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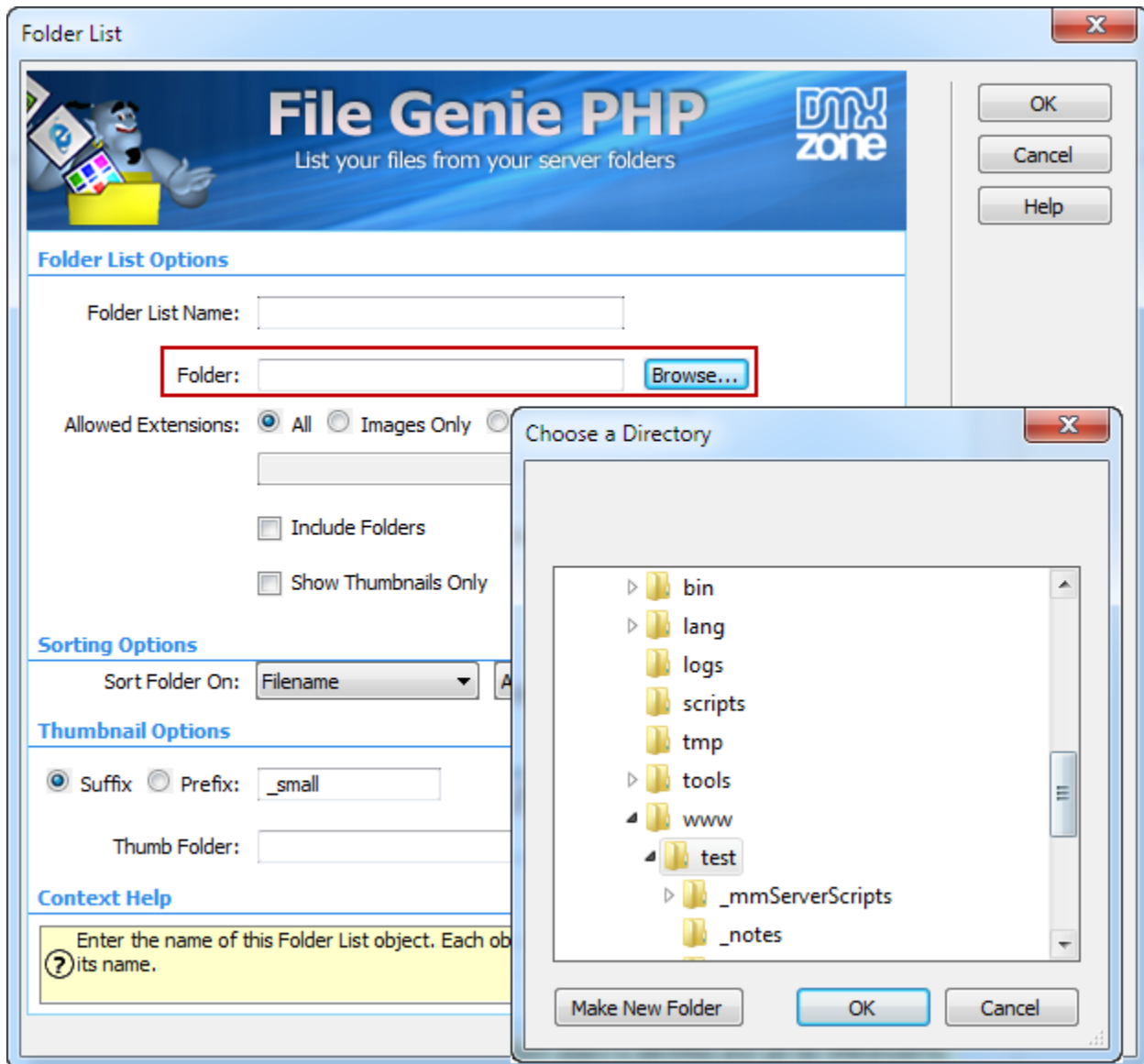
About File Genie PHP/ASP

This suite will allow you to very **easy create web pages containing lists of files** from your server folders. Make web **photo albums on the fly!** Multi column thumbnail views! No need for a database! Use the folderlist as a datasource to list the files. Just select and insert what you want to display on the page. A Folder List Repeater is included with this extension so you can easily make a table with a list of files.

[File Genie PHP/ASP](#) can be used together with [Pure PHP Upload 2](#) and [Pure ASP Upload 3](#) extensions! You don't need to write any additional code, it is all click and use!

Features in Detail

- **Specify any folder on the server as data source in Dreamweaver** - Use the folderlist as a datasource to list the files. Just select and insert what you want to display on the page.




- **Automatically list the files in your folders** -Now you can list a folder with files on your web page.


- **List only the thumbnails from a folder** - Just select the thumbnail image from the datasource and insert in your page.

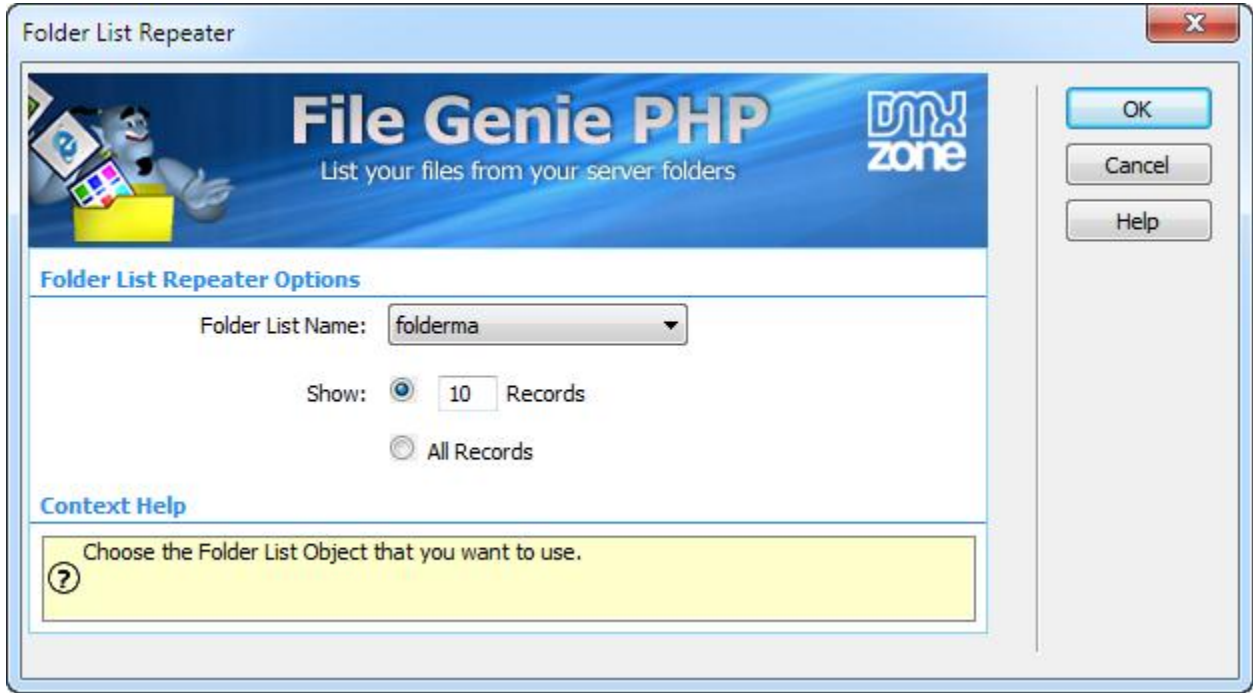

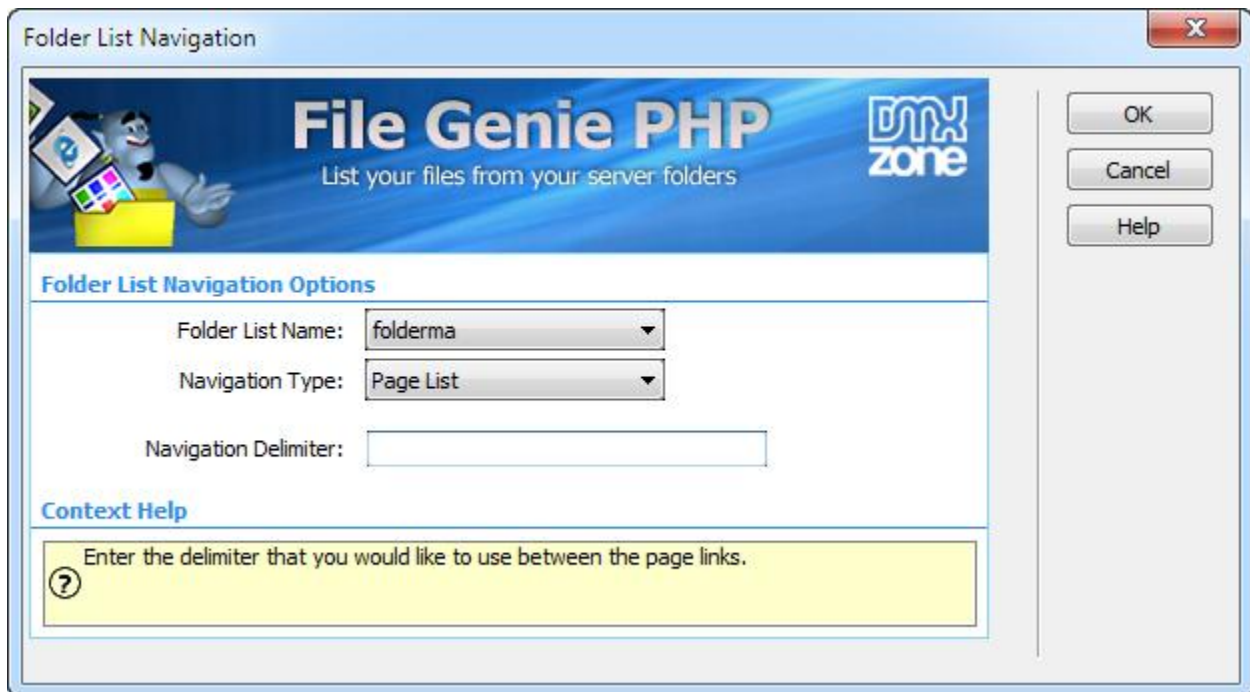

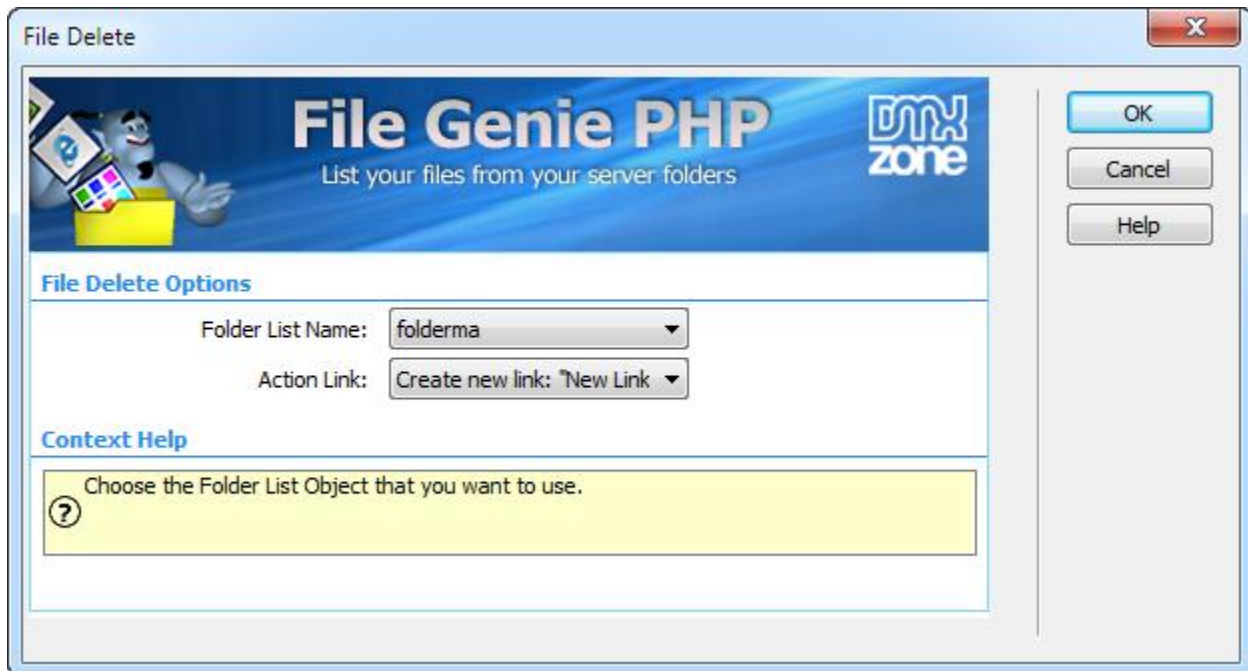
- **Repeat a list of files** - A Folder List Repeater is included with this extension so you can easily make a table with a list of files.



- **Folder List Navigation** - List the uploaded files and create navigation through multiple pages.



- **Horizontal Repeating is also supported! Make now lists also in multiple columns** - Create a web photo album with the images on your server. Use the special horizontal repeat behavior that is shipped with this extension.
- **Display files with properties** - Display your uploaded files with the name, size, date, etc.
- **Delete Files Server Behavior to manage your files** - A Delete Server Behavior is included so you can make a list of your files with links to delete files on the server.



- **Translators are supplied** - To map all produced code into nice visual elements in Dreamweaver

- **Great Dreamweaver integration** - Interactive dialog in Dreamweaver with all the options you'll need.


