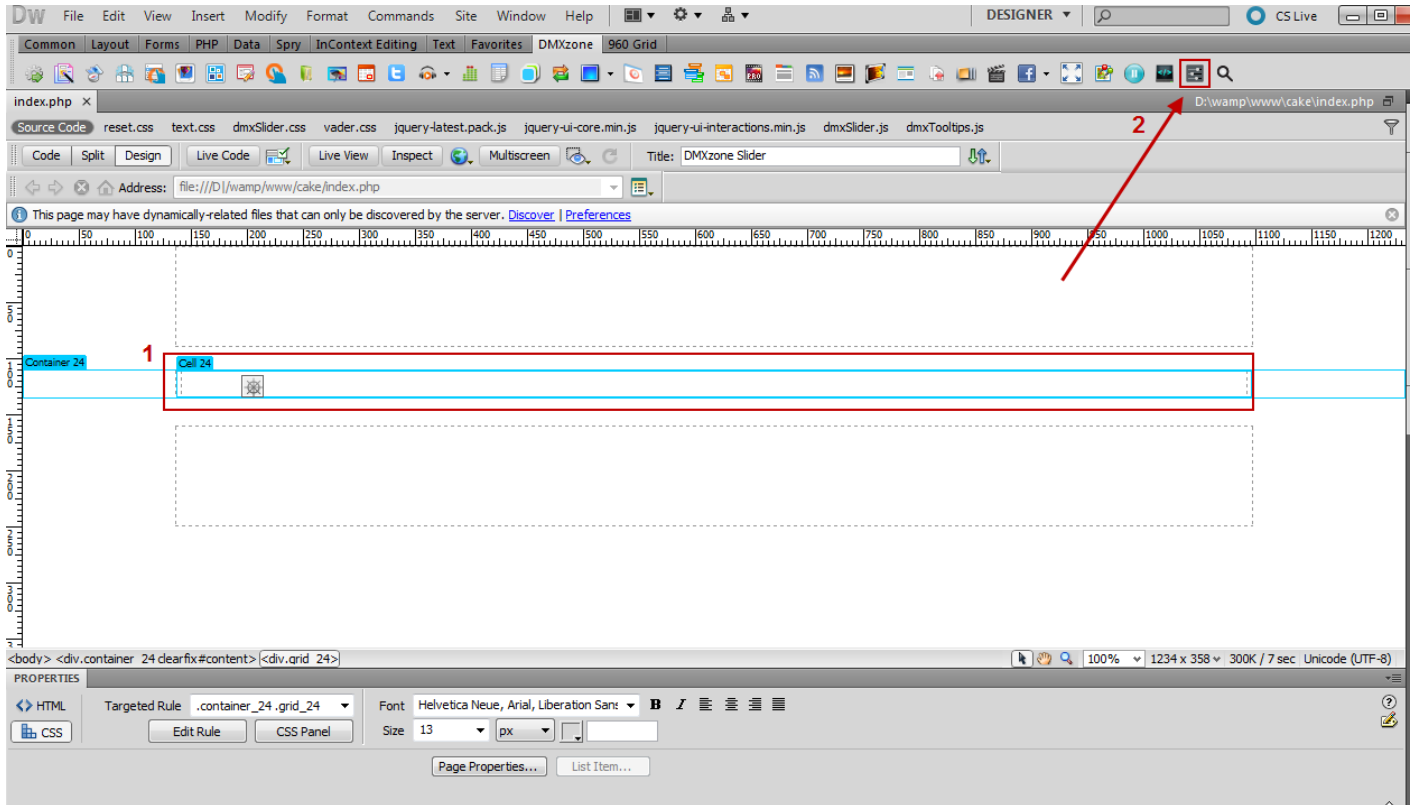

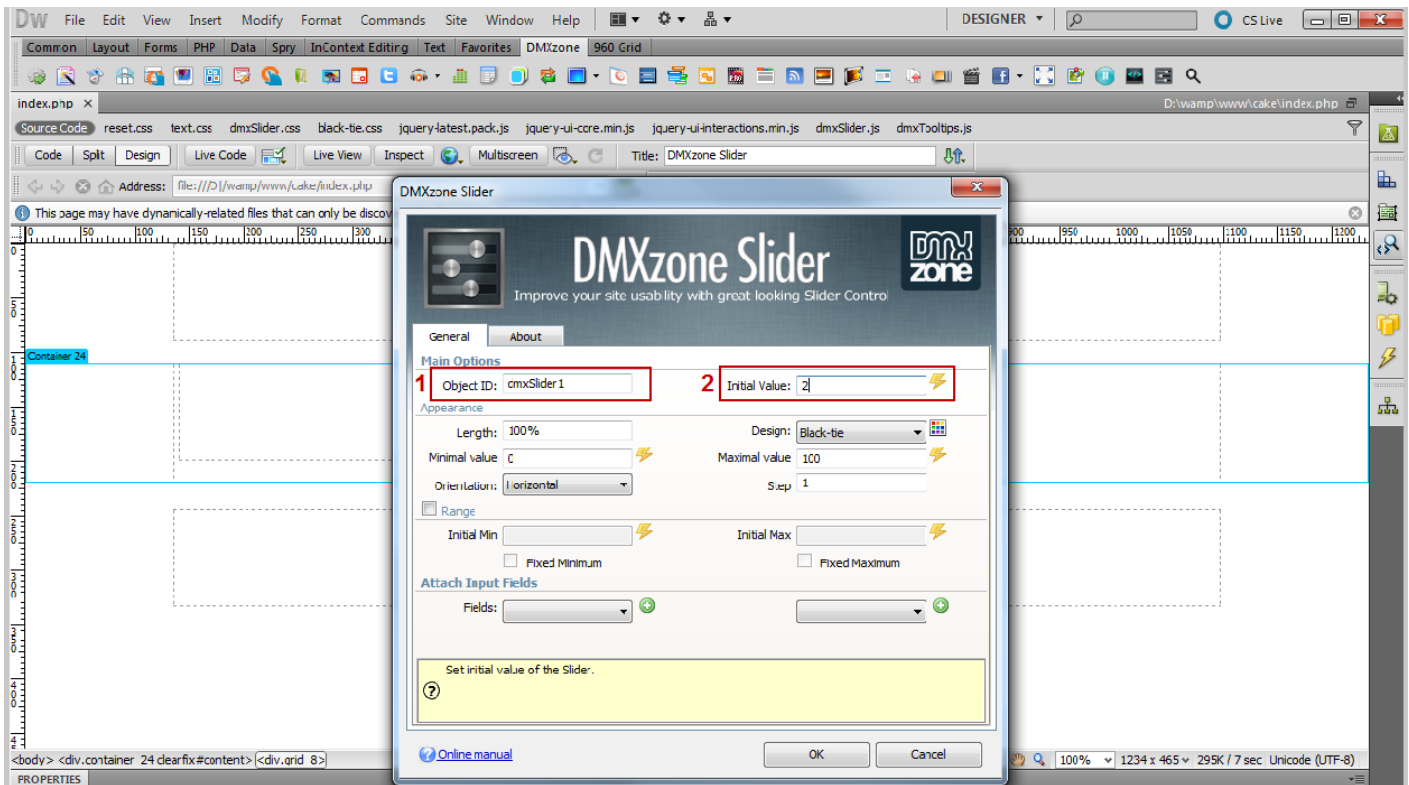


How to do it

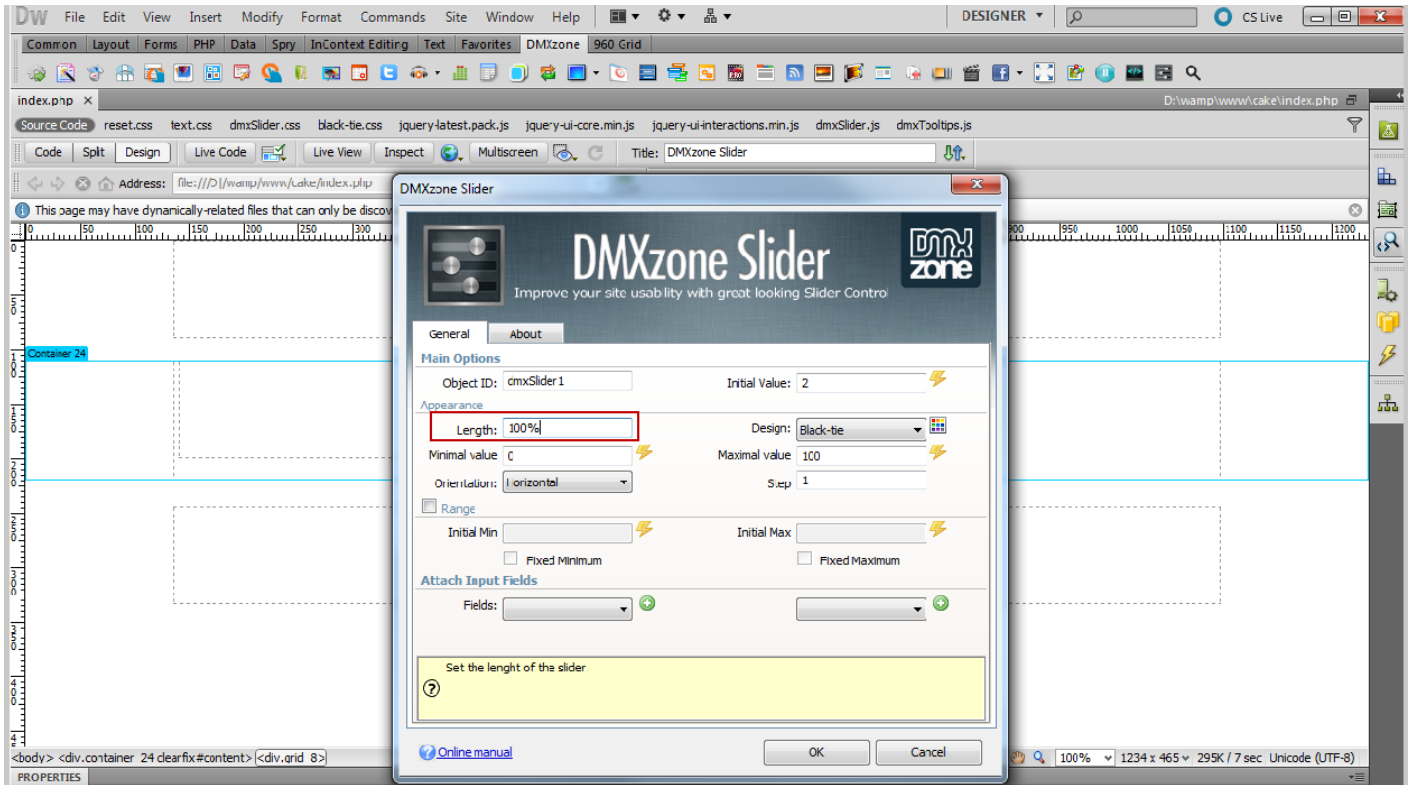
1. We've already created our page layout and now we'll insert the **DMXzone Slider**. Click on your **page (1)** and **hit the DMXzone Slider icon (2)**.



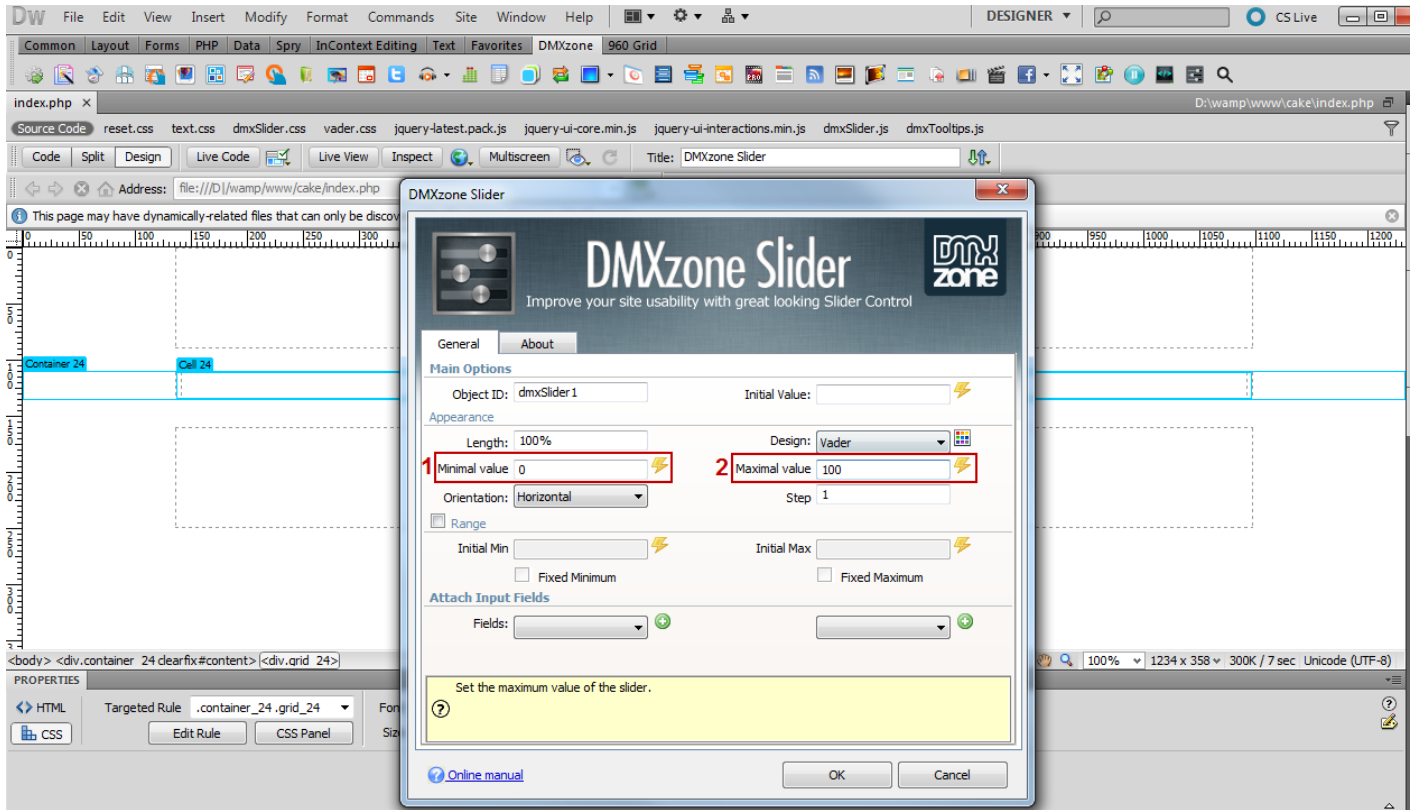
- For our tutorial we will **use the default ID (1)** for our Slider and will set the **Initial value to 2 (2)**. You can leave this field blank if you want your initial value to be 0.