Open the .mxp file (the extension manager should start-up) and install the extension.

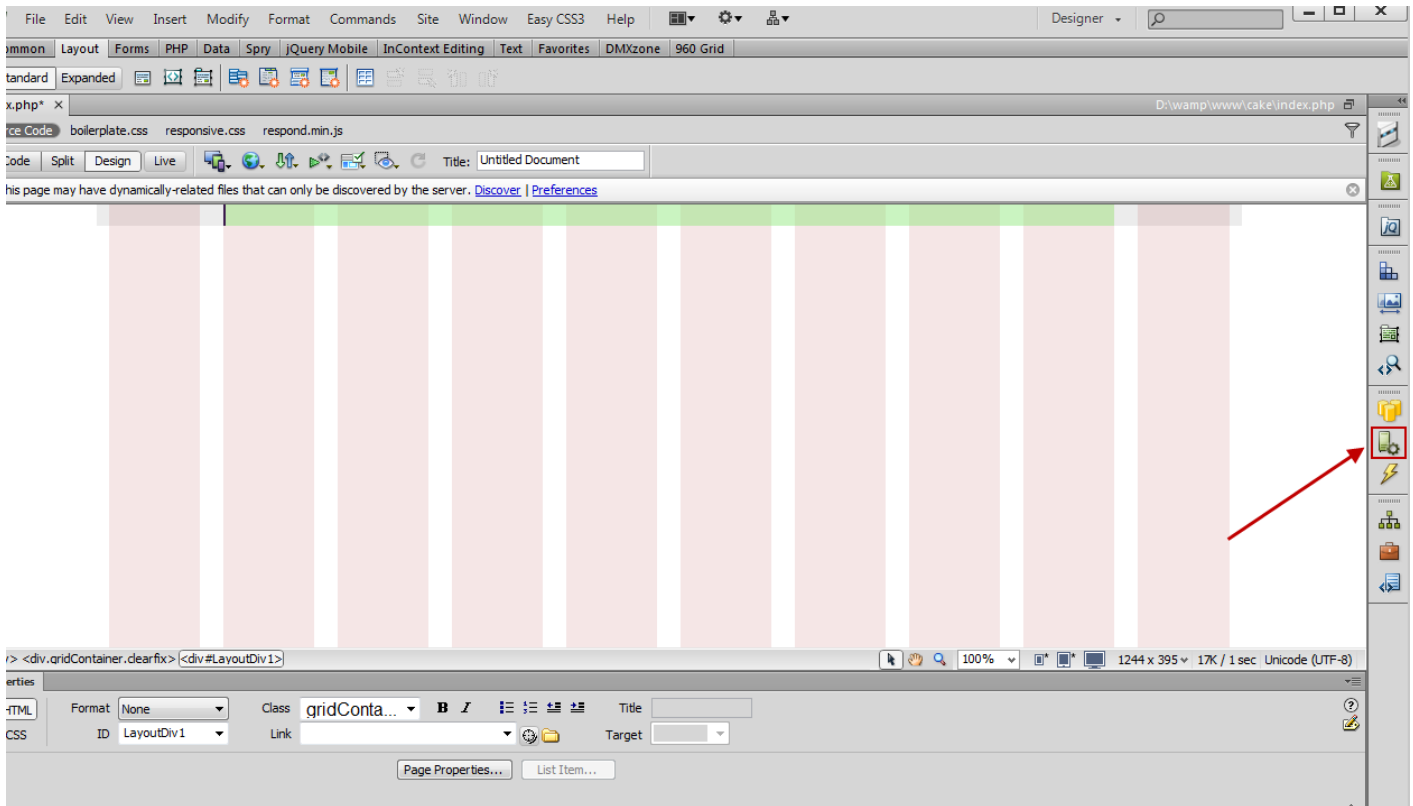

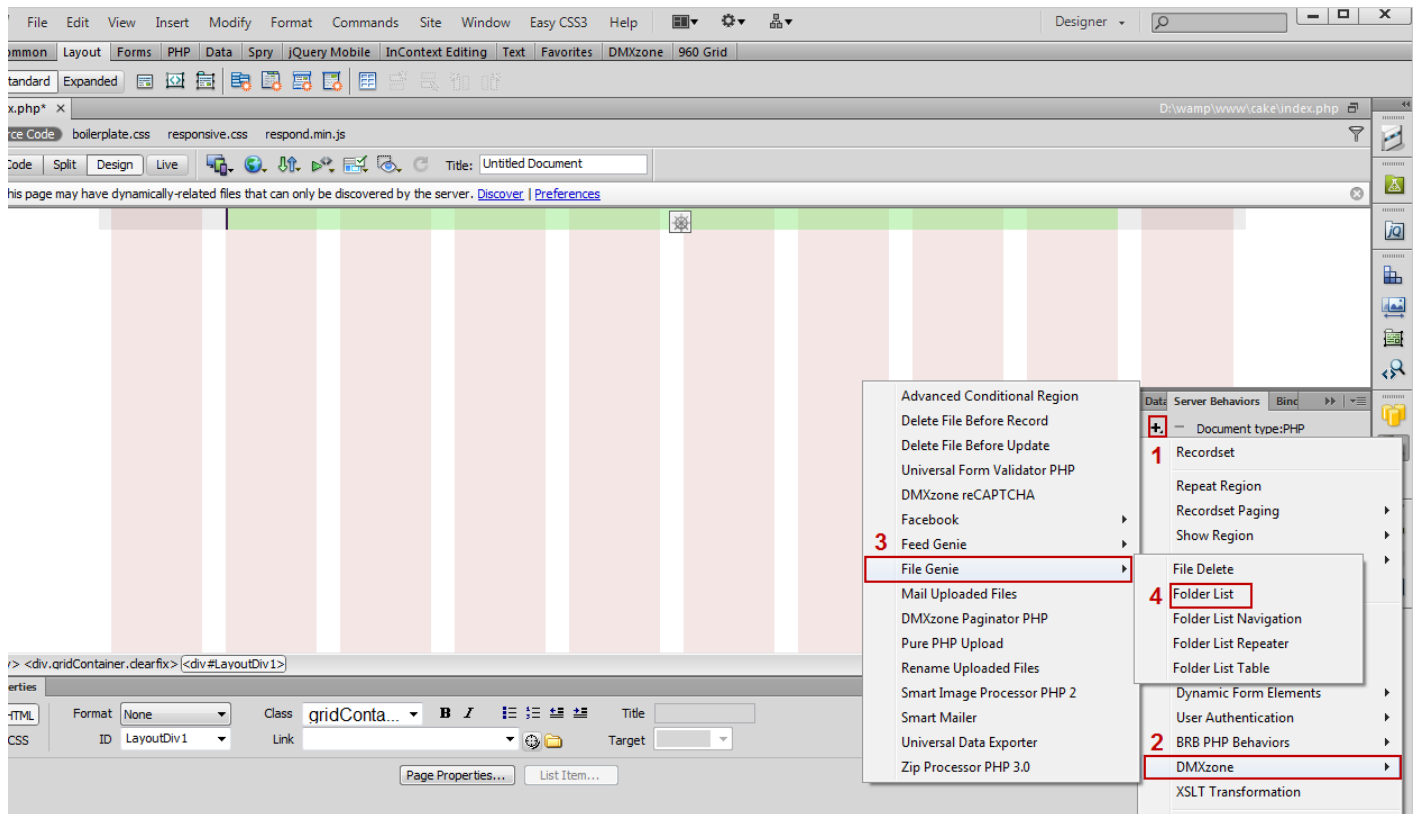

How to do it

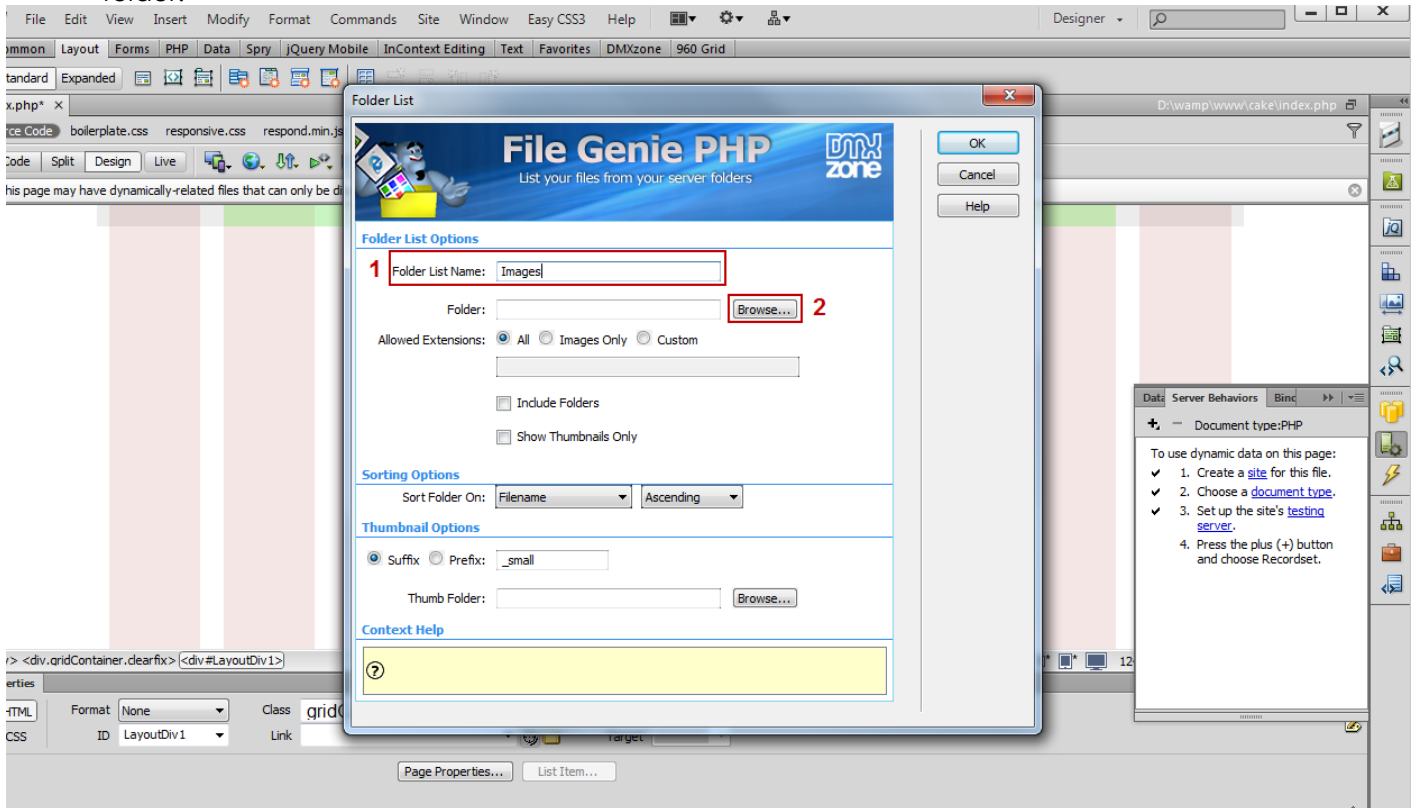
1. Click the **Server Behaviors** button in Dreamweaver.



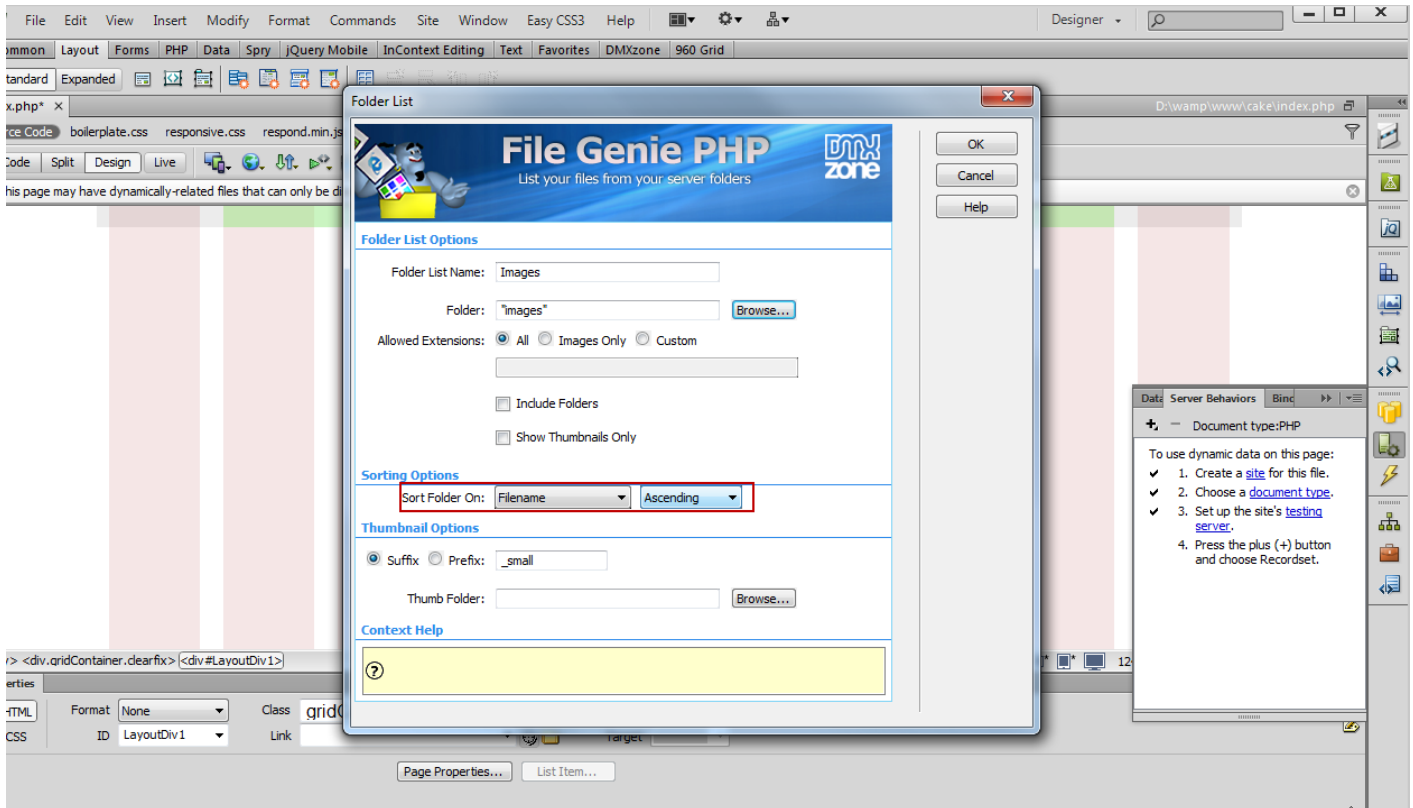
2. Click the **Add item** button (1), select the **DMXzone menu** item (2) and from the **File Genie menu** (3), choose the **Folder List** menu (4).



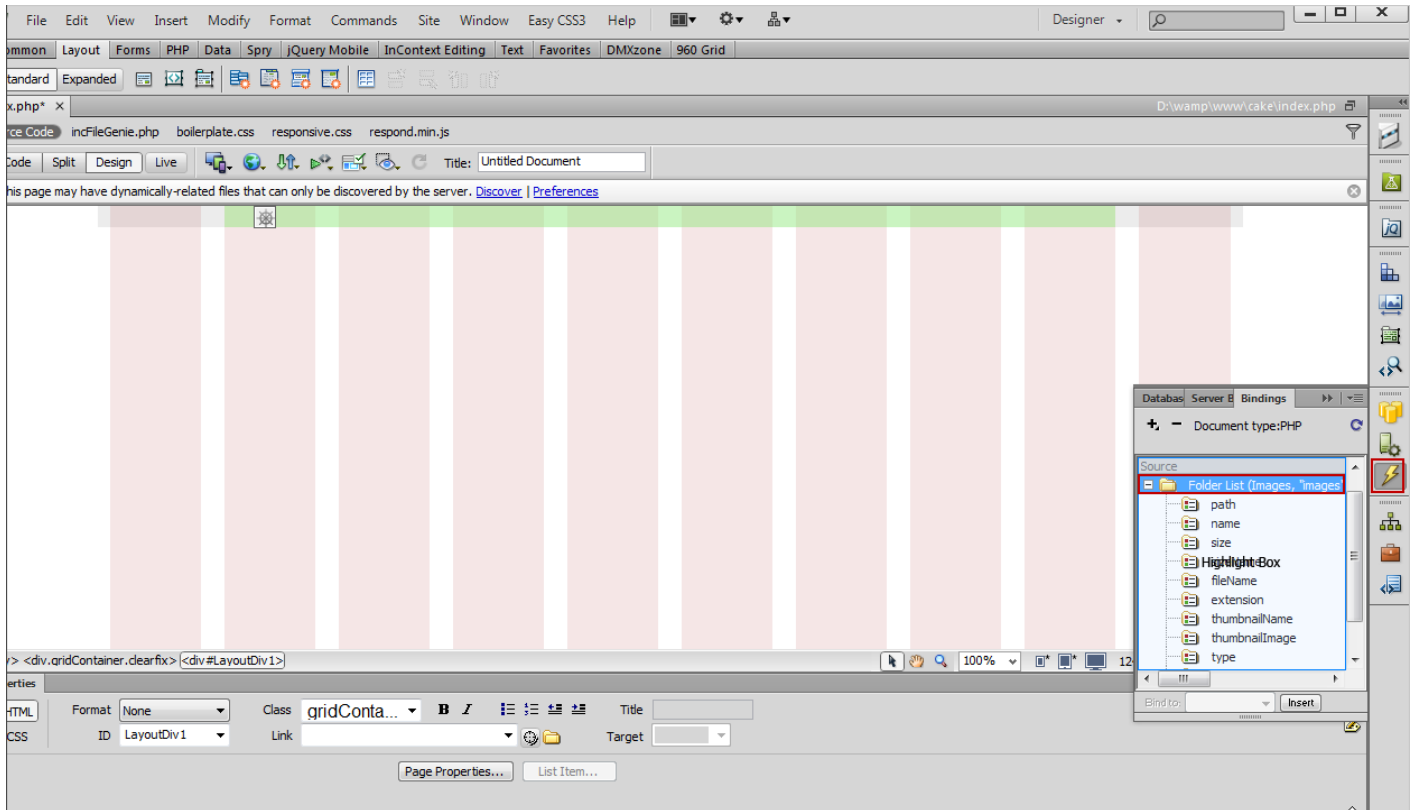
3. In the **Folder List** window, enter a name for your list (1) and from the **Browse** button (2) select your folder.



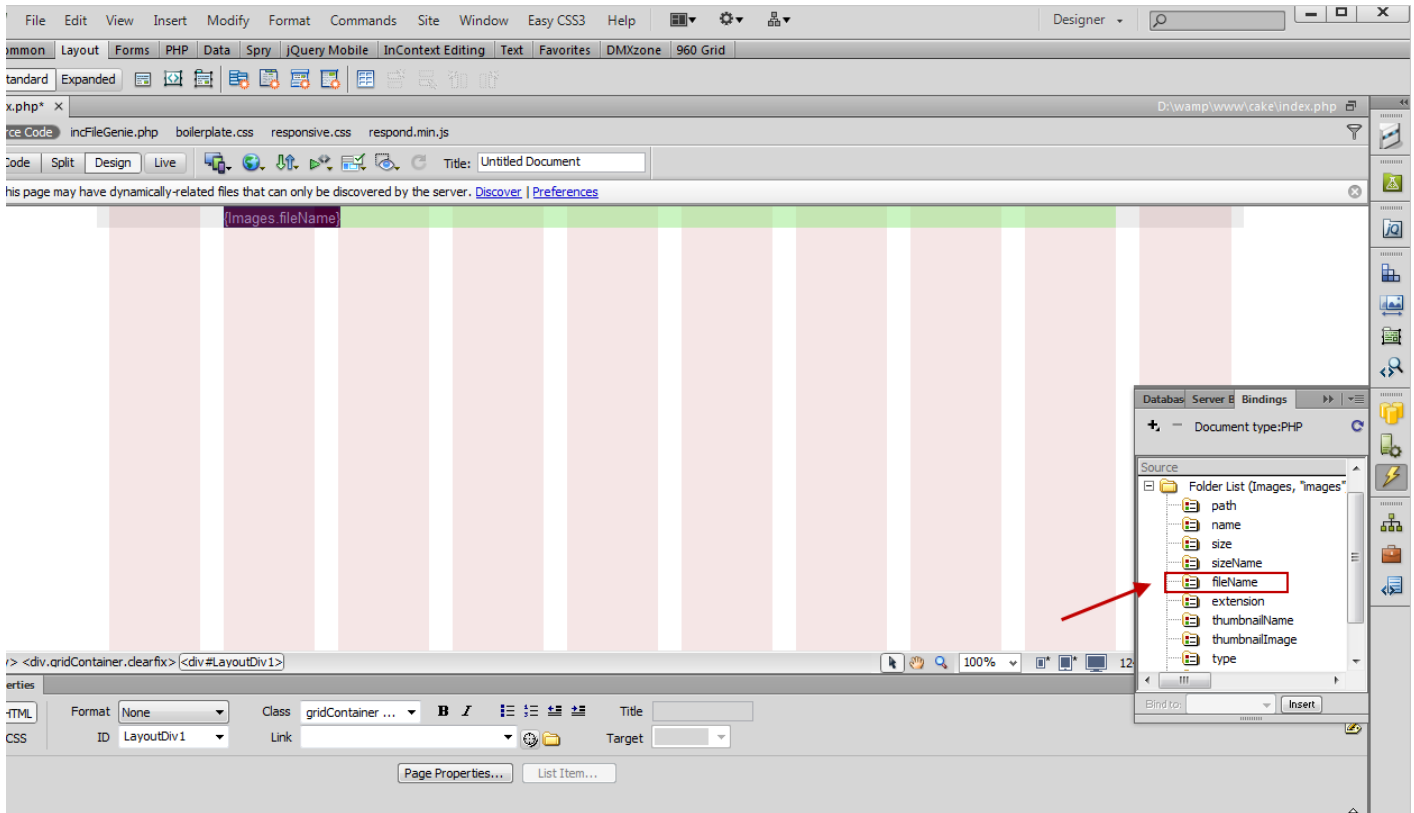
4. We will sort our files on **Filename** and select **Ascending**. When you're done click OK.



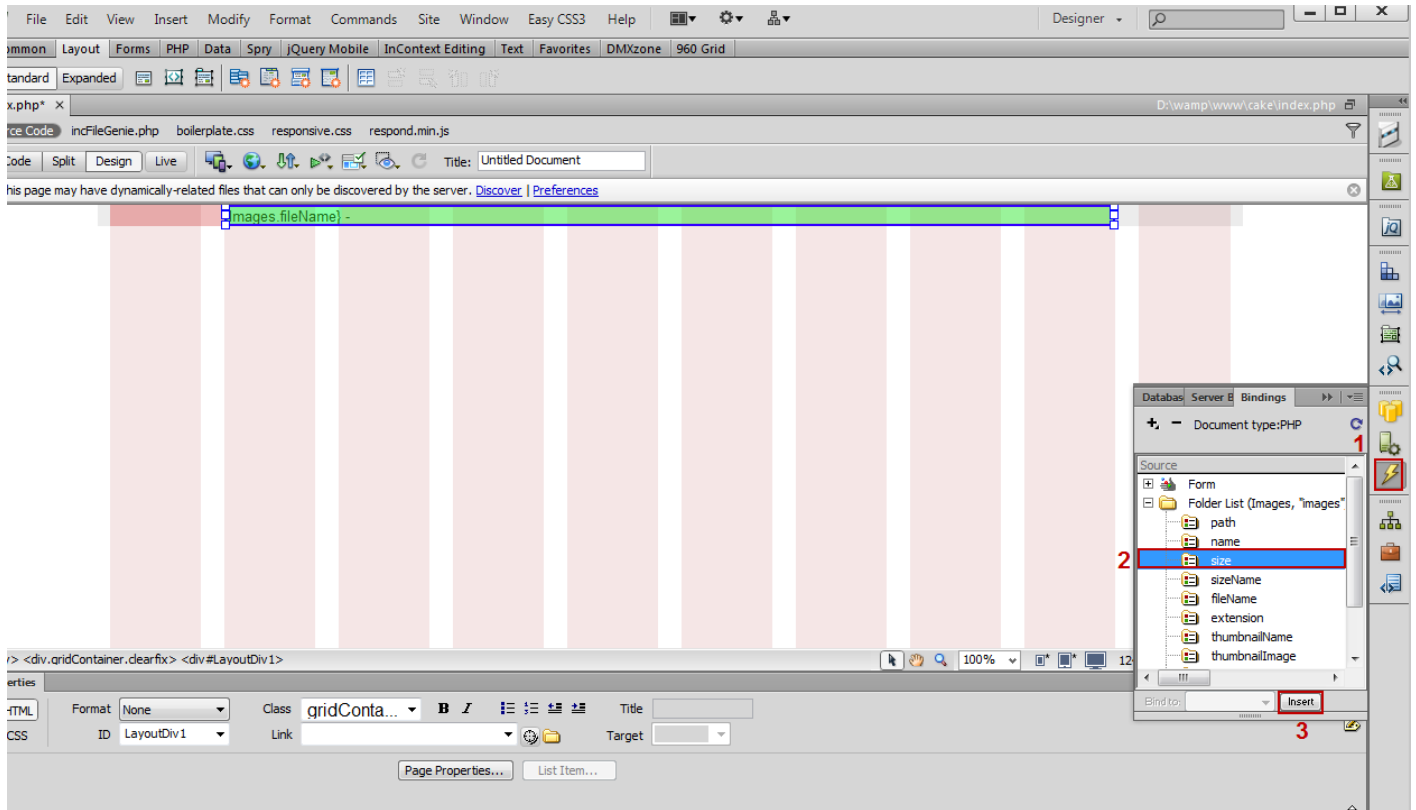
5. In the **Bindings** menu you will find all the **Bindings** under the **Folder List** menu.