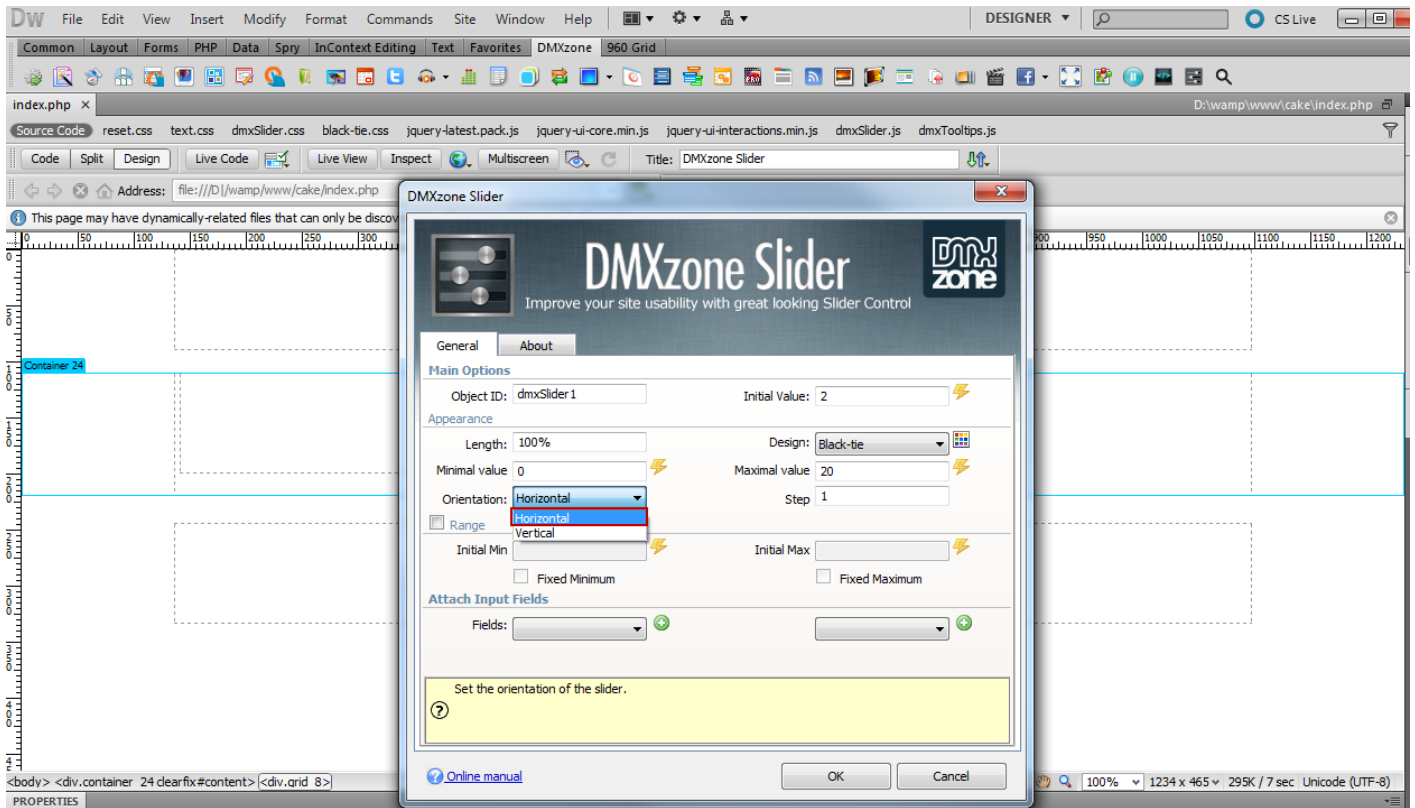
3. We'll leave the length at **100%**.



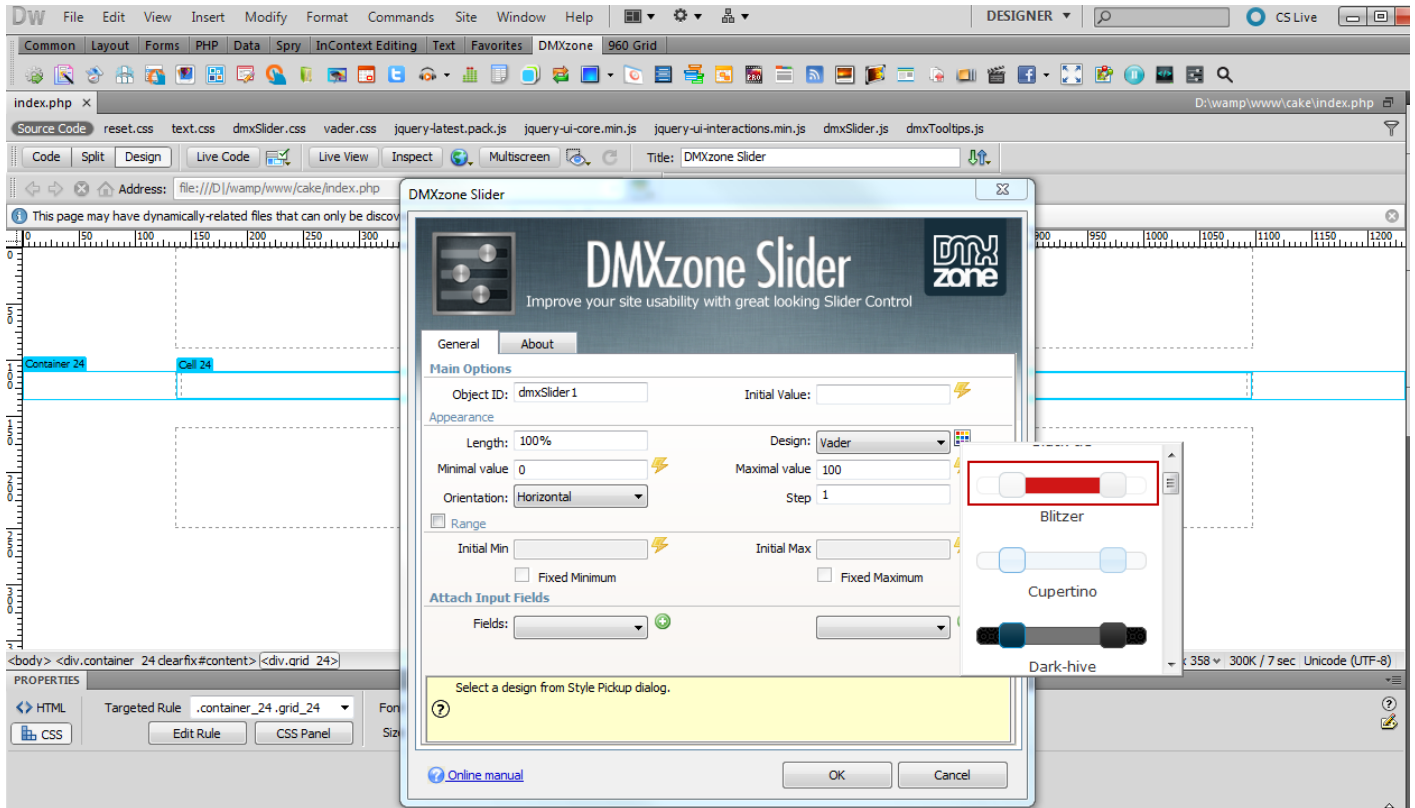
4. The **minimal value** is set at 0 **(1)** and the **maximal** we change to 100 **(2)**.



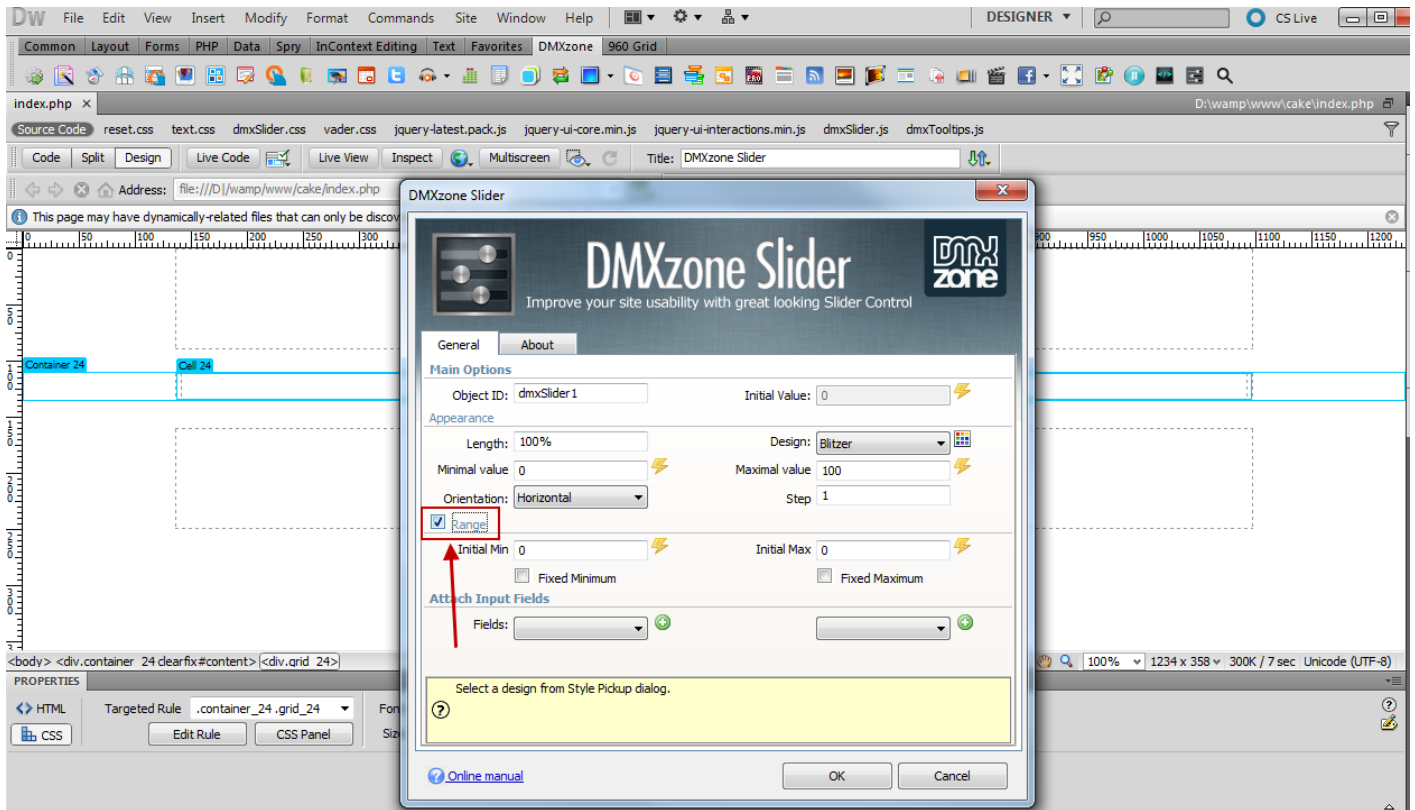
- The **DMXzone Slider** orientation can be horizontal or vertical. For our tutorial we choose the **horizontal** one.



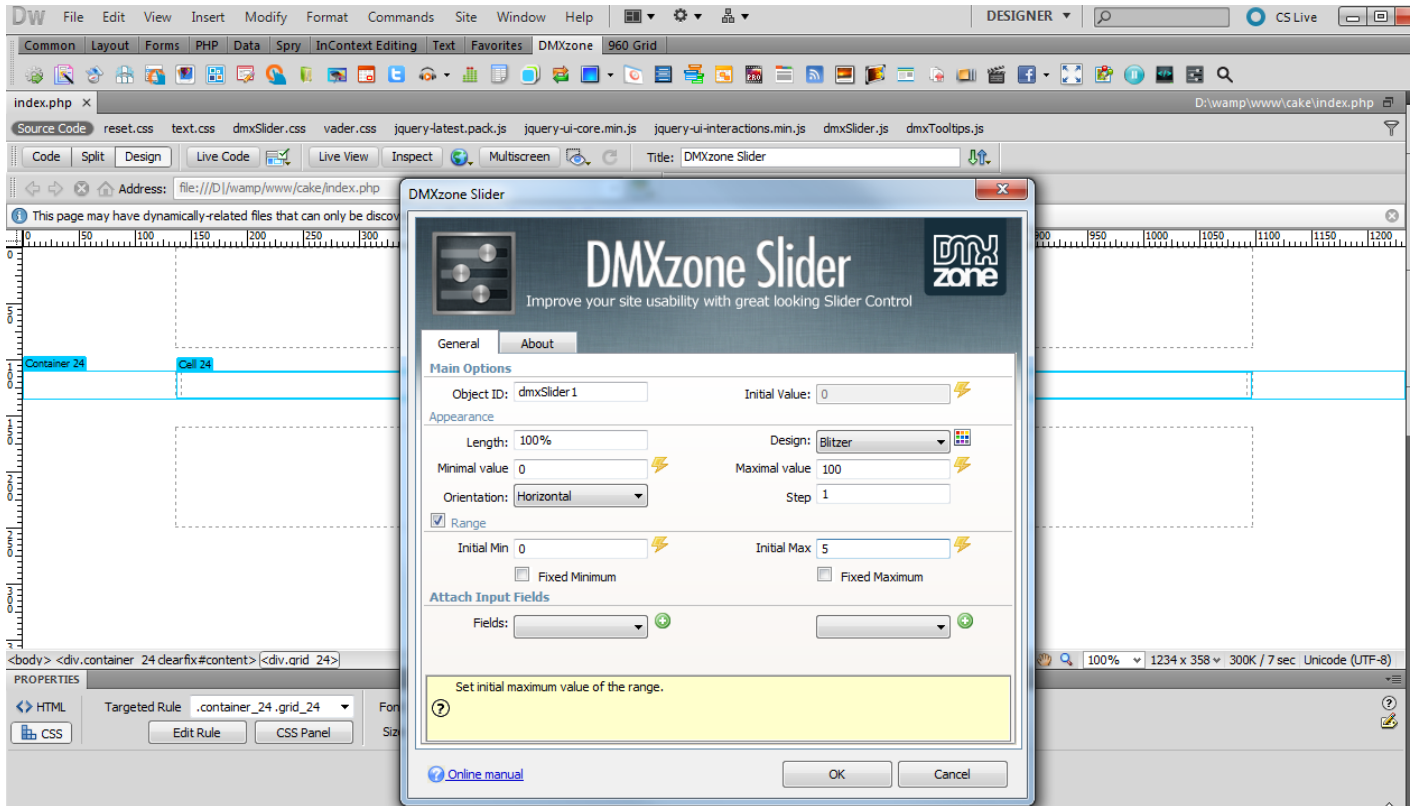
6. Choose one of the predefined designs by clicking on the style picker. We chose the **Blitzer** design.