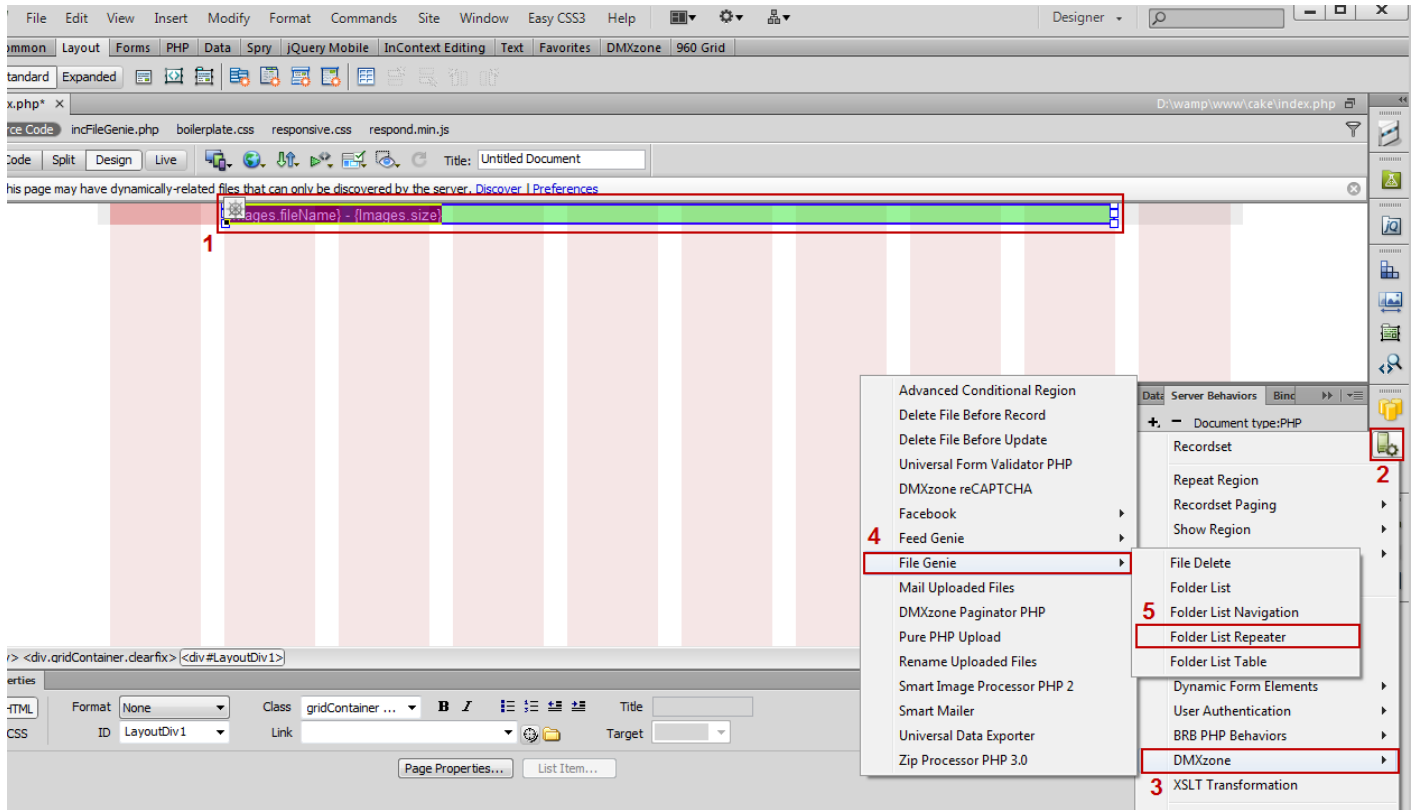
6. Select the **fileName** Binding and now, we're going to add the size of the file.



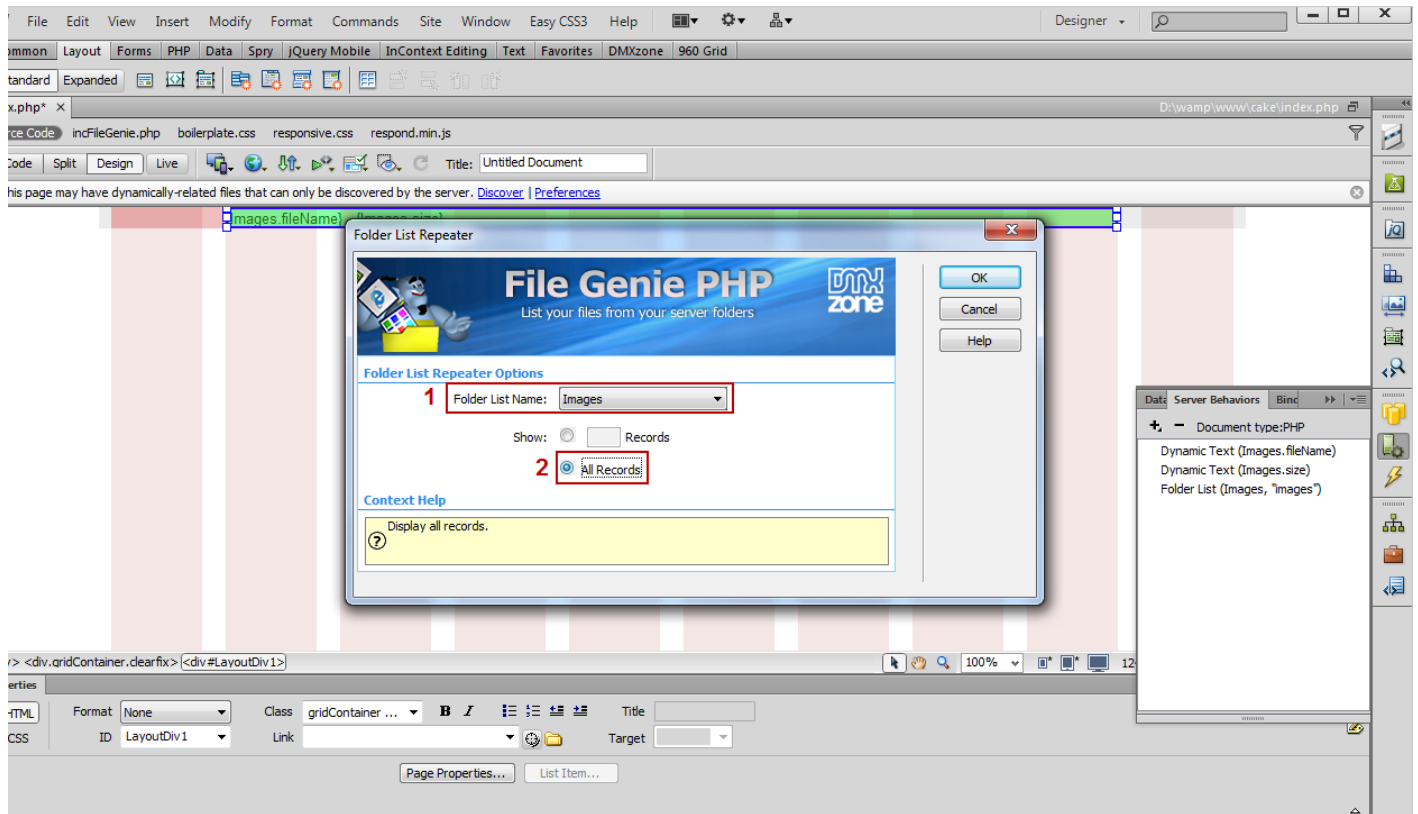
7. Click the **Bindings** button (1), select the **size** Binding (2) and click the **insert** button (3).



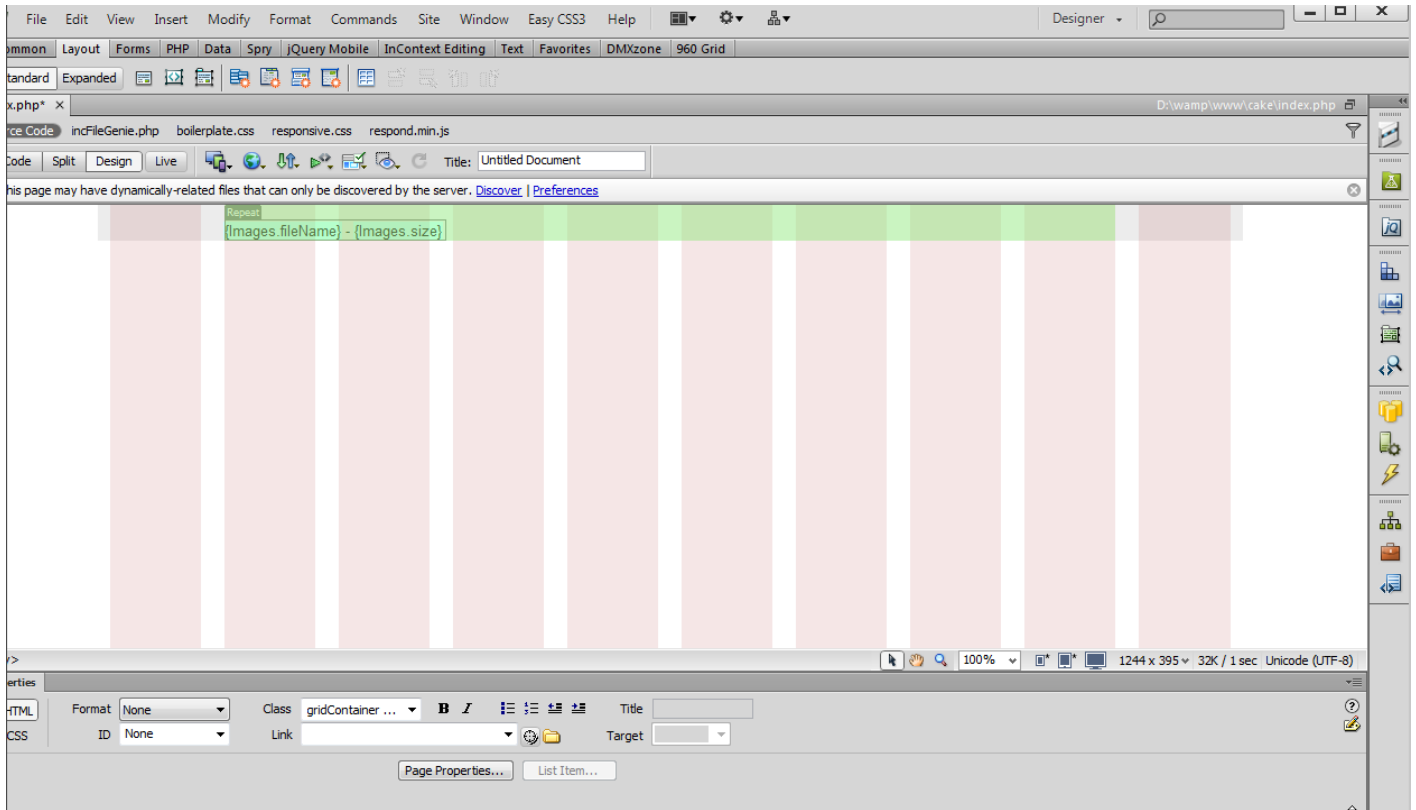
8. Select **both Bindings** that we've added (1), click the **Server behavior button** (2), click the **Add item button** (3), and from the **DMXzone Menu item** (3), choose the **File Genie menu item** (4). We will use the **Folder List Repeater** (5).



9. In the **Folder List Repeater** window, select the **Folder List Name (1)** that we've created and choose **All records to be displayed (2)**.



10. Now you can save your work and preview the results in your browser.

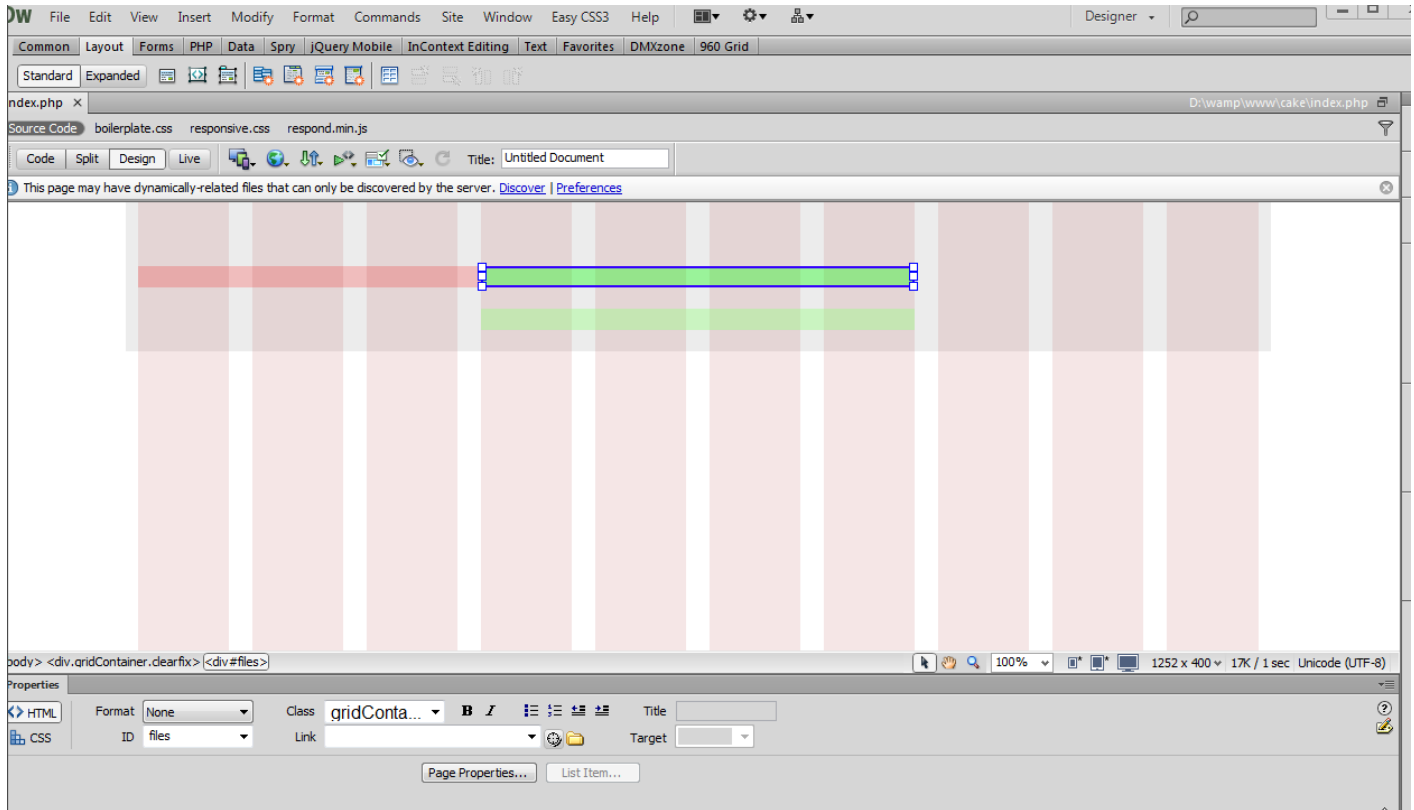

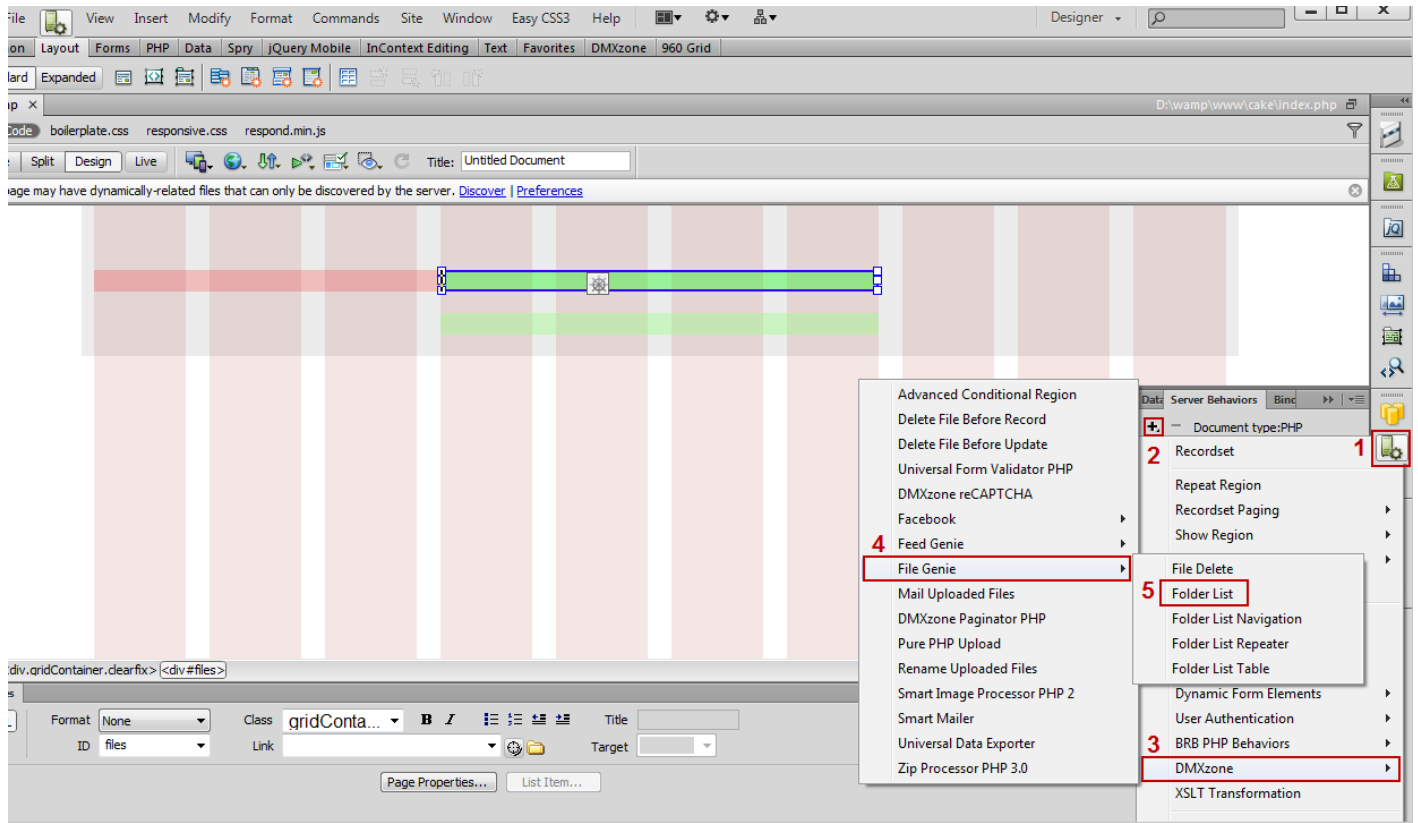

How to do it

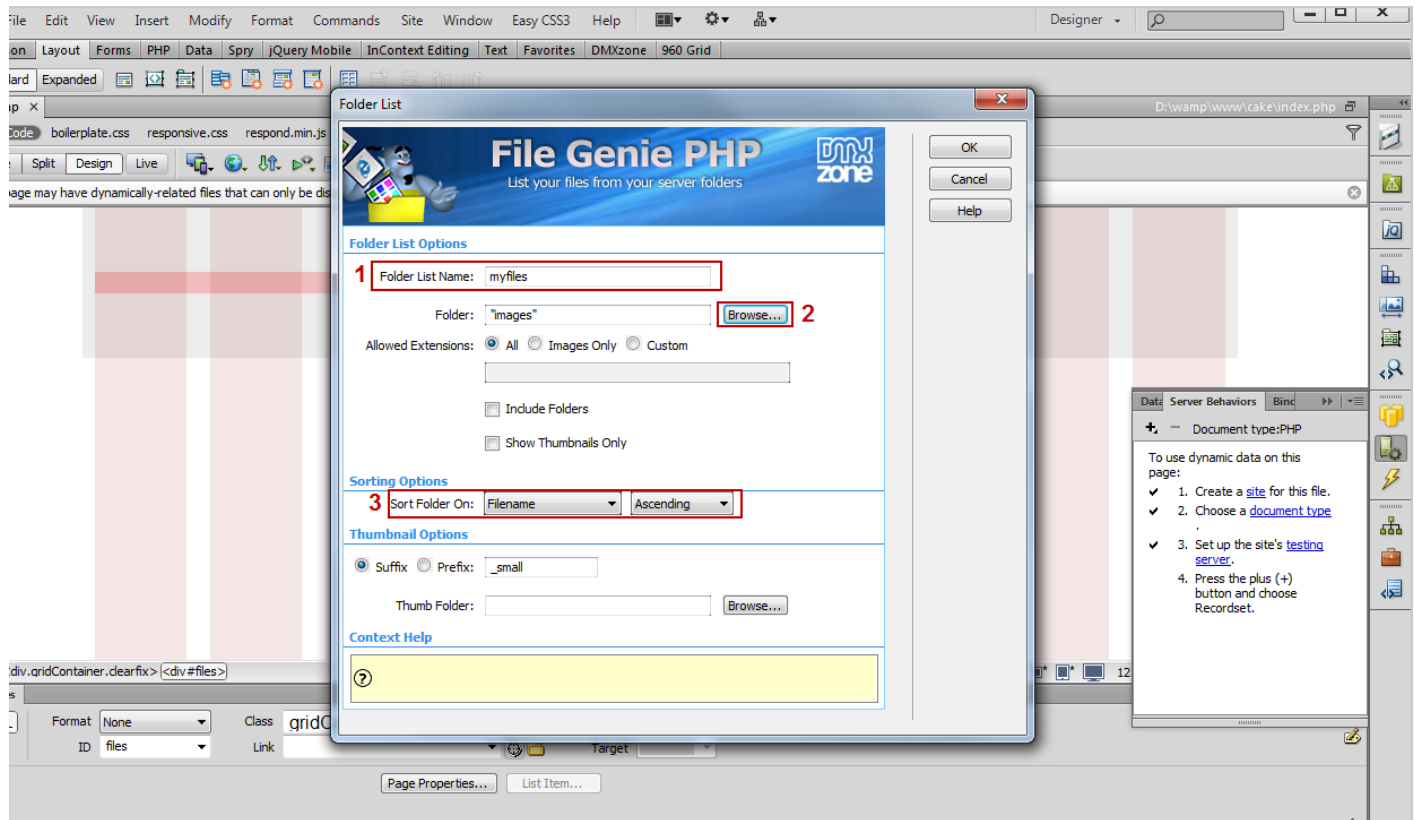
1. We are going to create a folder list and add a folder list repeater.



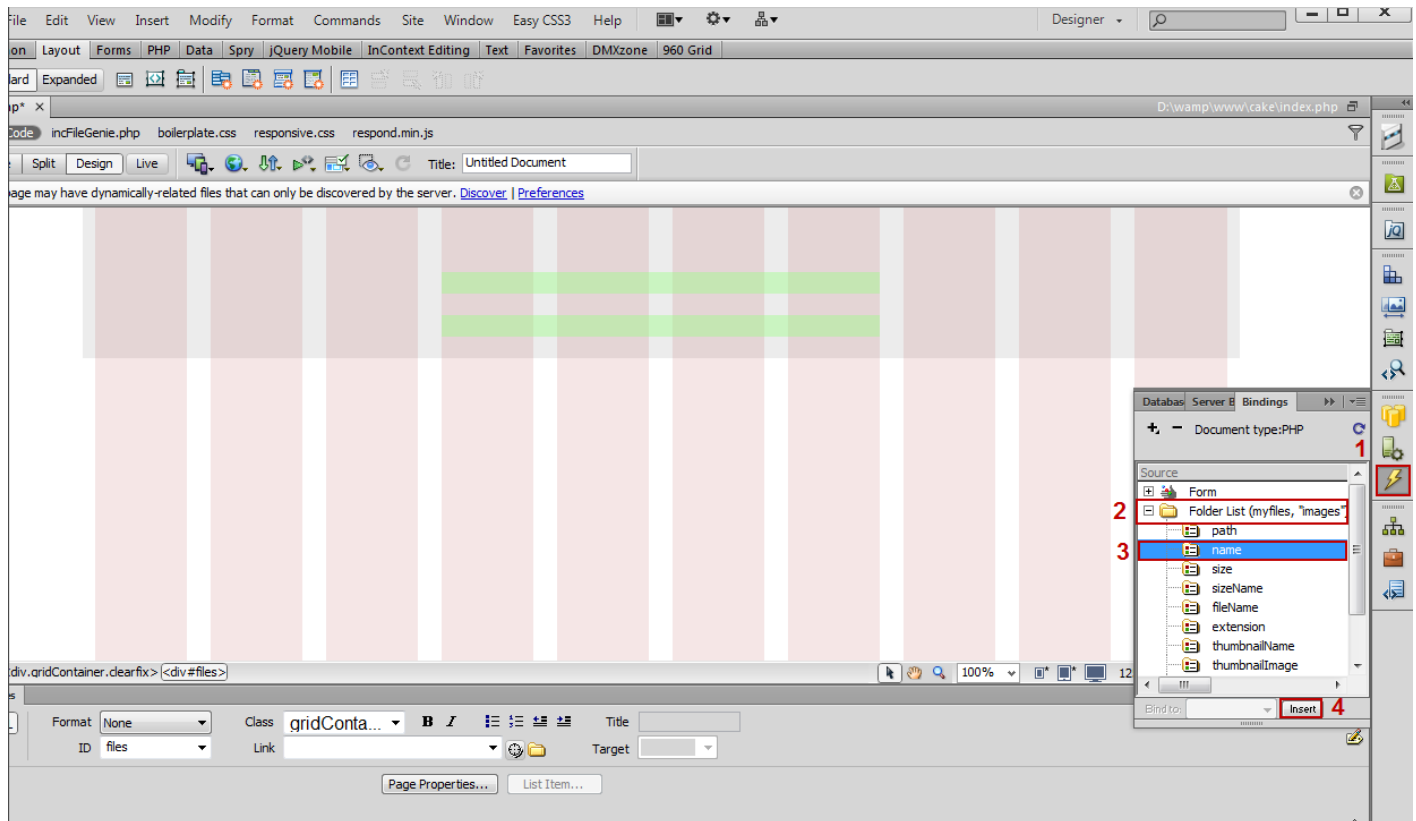
2. From the **Server Behaviors** menu (1), click the **Add item button** (2), select the **DMXzone** Menu item (3) and choose **File Genie** (4) **Folder List** menu item (5).