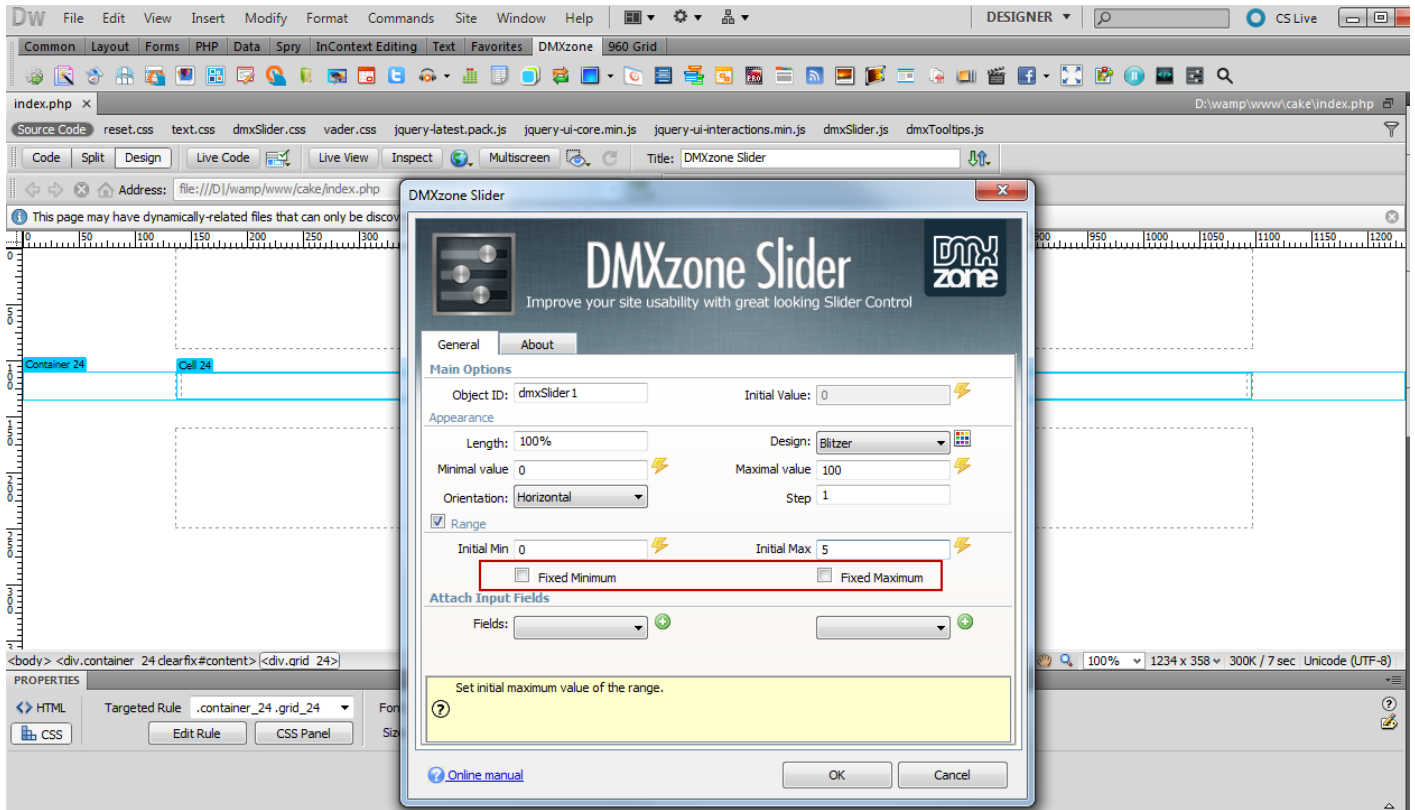
7. To add the range selector, **click** on the **range** checkbox.



8. We leave the **initial minimal value to 0 (1)** and set **5 as initial maximal value (2)** for our range.

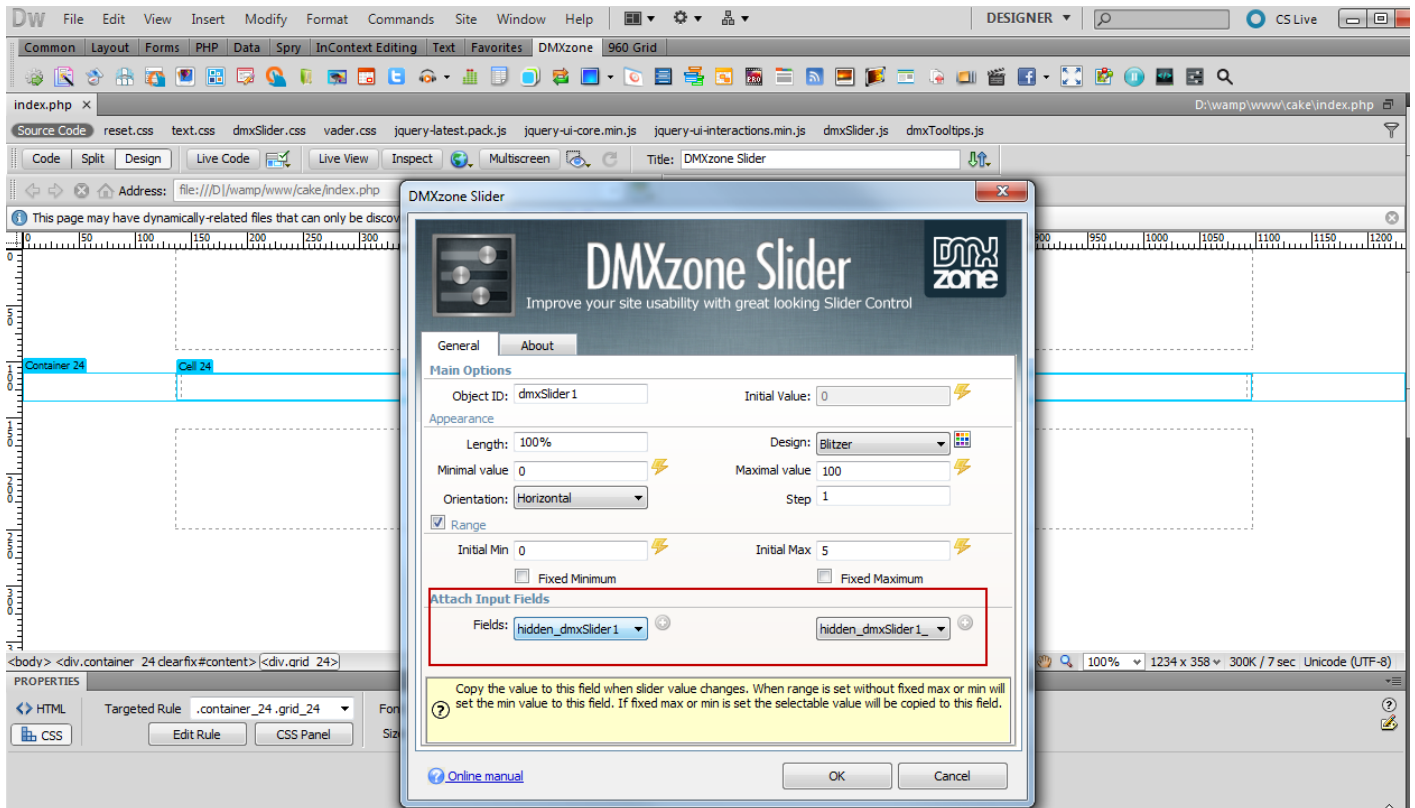


- You can set the Min and Max value of the range selector to be fixed. In this **case if you chose fixed minimum value it will be equal to the Slider min value**, and if the **fixed maximum is checked then the maximum range value will match the Slider max value**.

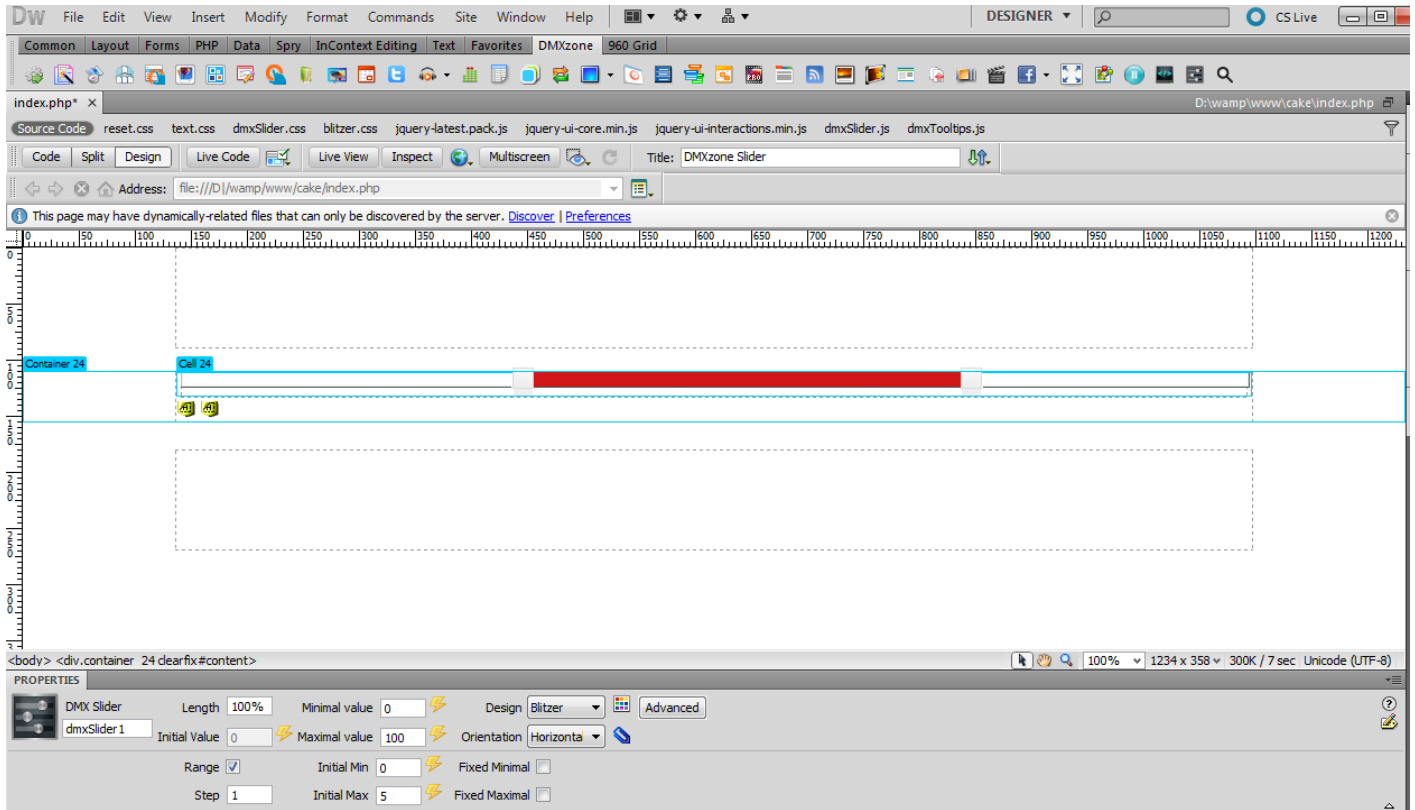


10. You can also store the selected values of the range selector into hidden fields. If you like to do so, click the **Add new button** in order to **create a new hidden field**. When you're done, click OK.

***Note:** If you're using fixed min and fixed max then only the selectable value will be copied to the hidden field!



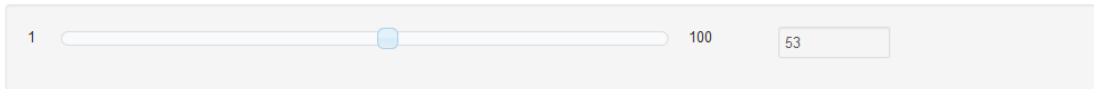
11. Now you can save your work and preview the result in the browser.