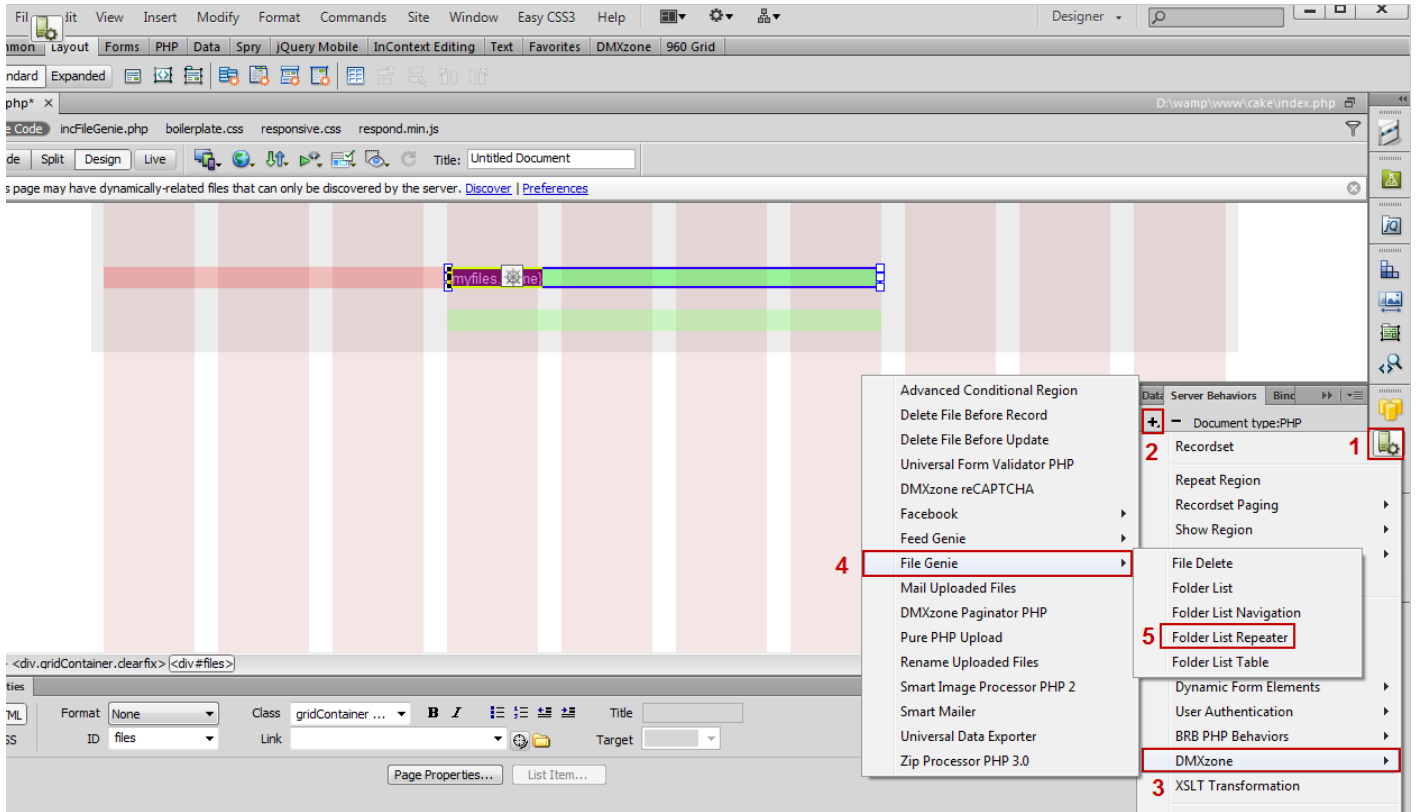
3. In the Folder List window, add **a name for the folder list (1)**, select it from the **browse button (2)** and choose a **sorting option (3)**.



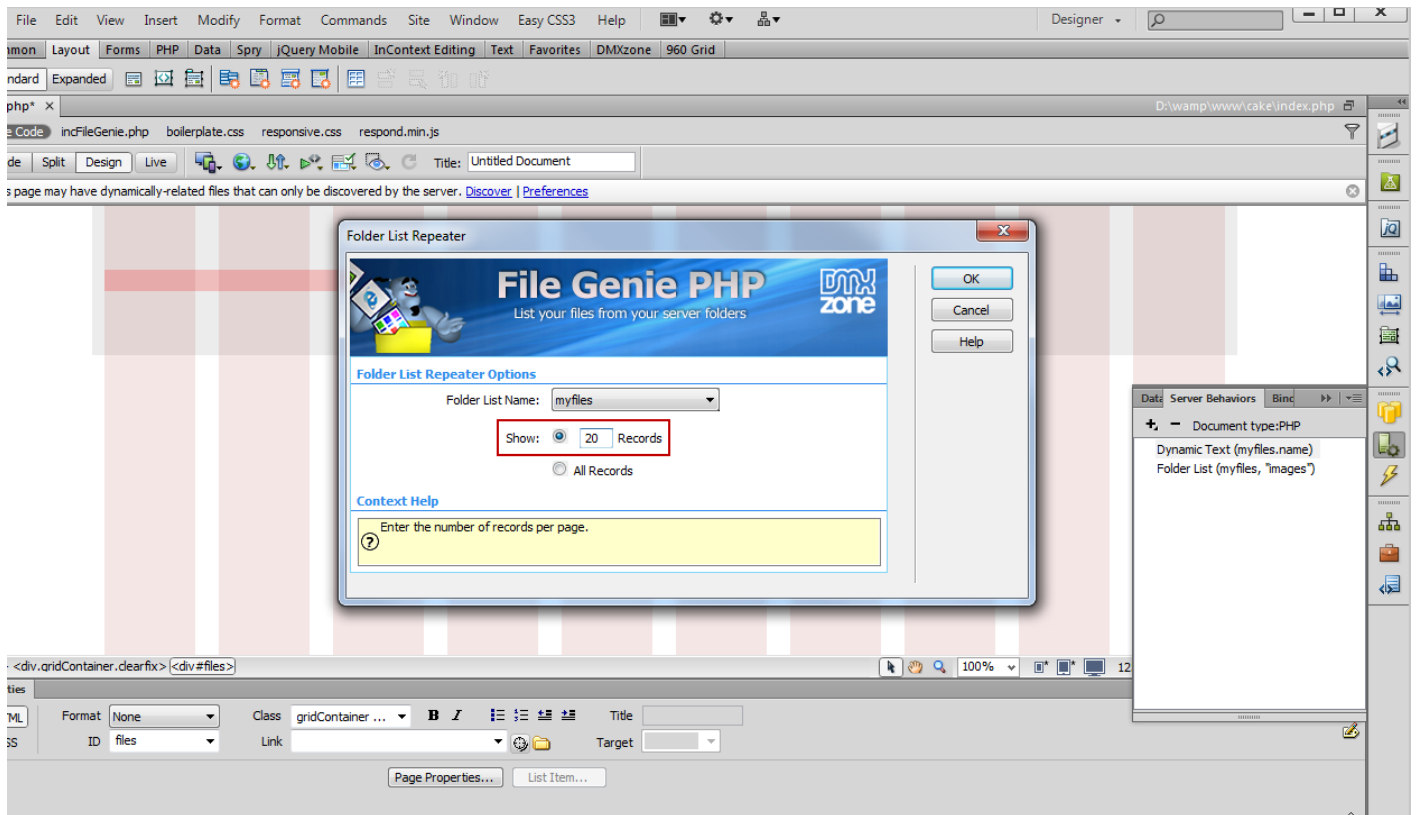
4. Under the **Bindings (1)** find your **Folder list (2)**, select the **Name Binding (3)** and **click Insert (4)**.



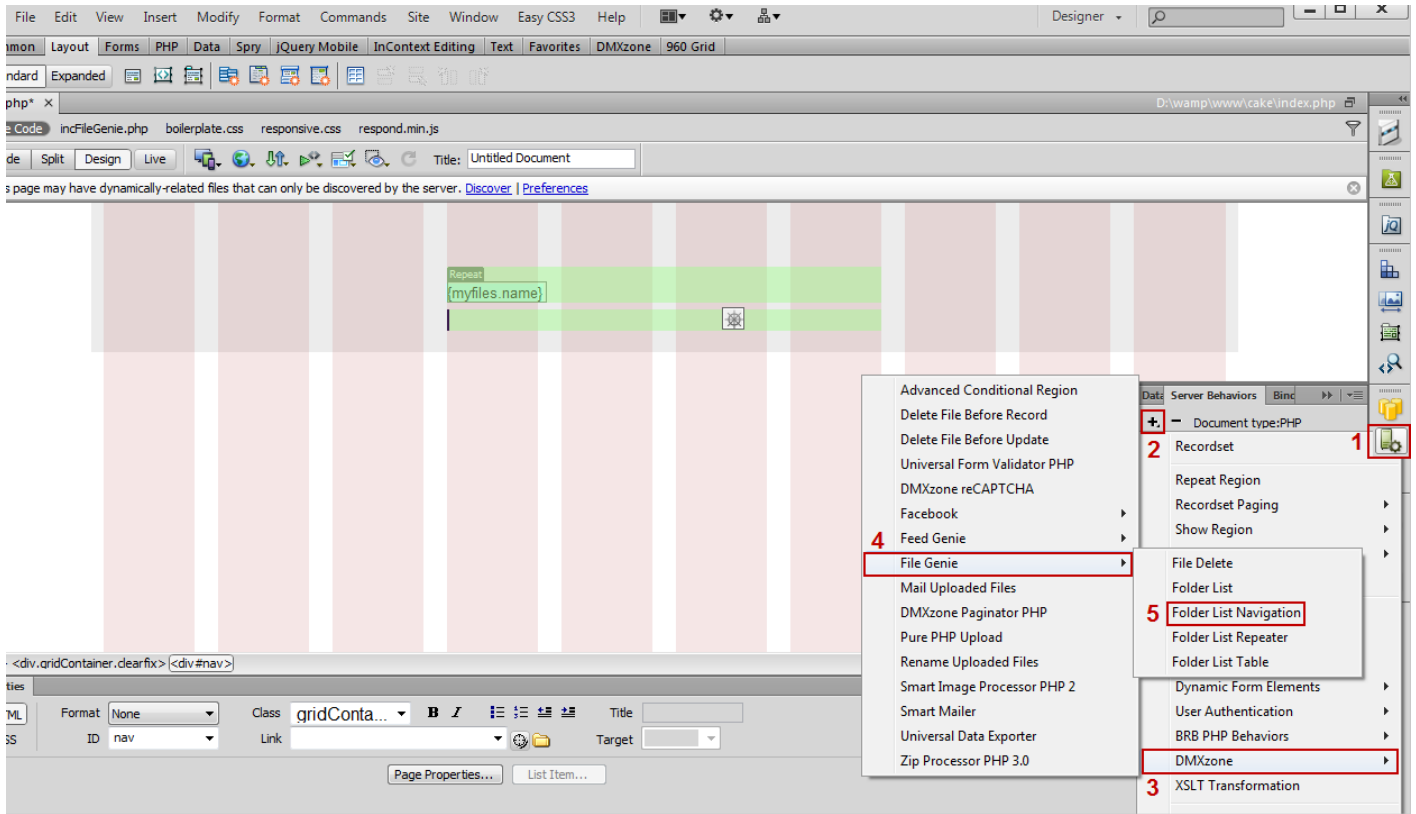
5. From the **Server Behaviors** menu (1), click the **Add item button** (2), select the **DMXzone Menu** item (3) and choose **File Genie** (4) **Folder List Repeater** item (5).



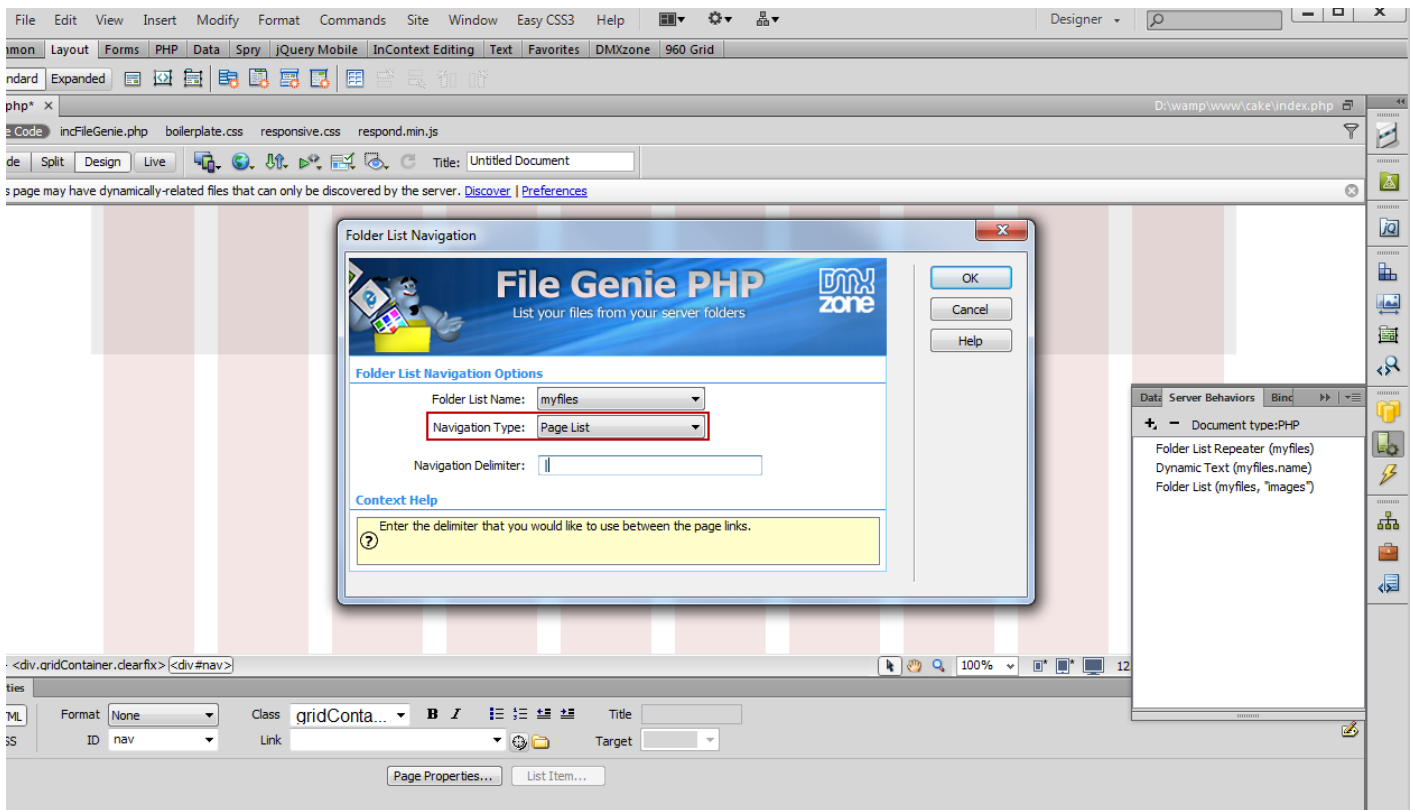
6. In the Folder List Repeater window, add **20 files to be listed on your page** and click OK.