Advanced: Show the DMXzone Slider Value into a Text Field

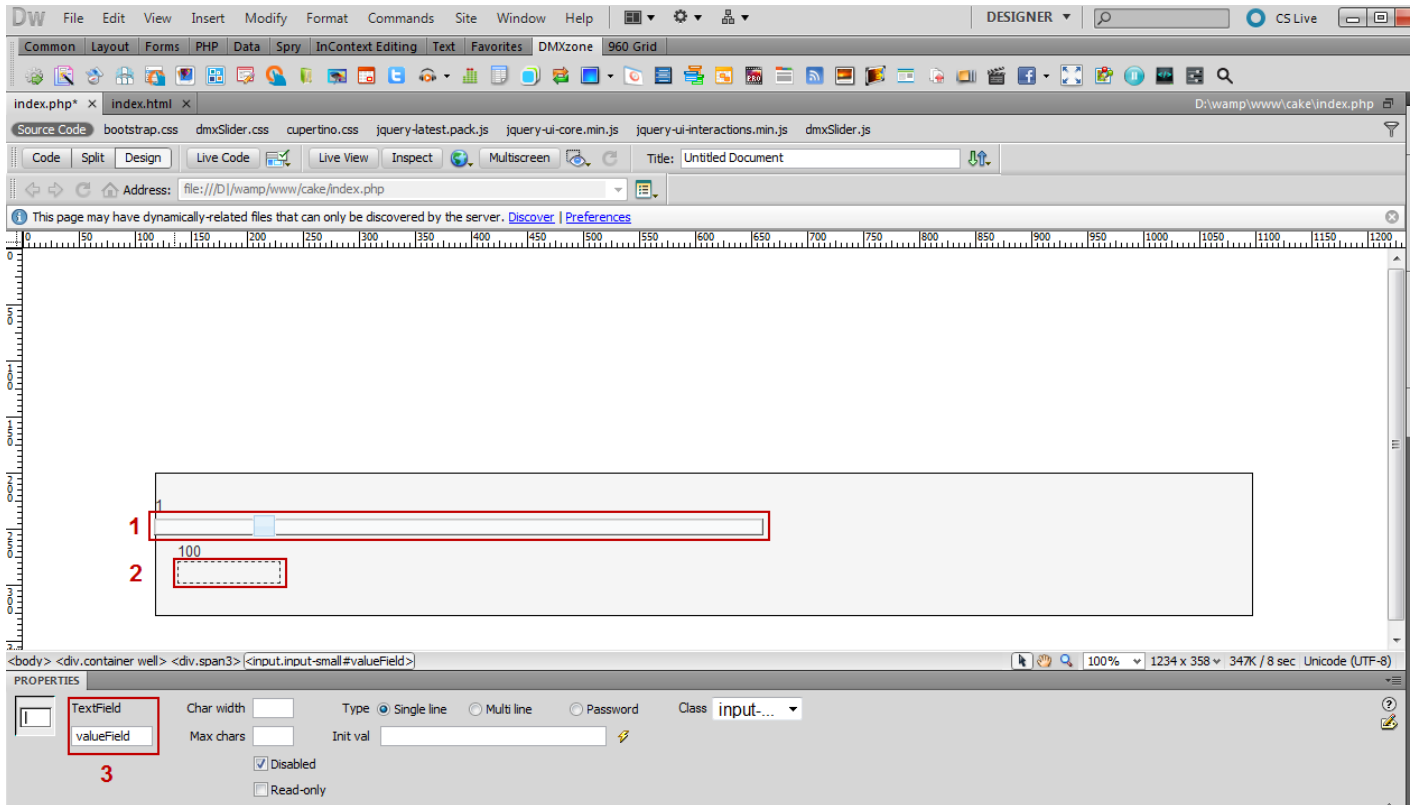

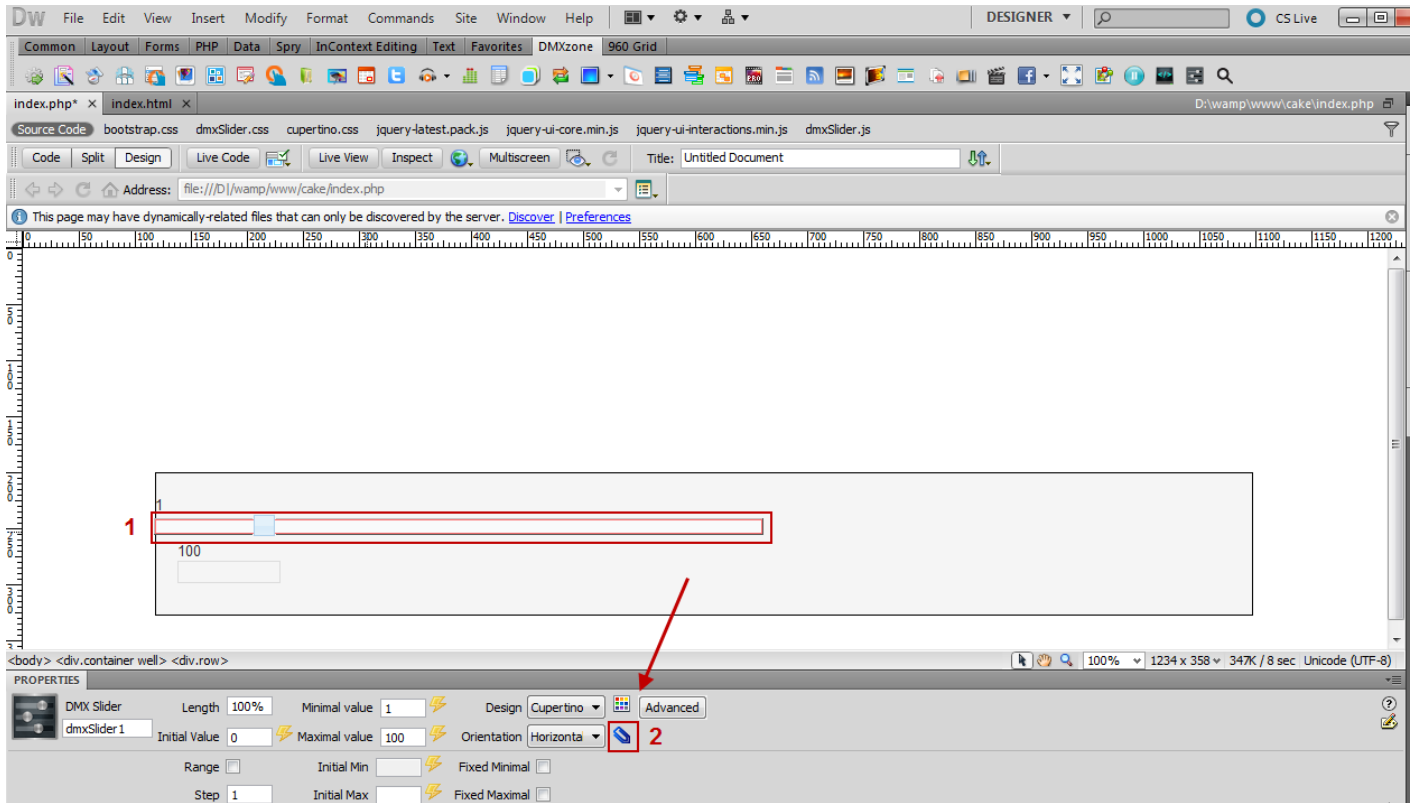


How to do it

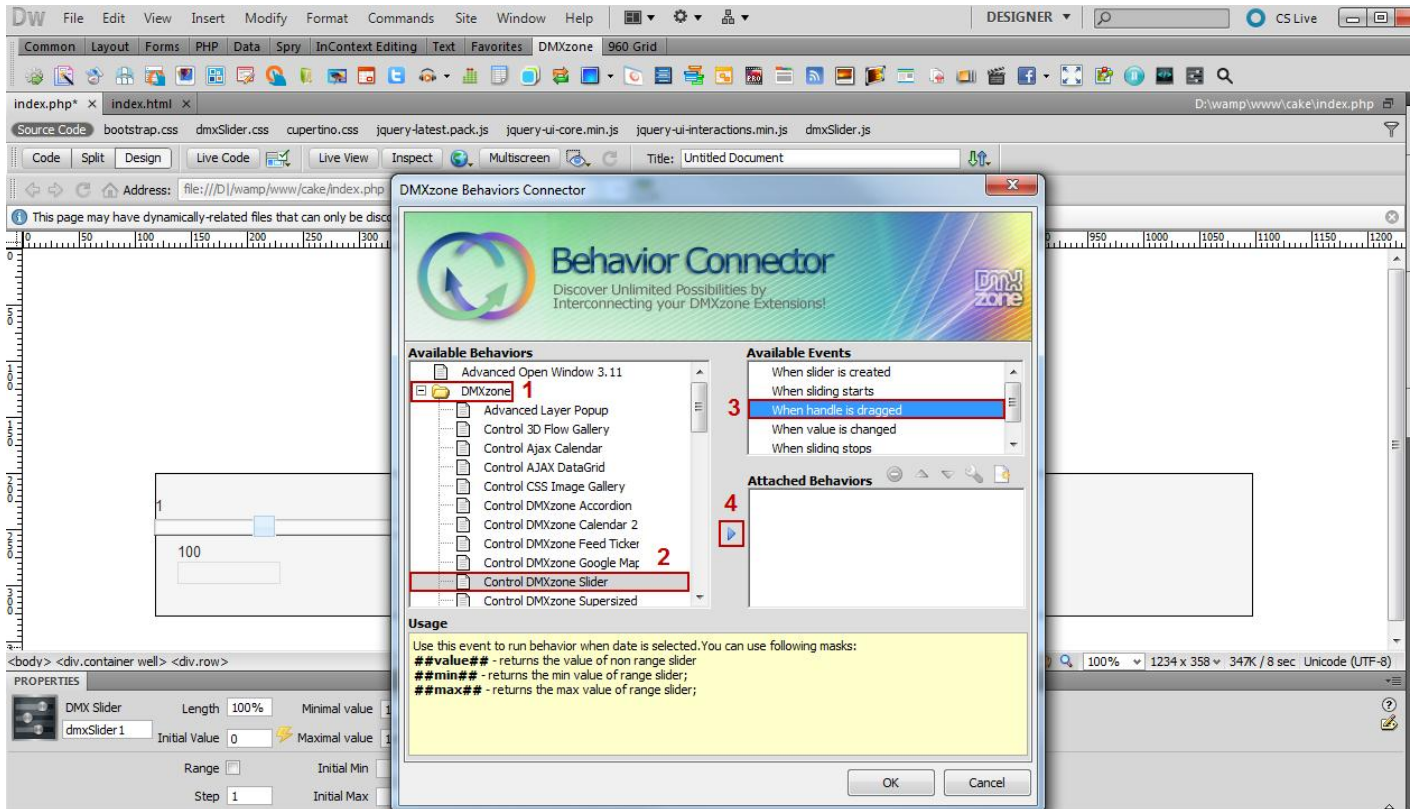
1. We've already inserted the **DMXzone Slider (1)** on our page, added a **standard Text field (2)** and named its ID: **valueField (3)**.



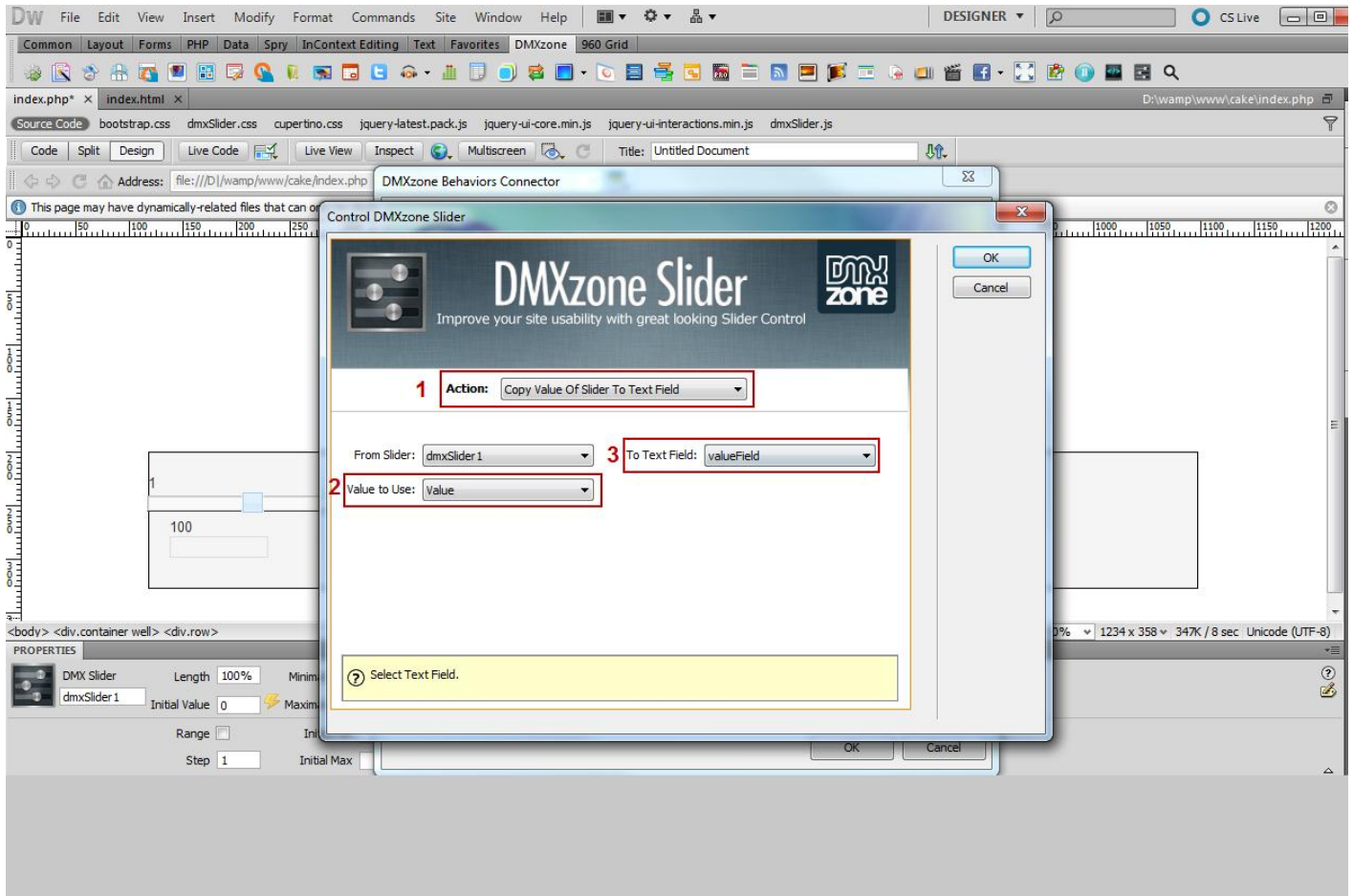
- In order to bind the **Text field** and the **DMXzone Slider** we'll need to use the **Behavior connector**. So, click on the **DMXzone Slider (1)** and then click the **Add/edit behaviors button (2)** in the property inspector.



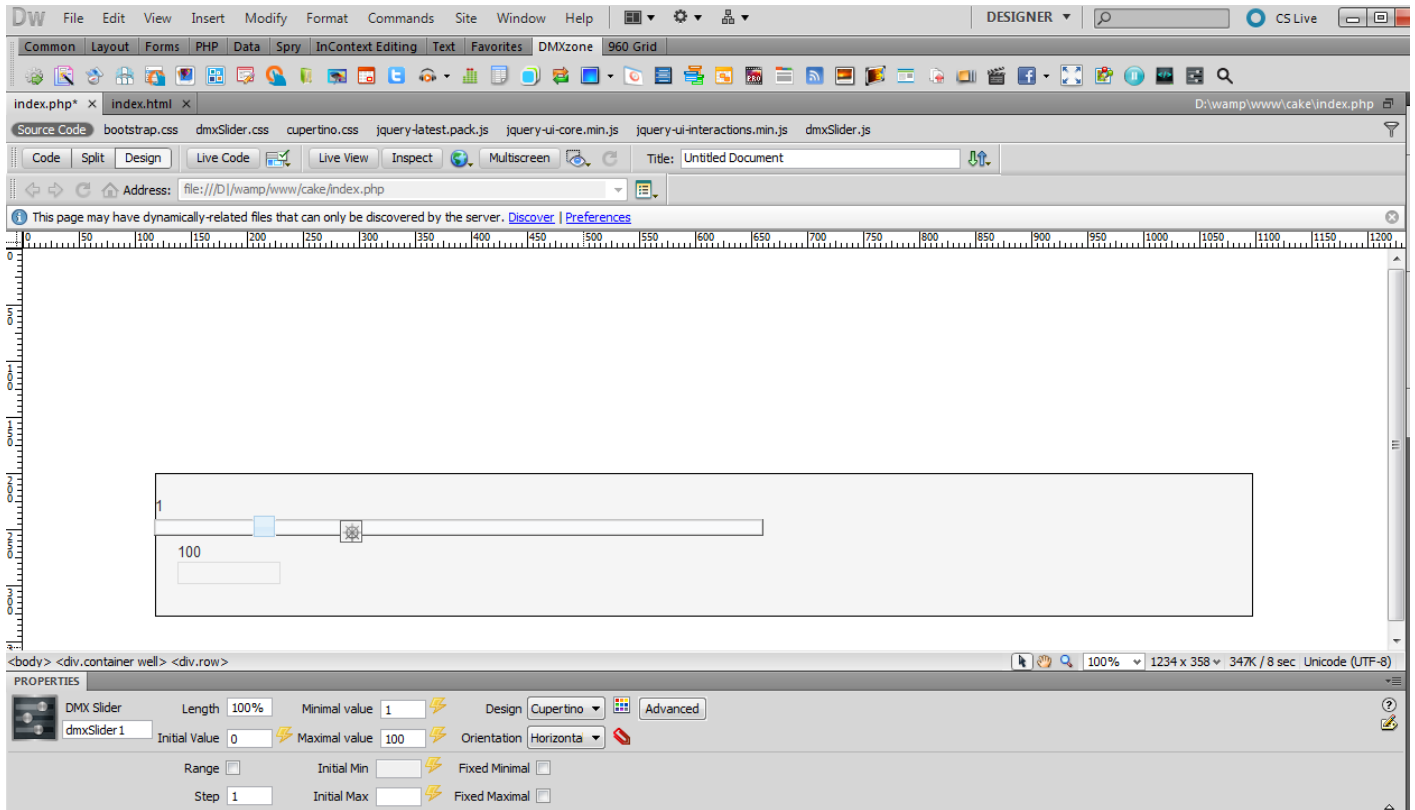
- Once the DMXzone behavior connector window opens, select **DMXzone folder (1)**, the **Control DMXzone Slider behavior (2)**, when the **handle is dragged event (3)** and **Add the selected behavior (4)**.



- When the Control DMXzone Slider window opens, select the **Copy value of slider to text field action (1)** from the menu and choose **Value (2)** from the value to use menu that will return the current value of the slider. From the text field dropdown we select our text field ID – **valueField (3)**.



5. Now you can save your work and preview the result in the browser.



Advanced: Controlling HTML5 Slideshow with DMXzone Slider

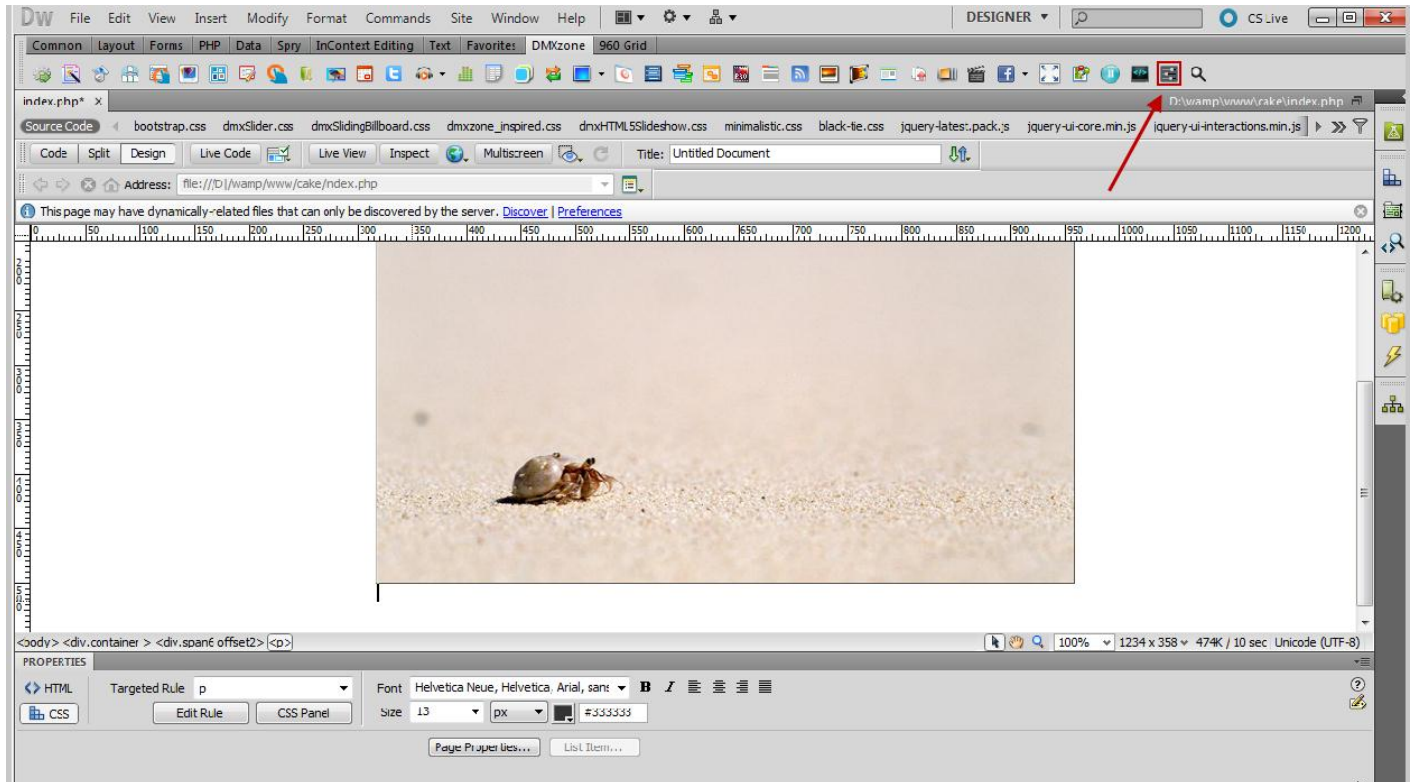

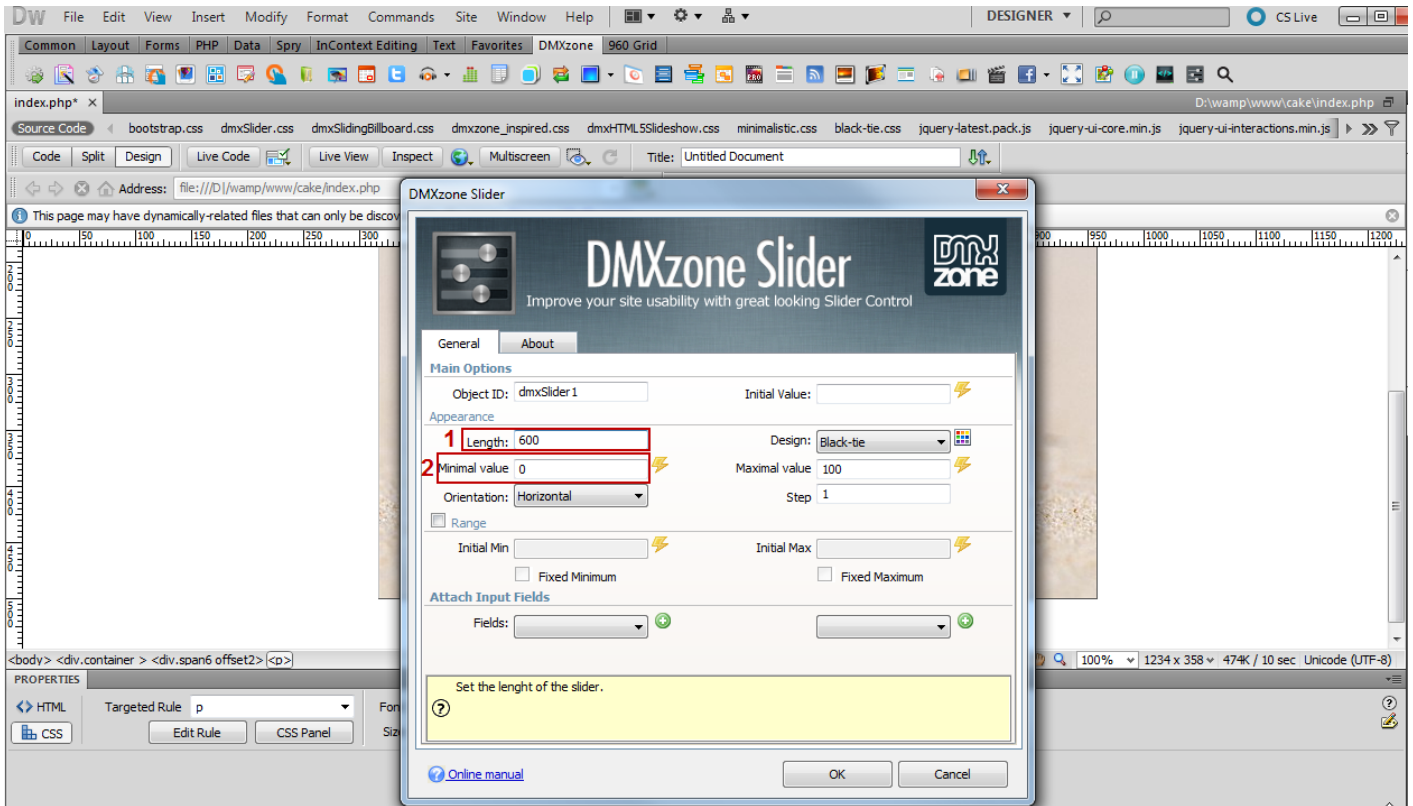


How to do it

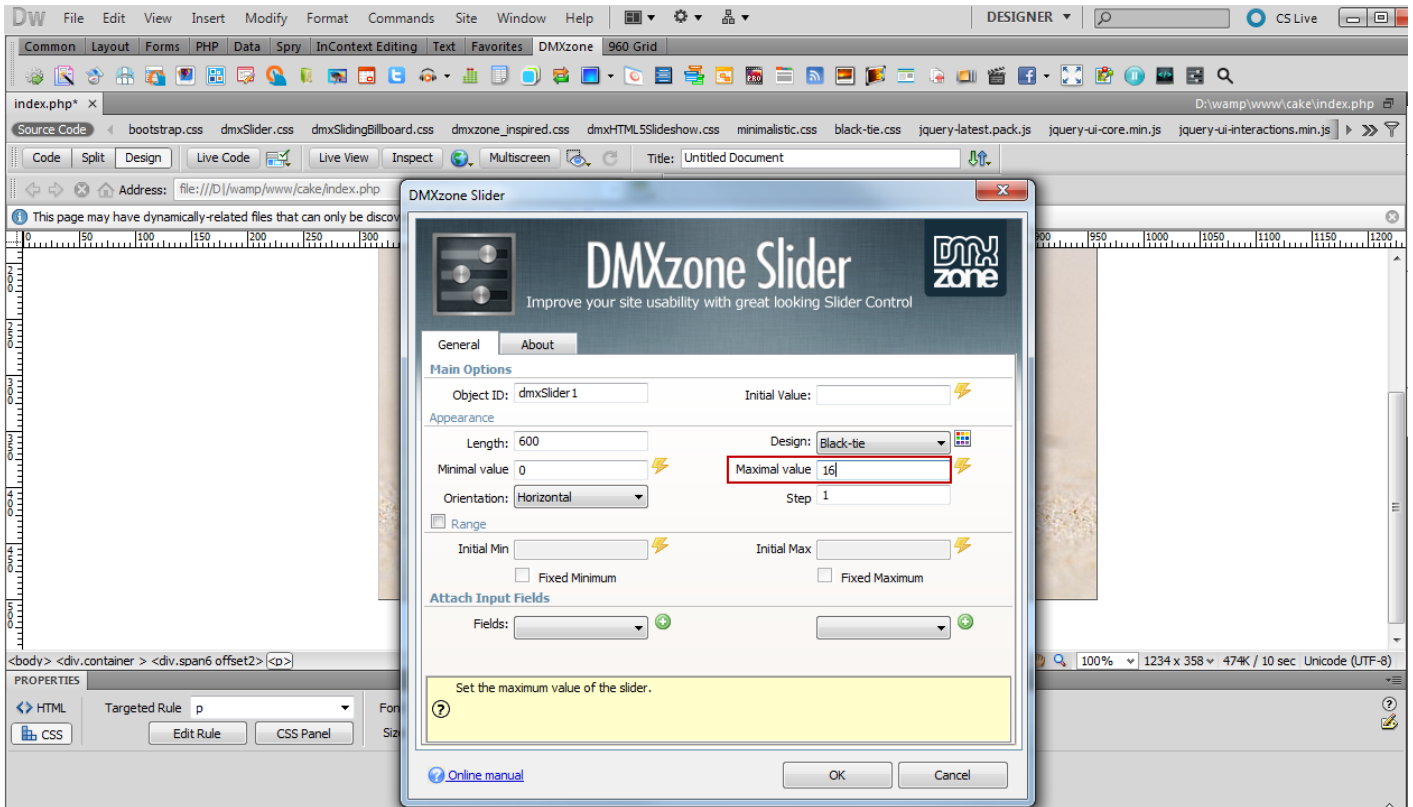
1. We've already inserted the [HTML5 Slideshow](#) that contains 17 images. Outside the slideshow, click on your page and open the **DMXzone Slider window**.



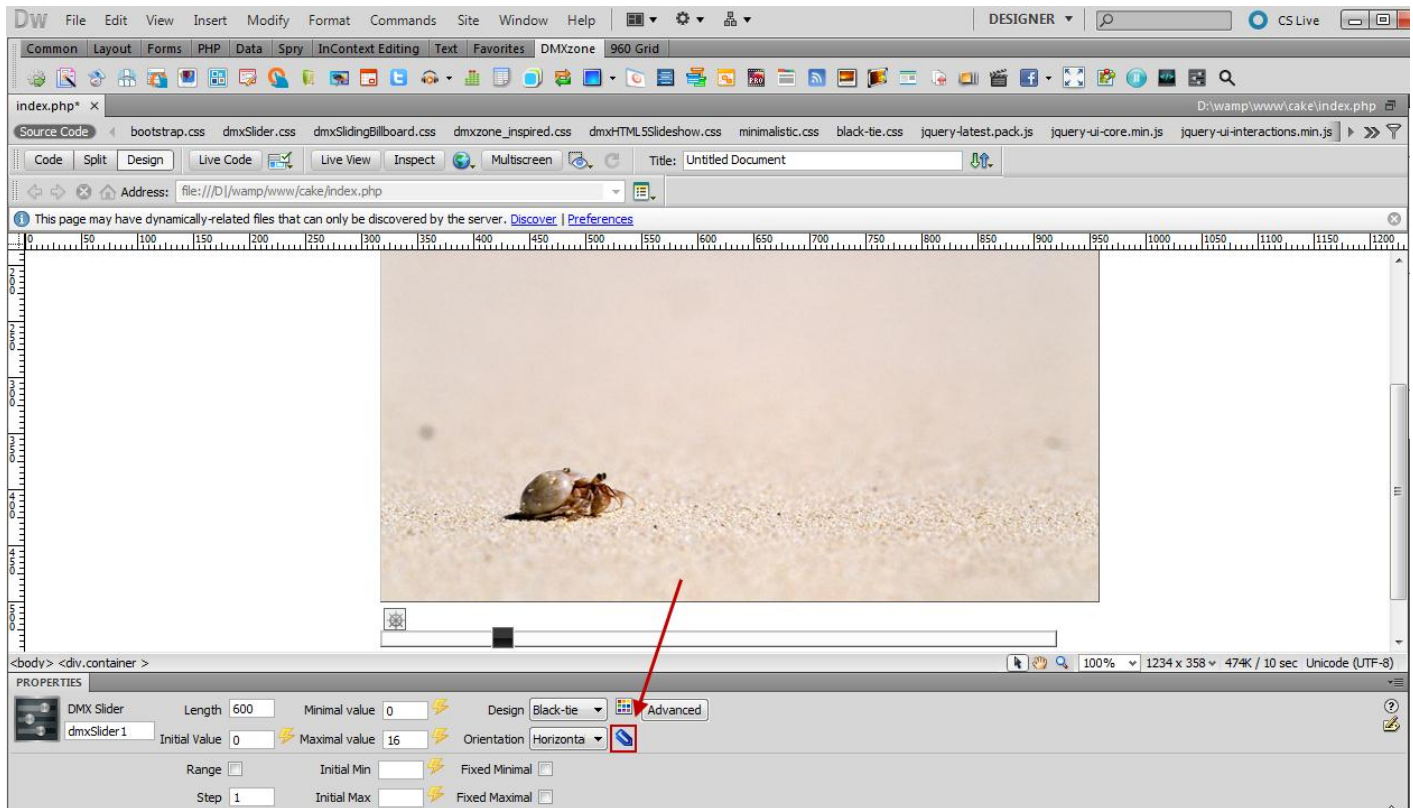
- In the DMXzone Slider window we set the **width to 600px (1)** so it matches our [HTML5 Slideshow](#) size. The **minimal value for our Slider should be 0 (2)** as this is the first slide of the **HTML5 Slideshow**.