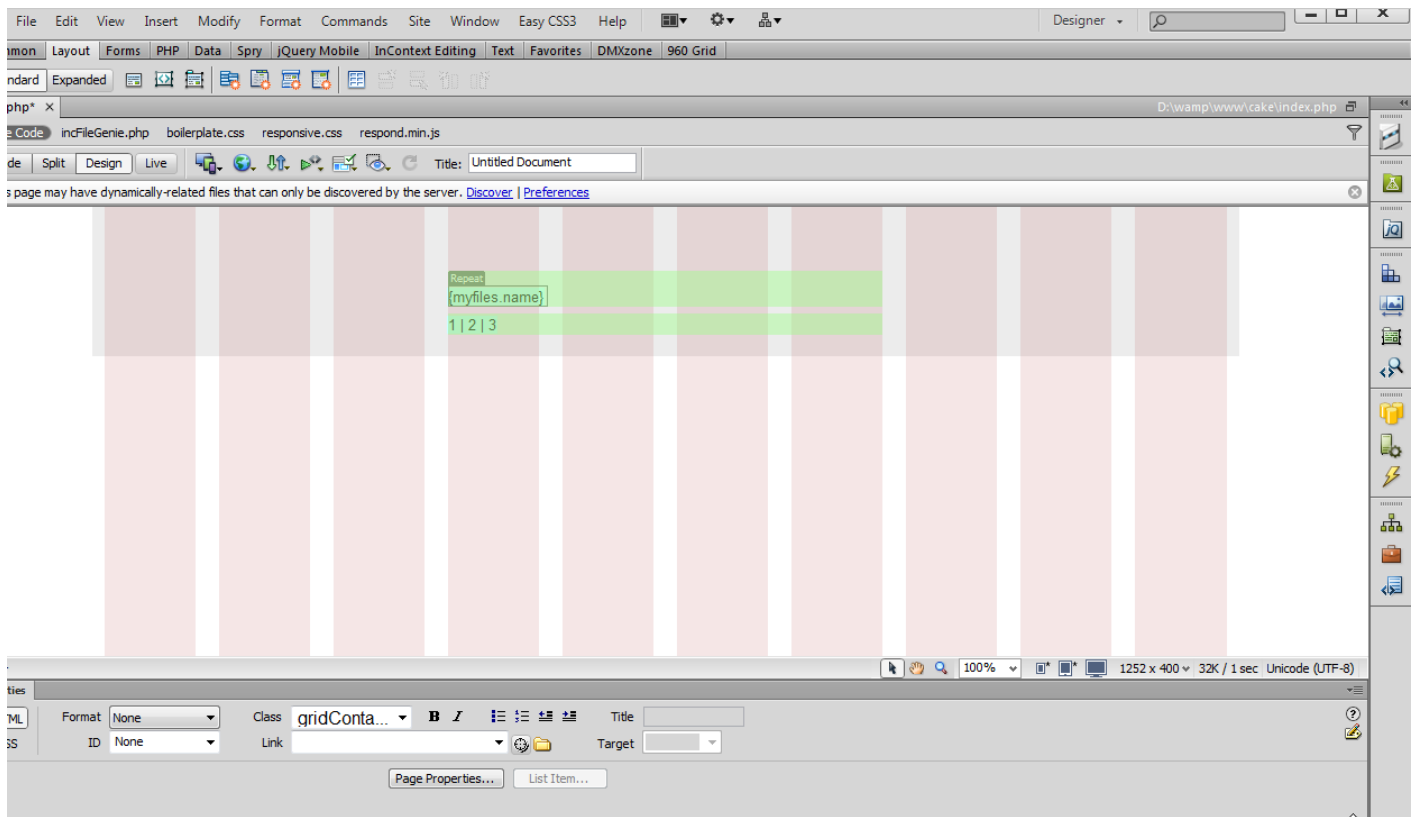
- Now we are going to add the **Folder List Navigation** so we can browse through all of our files. From the **Server Behaviors** menu (1), click the **Add item button** (2), select the **DMXzone Menu item** (3) and choose **File Genie** (4) **Folder List Navigation** item (5).



- In the Folder List Navigation window, select the **Navigation type – page list** and click OK. You can also add a custom navigation delimiter if you want.