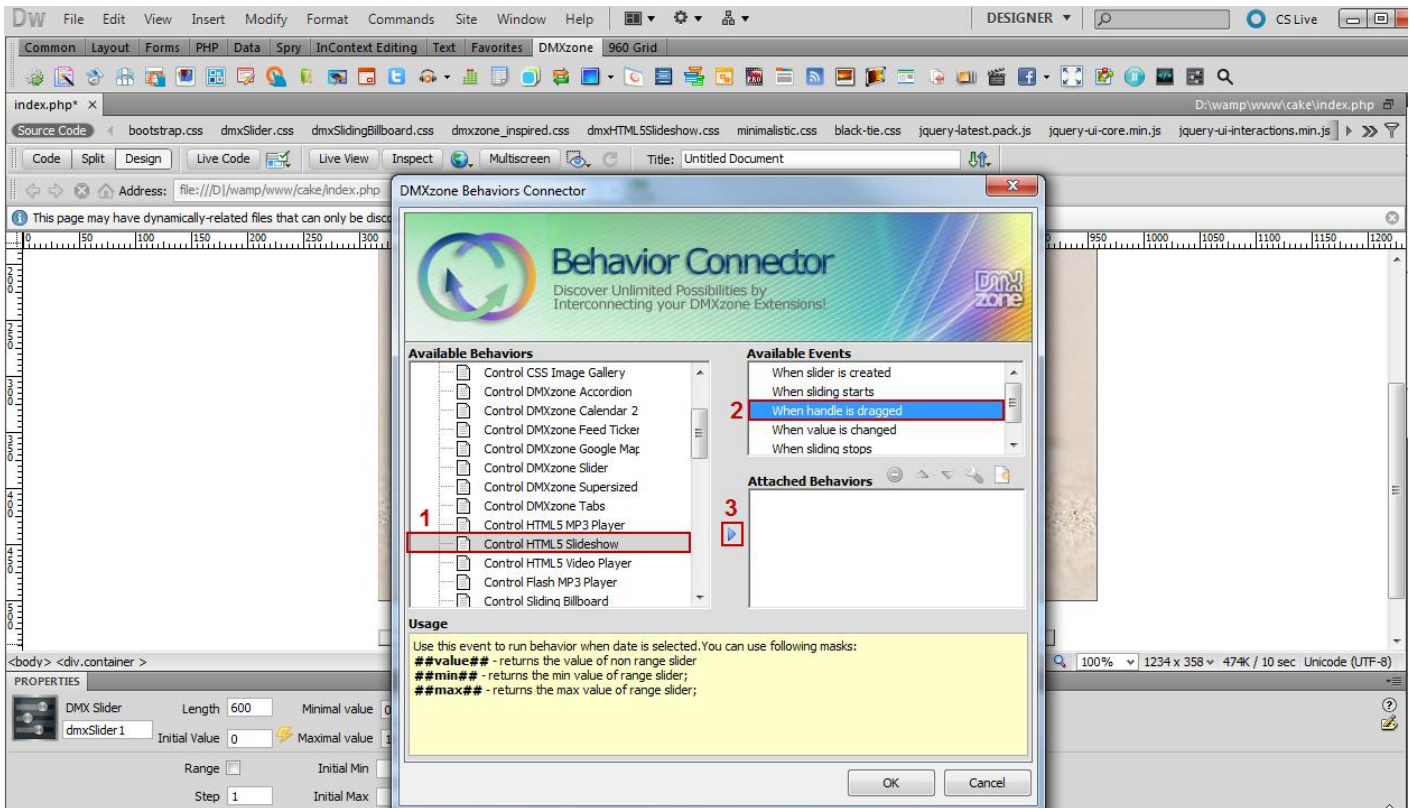
- We set the **maximum value to 16** as this is the number of the slides in our [HTML5 Slideshow](#). When you're done, click OK.



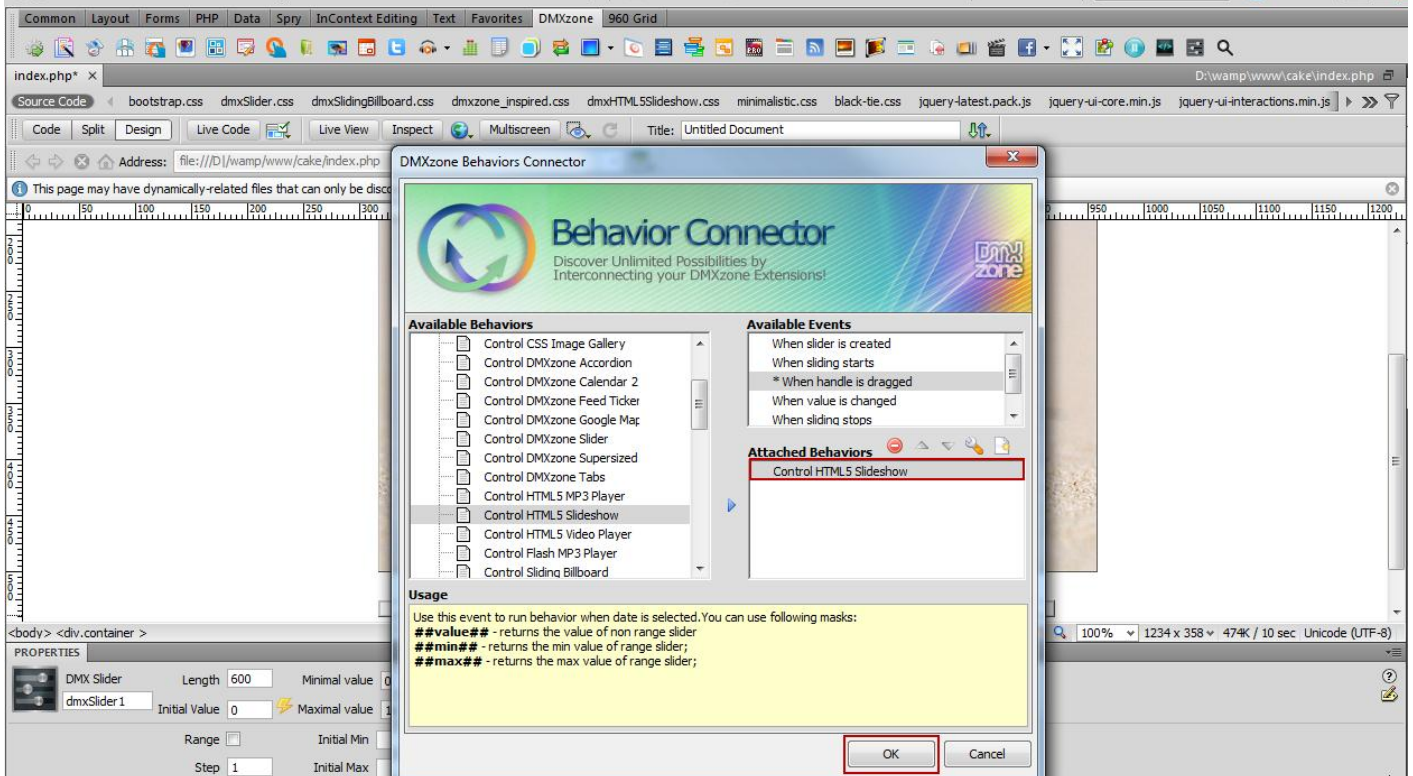
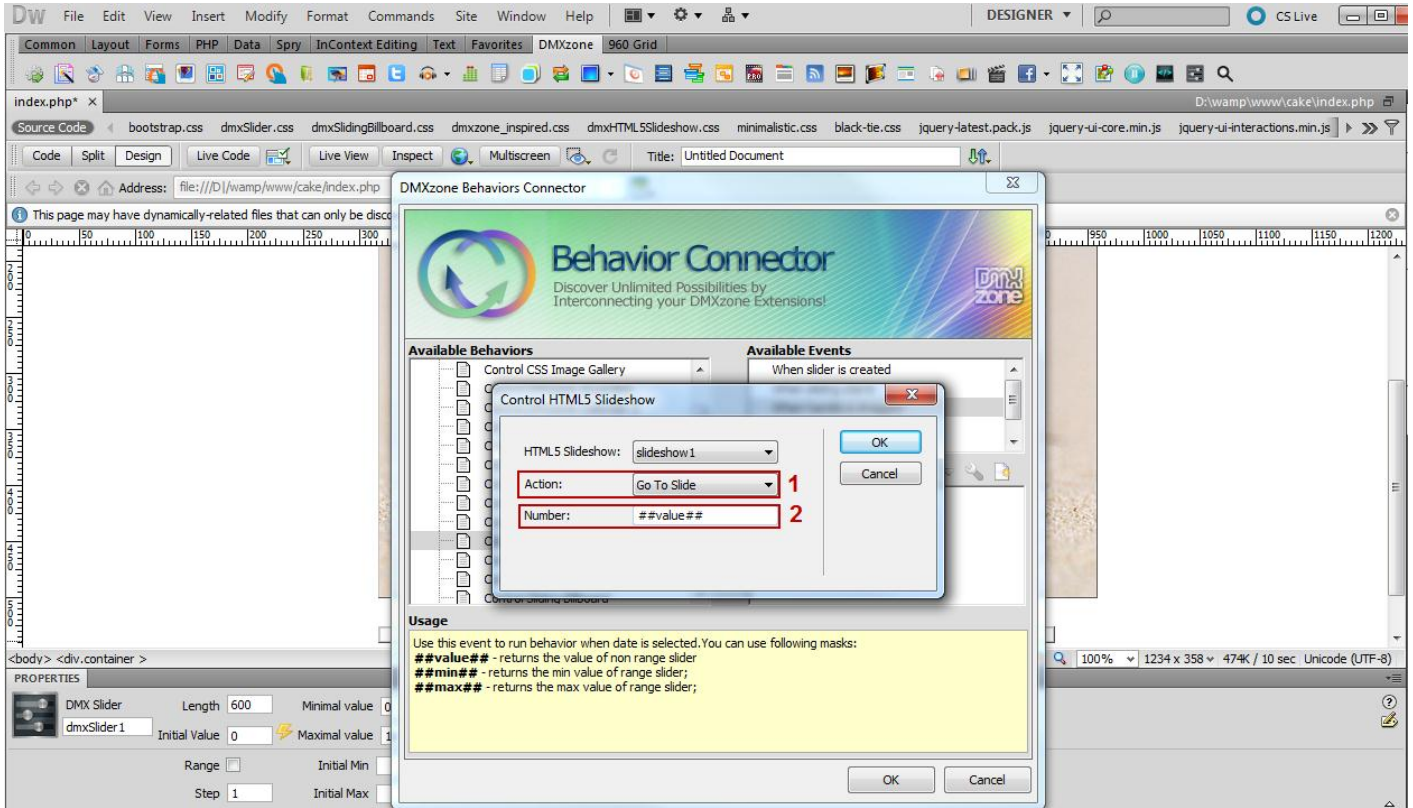
- Now we're going to connect the **DMXzone Slider** with the [HTML5 Slideshow](#). Click the **Add/edit behaviors** button.



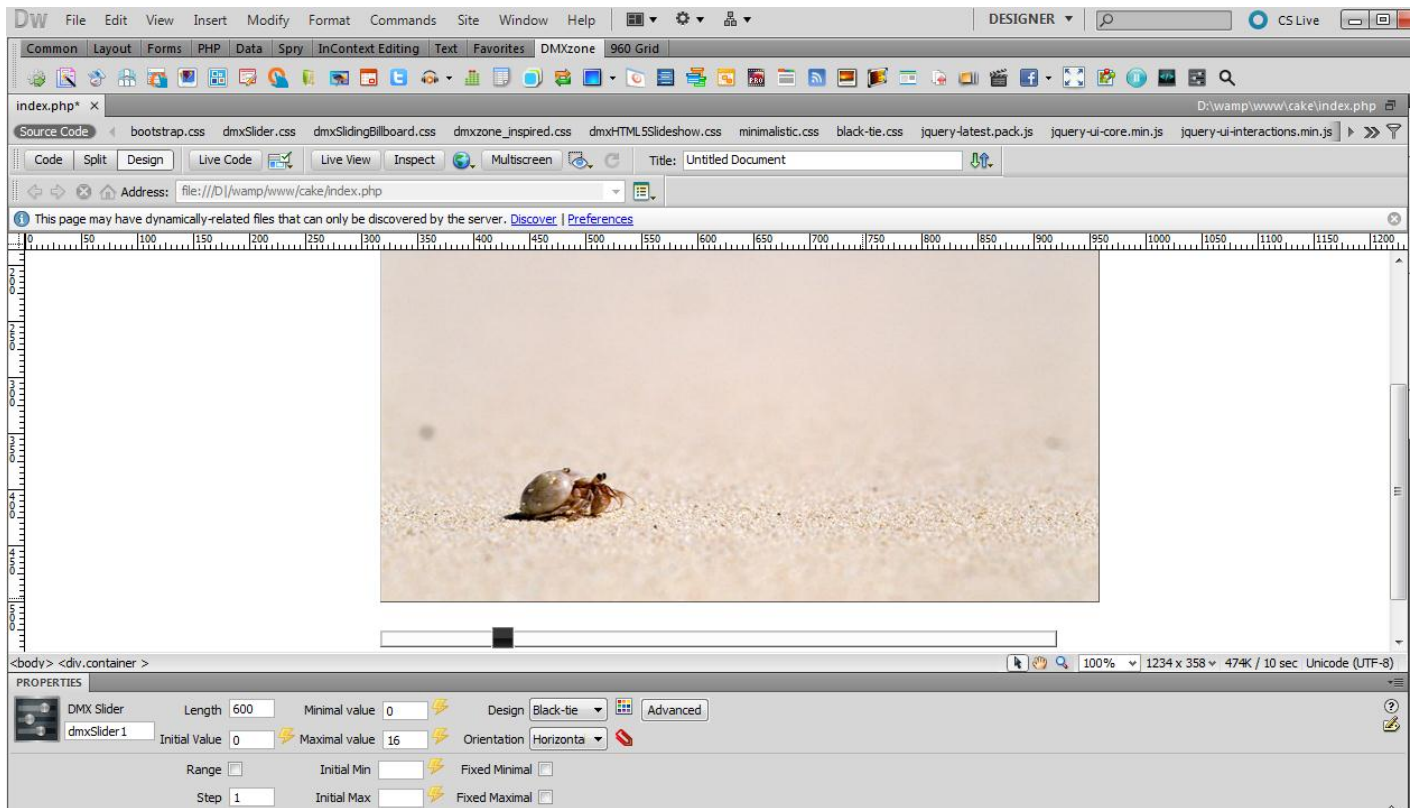
- From the **DMXzone folder**, choose **Control HTML5 Slideshow behavior (1)**, select the **When handle is dragged action (2)** and **add the selected behavior (3)**.



- In the Control HTML5 Slideshow window select **Go to slide item (1)** from the **Action menu** and enter **#value#** in the **number field (2)**. This mask returns the current value of our slider. When you're done, click the OK button.



7. Now you can save your work and preview the result in the browser.

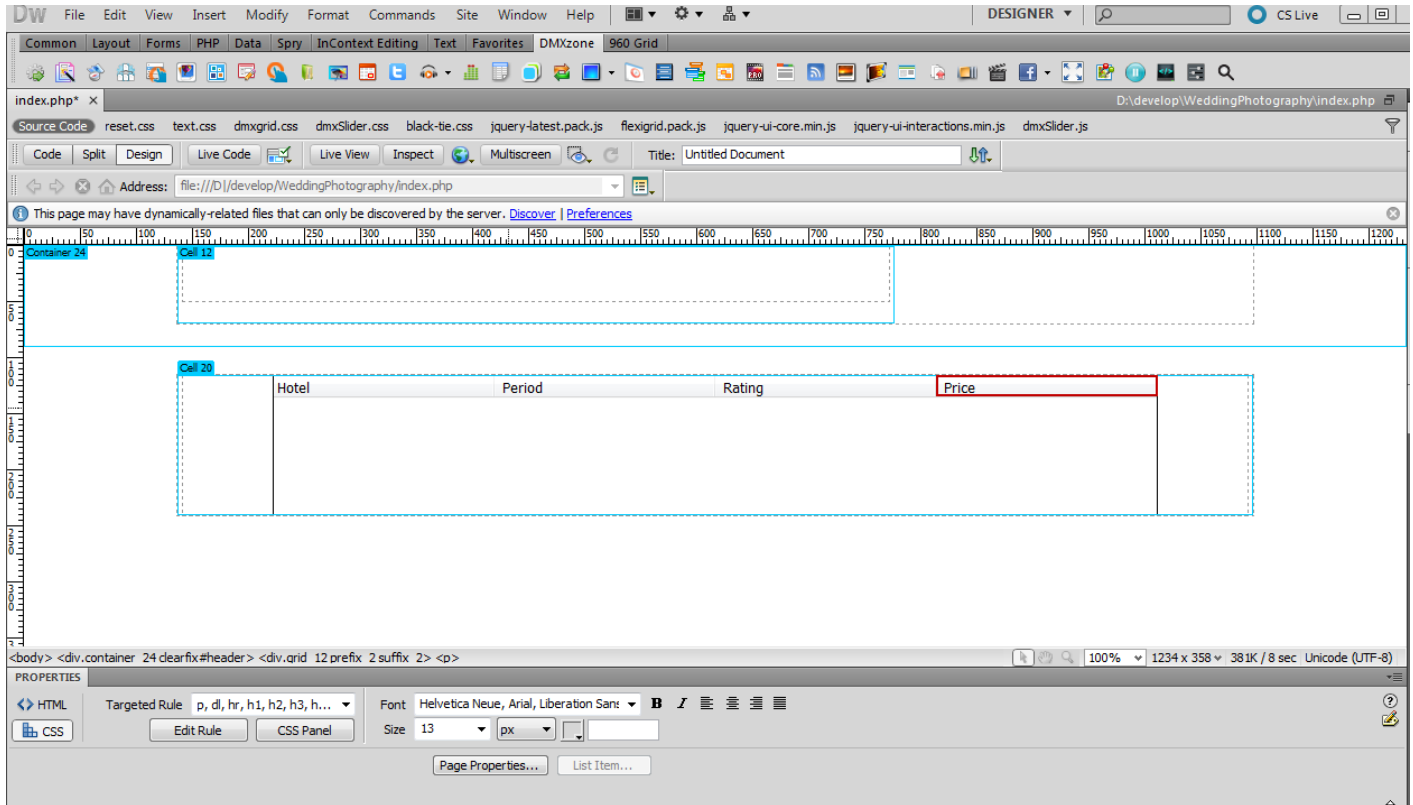

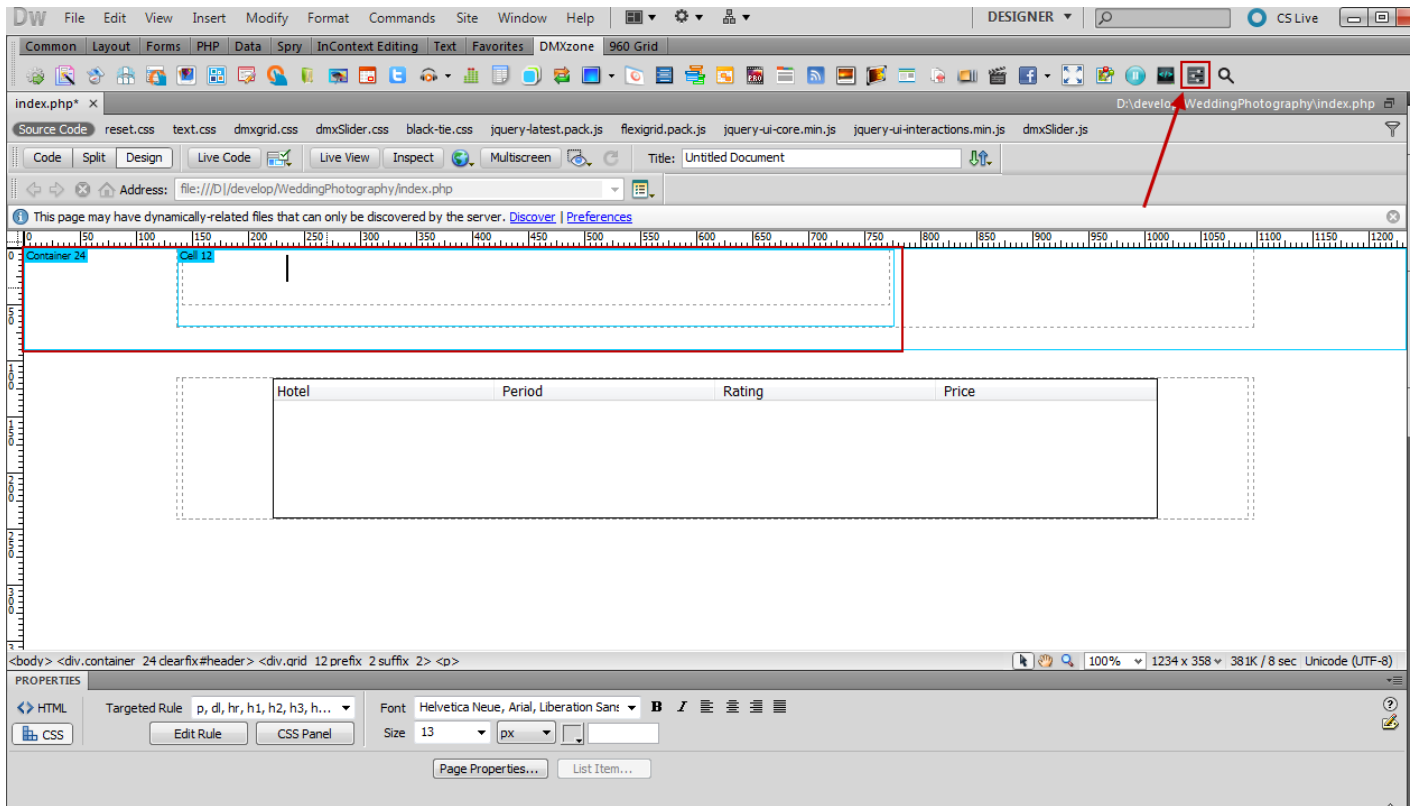

How to do it

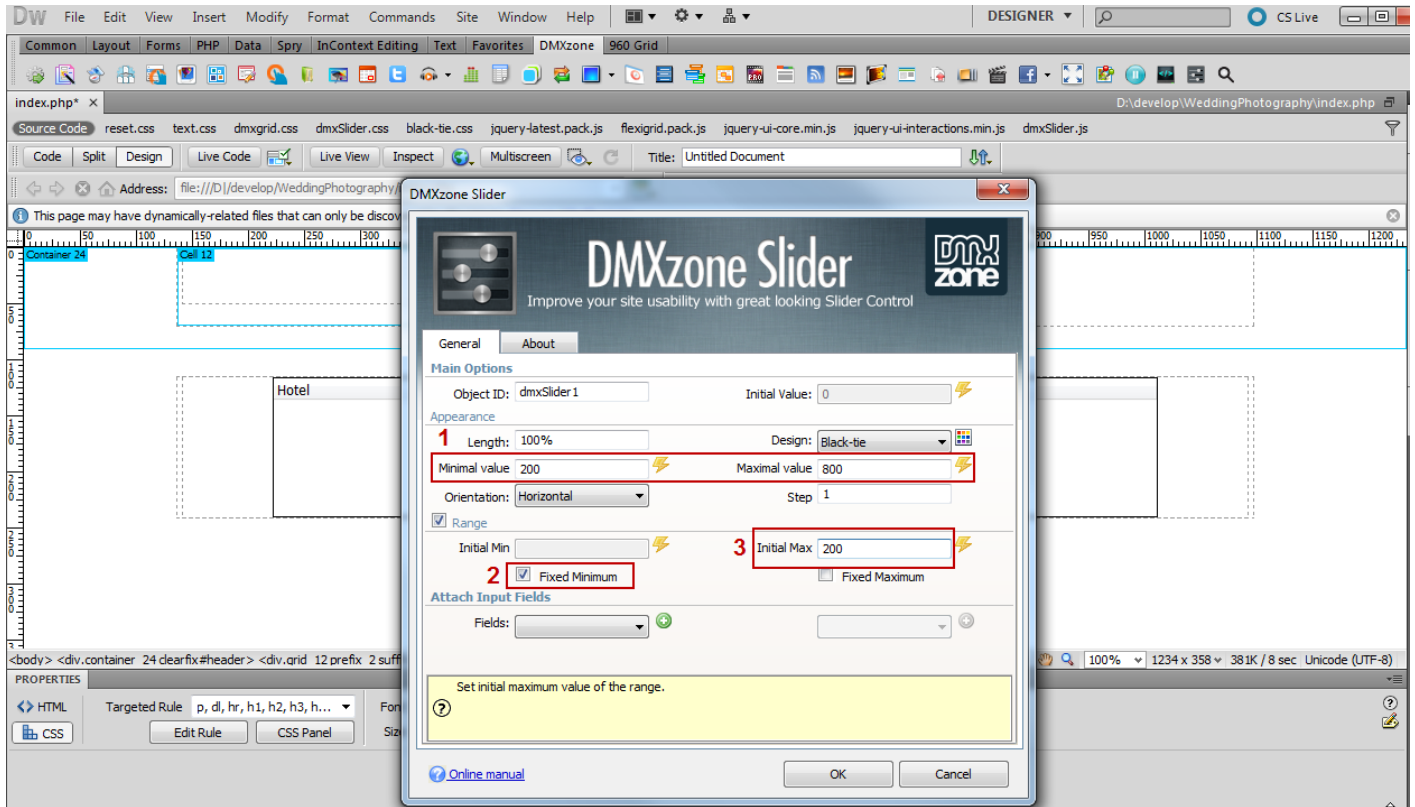
1. We've already inserted our [Ajax Datagrid](#) on our page and we're going to use **DMXzone Slider** to filter it by the price column.



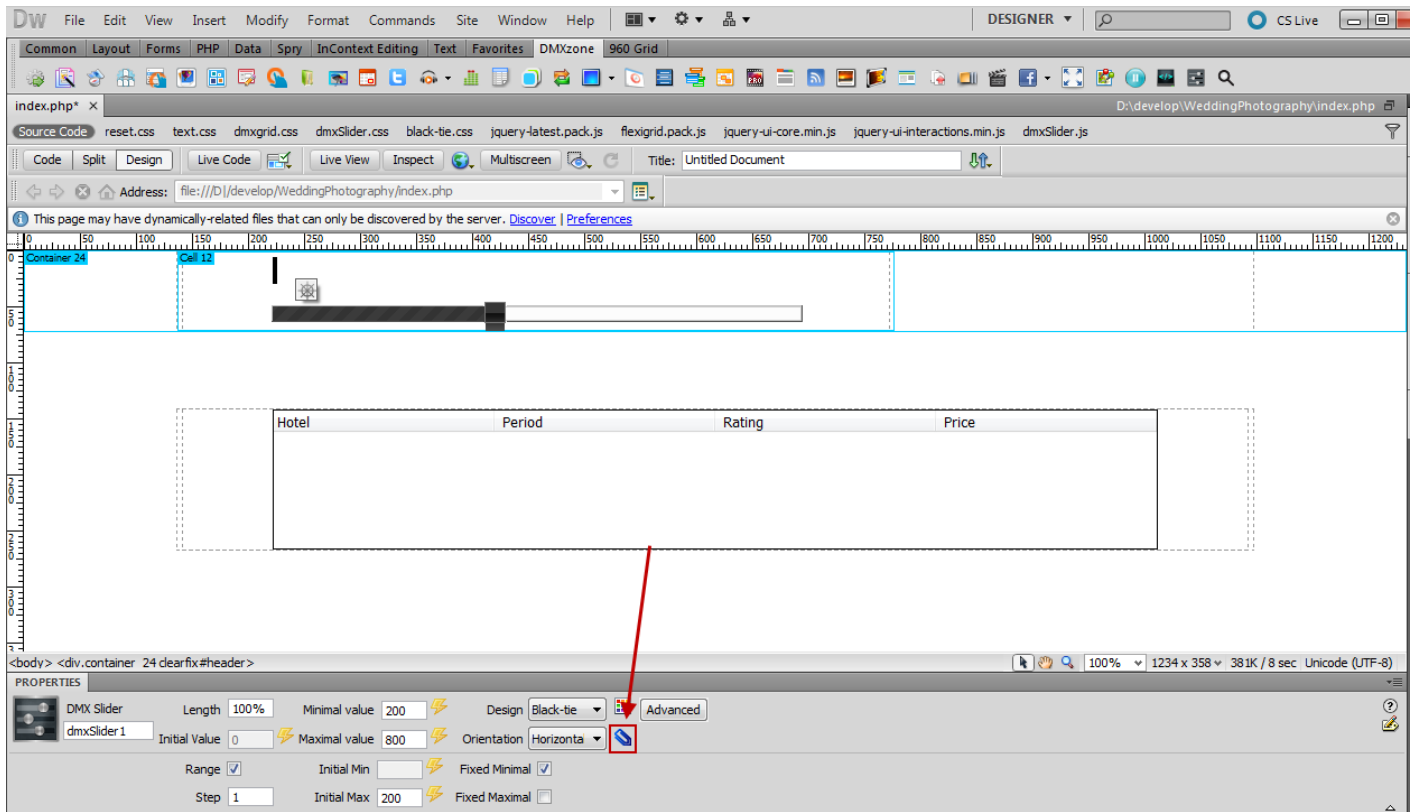
2. In a separate container we will insert the **DMXzone Slider** so open the DMXzone Slider window.



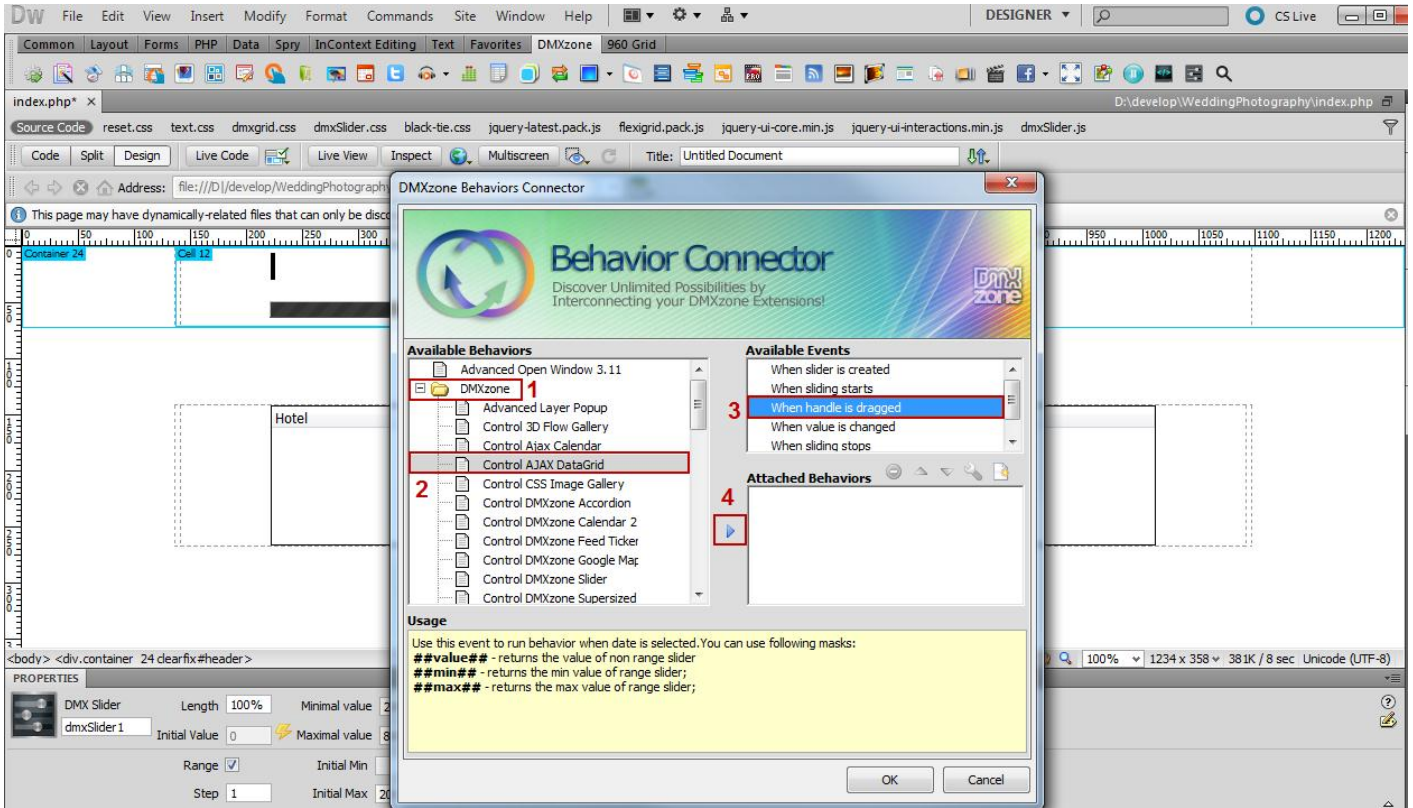
- In the DMXzone Slider window we set **200 as a minimal value** and **800 as a maximal value (1)**, also in the range options we **check the fixed maximum (2)** and use **200 as an initial max value (3)**.



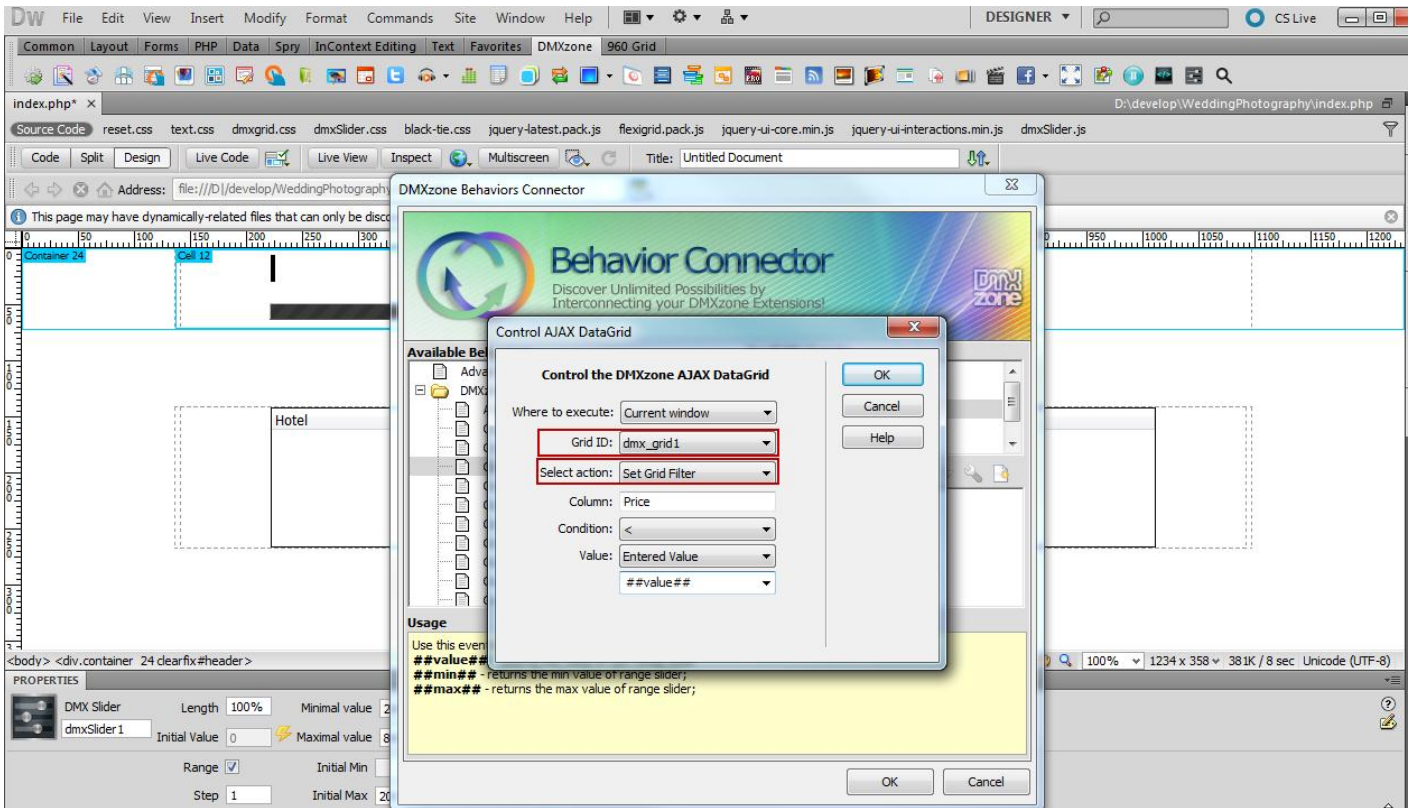
- Now we're going to connect the **DMXzone Slider** with the [Ajax Datagrid](#) through the **Behavior connector**. Click the **Add/edit behaviors button**.



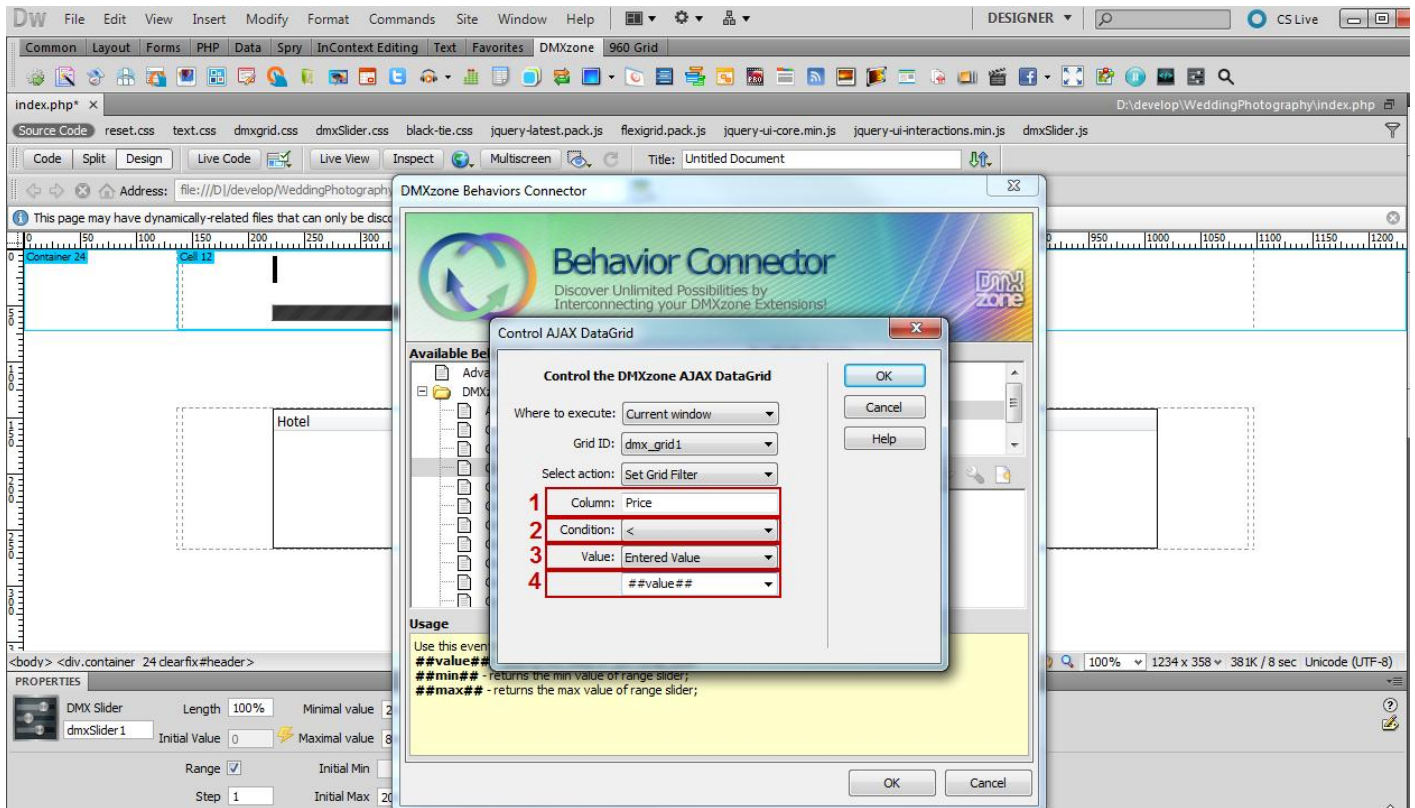
- From the **DMXzone folder (1)**, choose **Control Ajax Datagrid behavior (2)**, select the **When handle is dragged action (3)** and add the selected behavior (4).



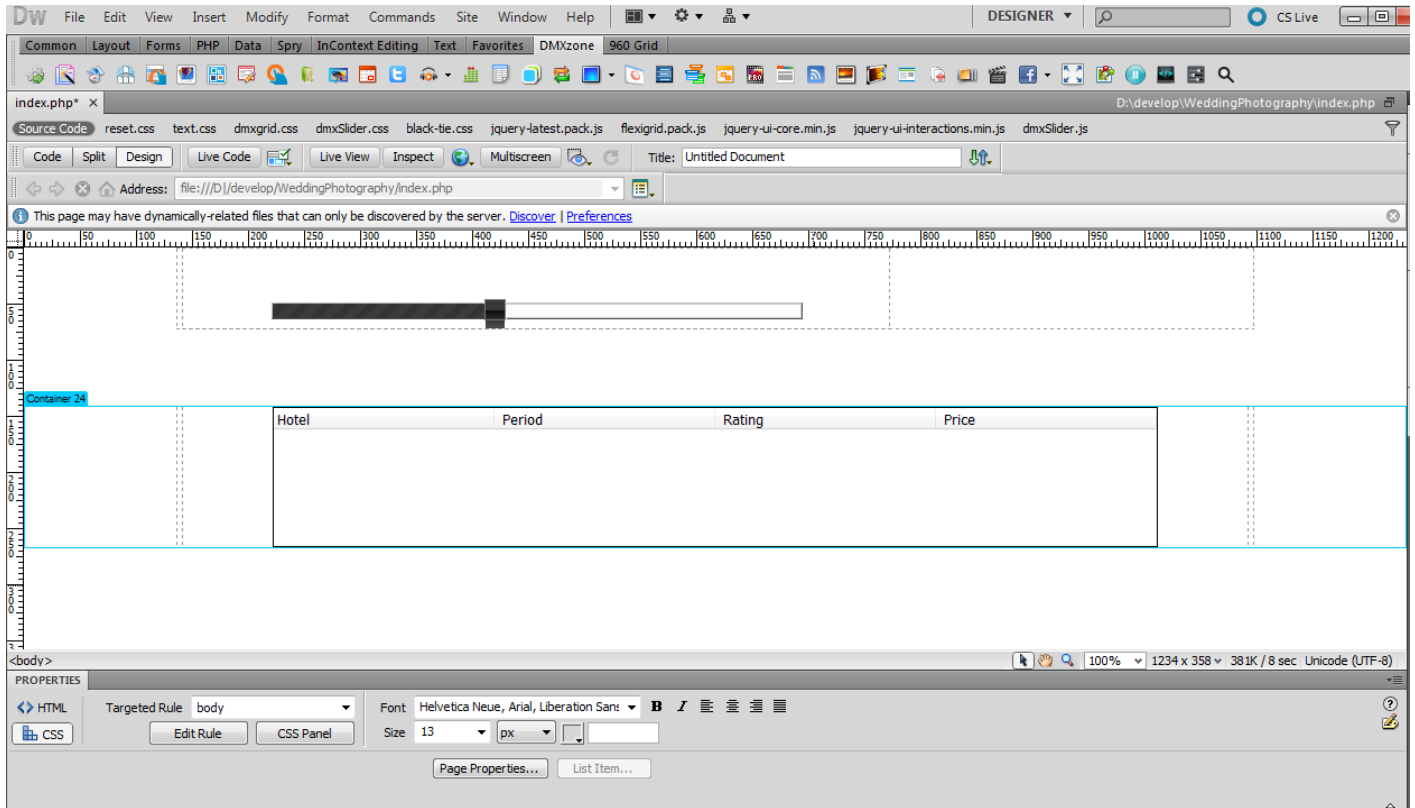
- In the Control Ajax Datagrid window select the **Ajax Datagrid ID (1)** from the **Grid ID menu** and add the **Set grid filter item (2)** from the select action dropdown menu.



- We're going to use the **Price** column in our **Ajax Datagrid (1)** with **<** item as a **condition (2)**, **entered value** as **value (3)** and **##value##** as a **mask (4)** that returns the current value of the handle.



8. Now you can save your work and preview the result in the browser.

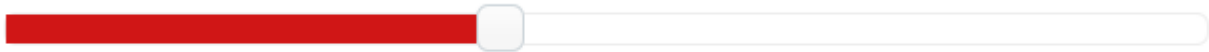

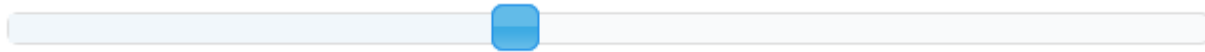

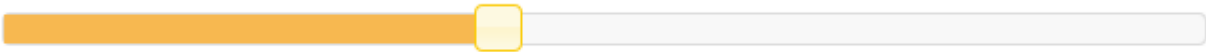