9. Now you can save your work and preview the result in the browser.

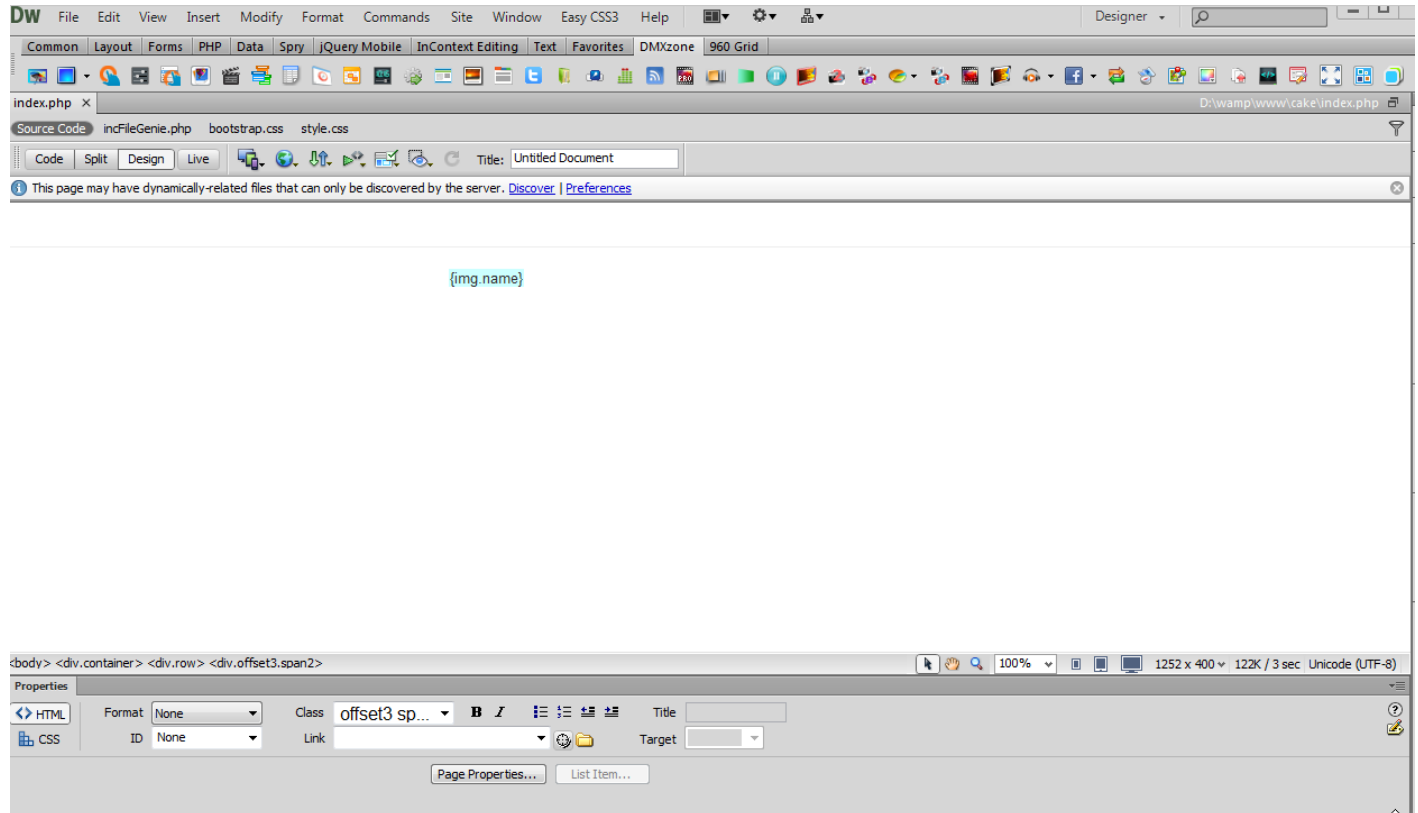

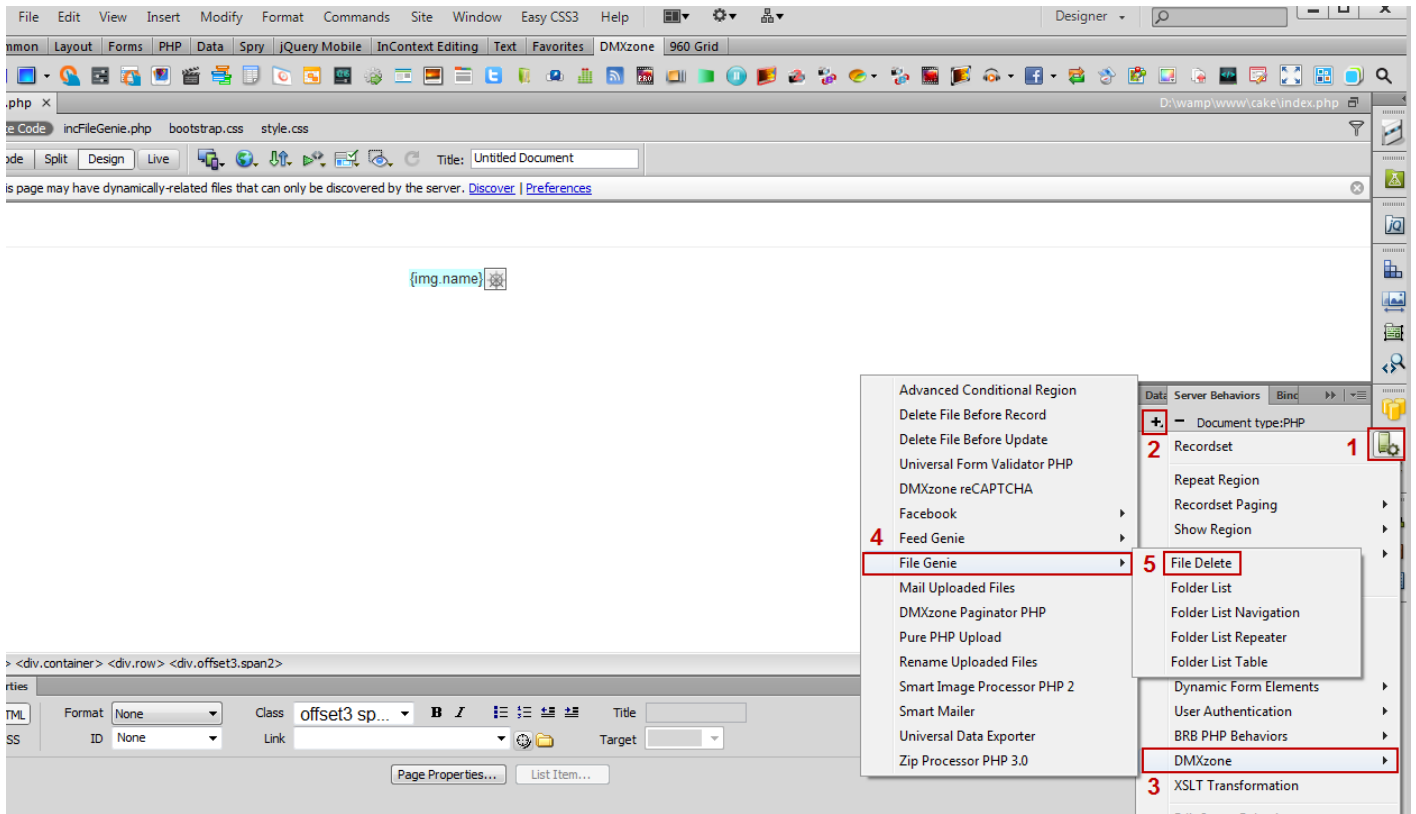

How to do it

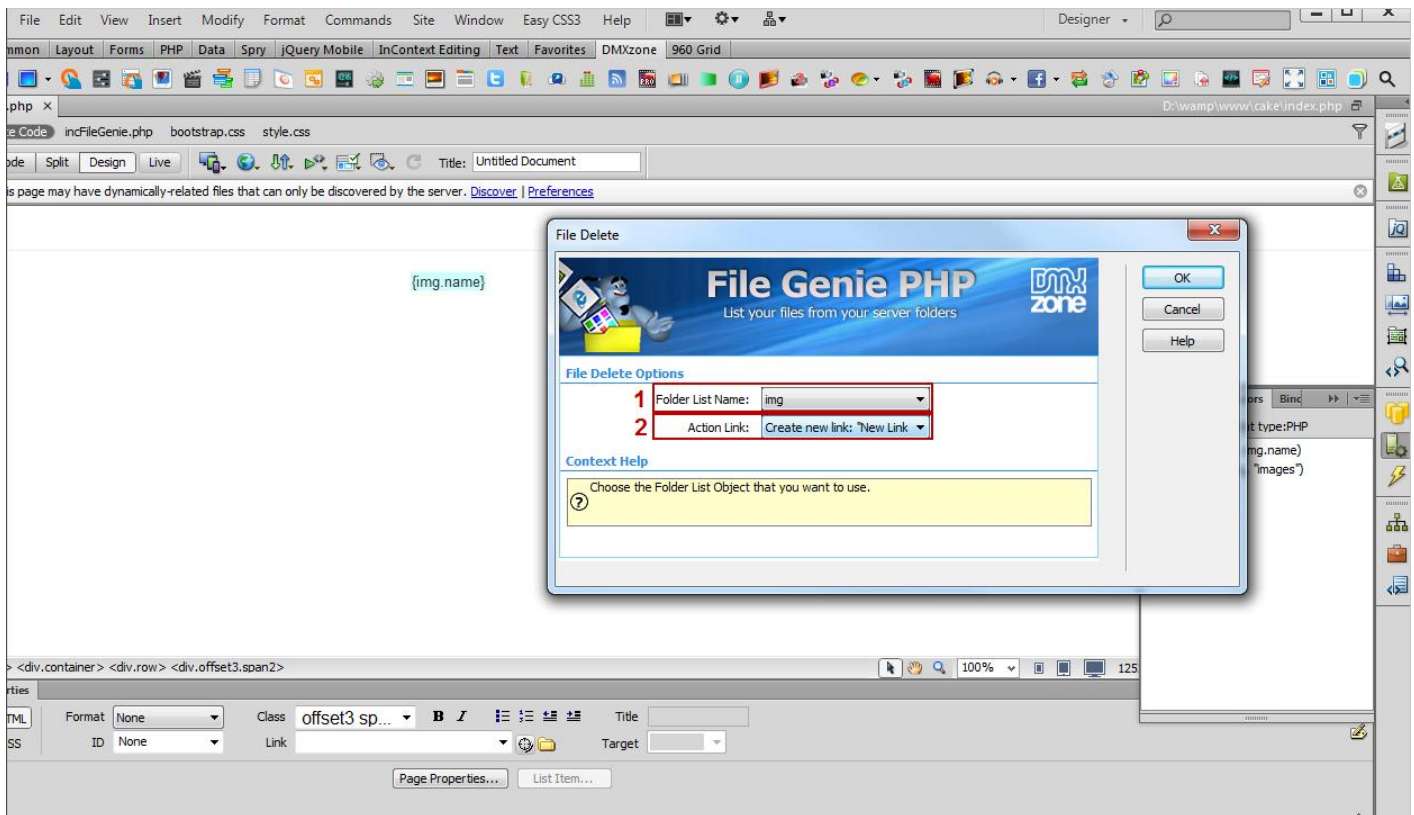
1. We've already created a **Folder List** and added the **Name Binding** on our page. We want to have a delete button next to each of the listed files.



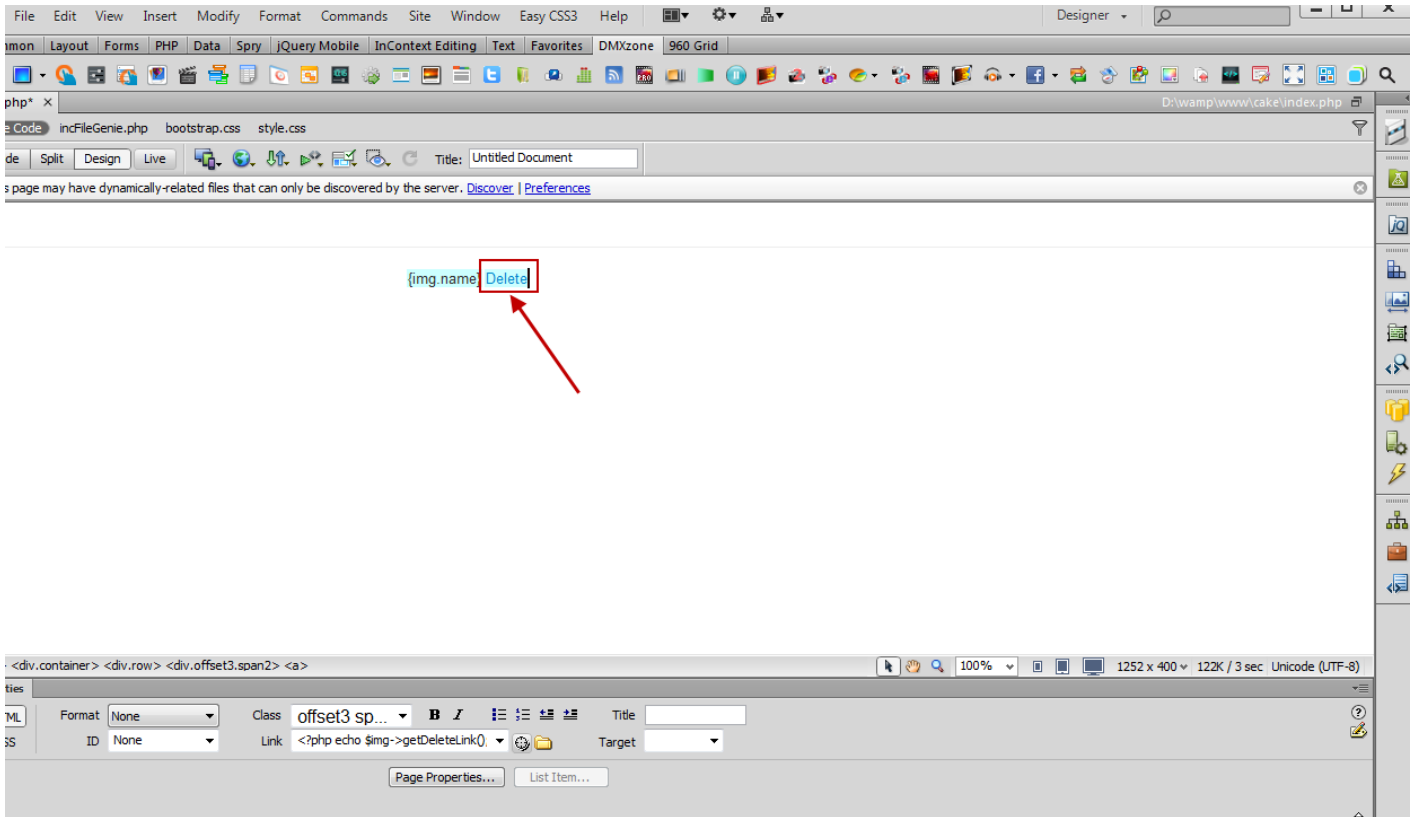
2. From the **Server Behaviors** menu (1), click the **Add item button** (2), select the **DMXzone Menu item** (3) and choose **File Genie** (4) **Delete file menu item** (5).



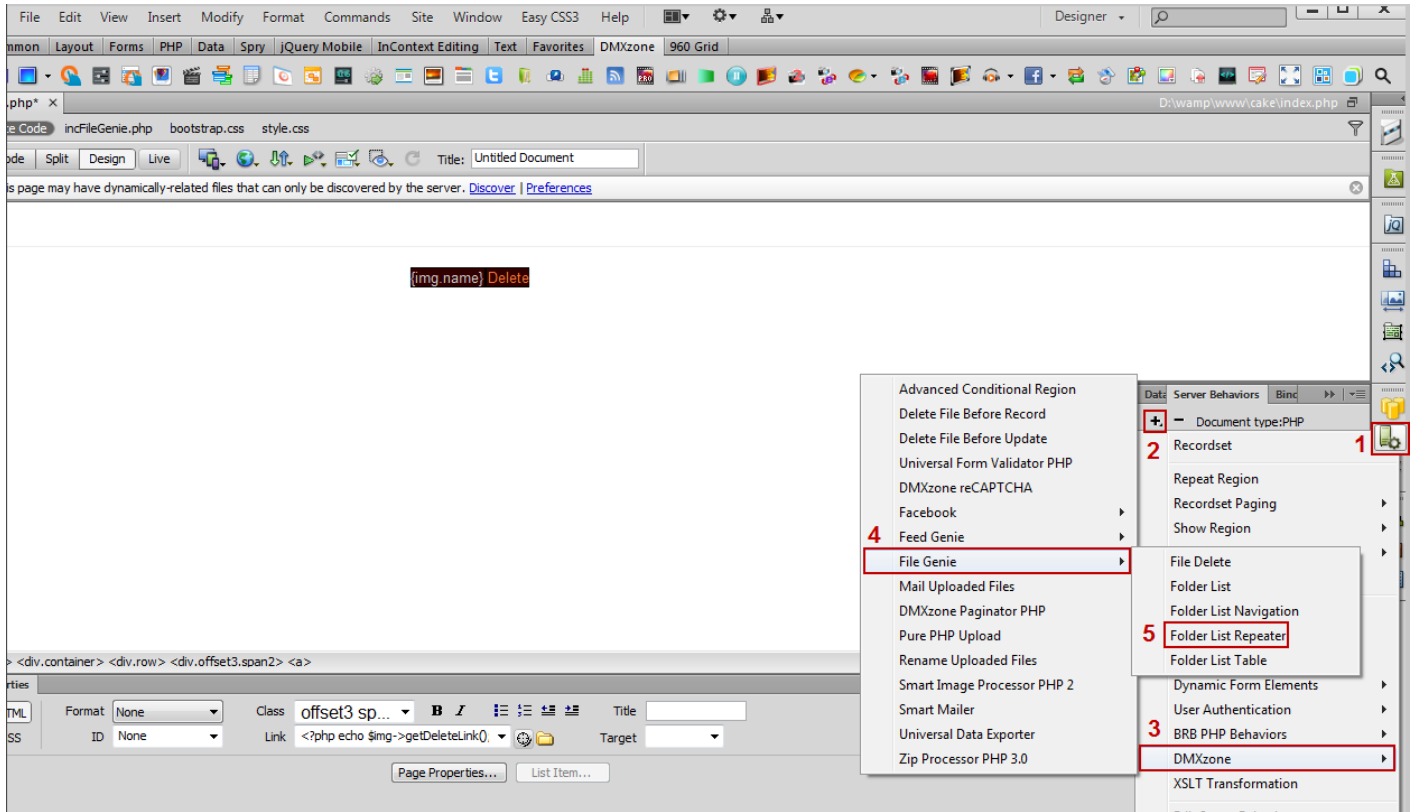
3. In the File Delete window, select the **file list name (1)**. As we don't have any link created on our page we are going to use the **Create a New Link option (2)**.



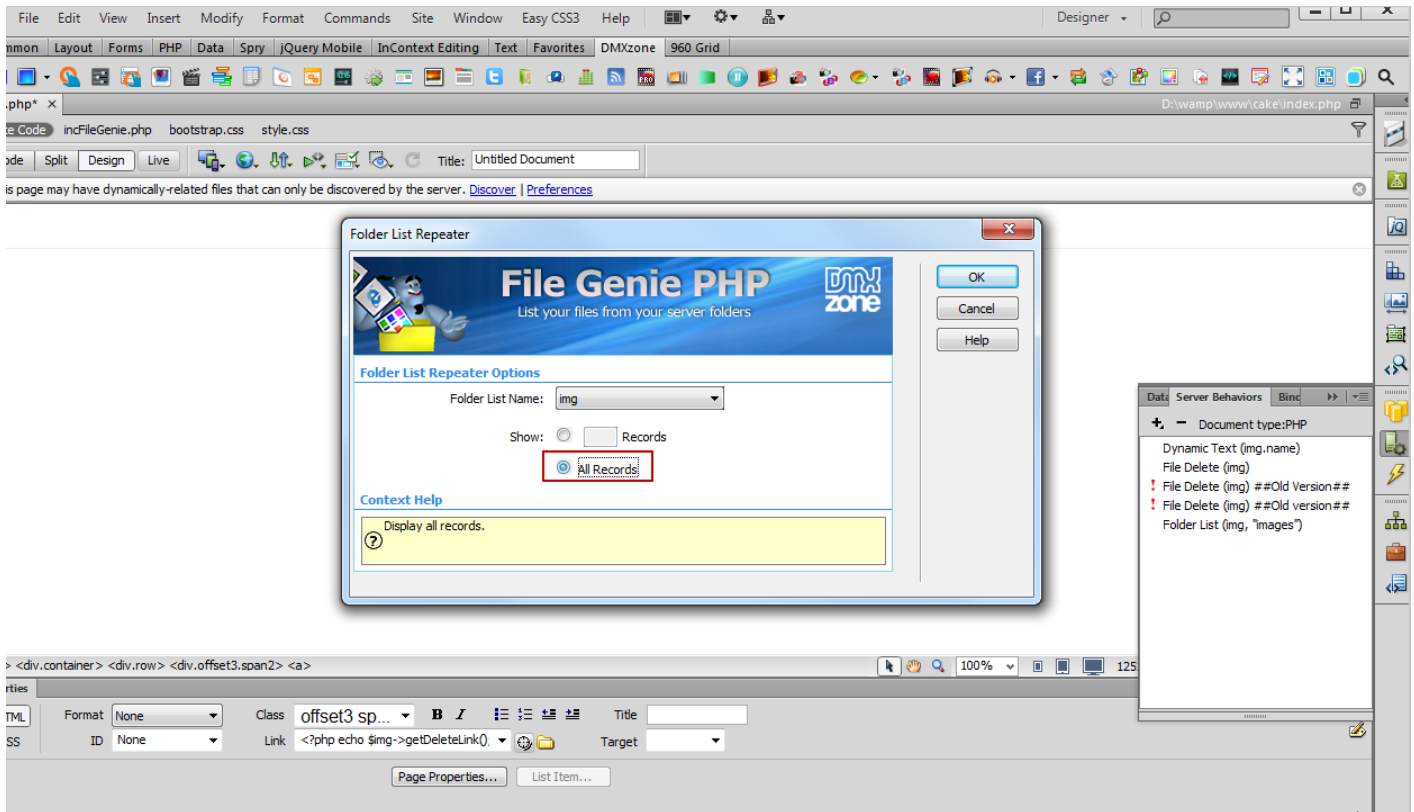
4. Here is the link that File Genie just created. We are going to change the text to "delete".



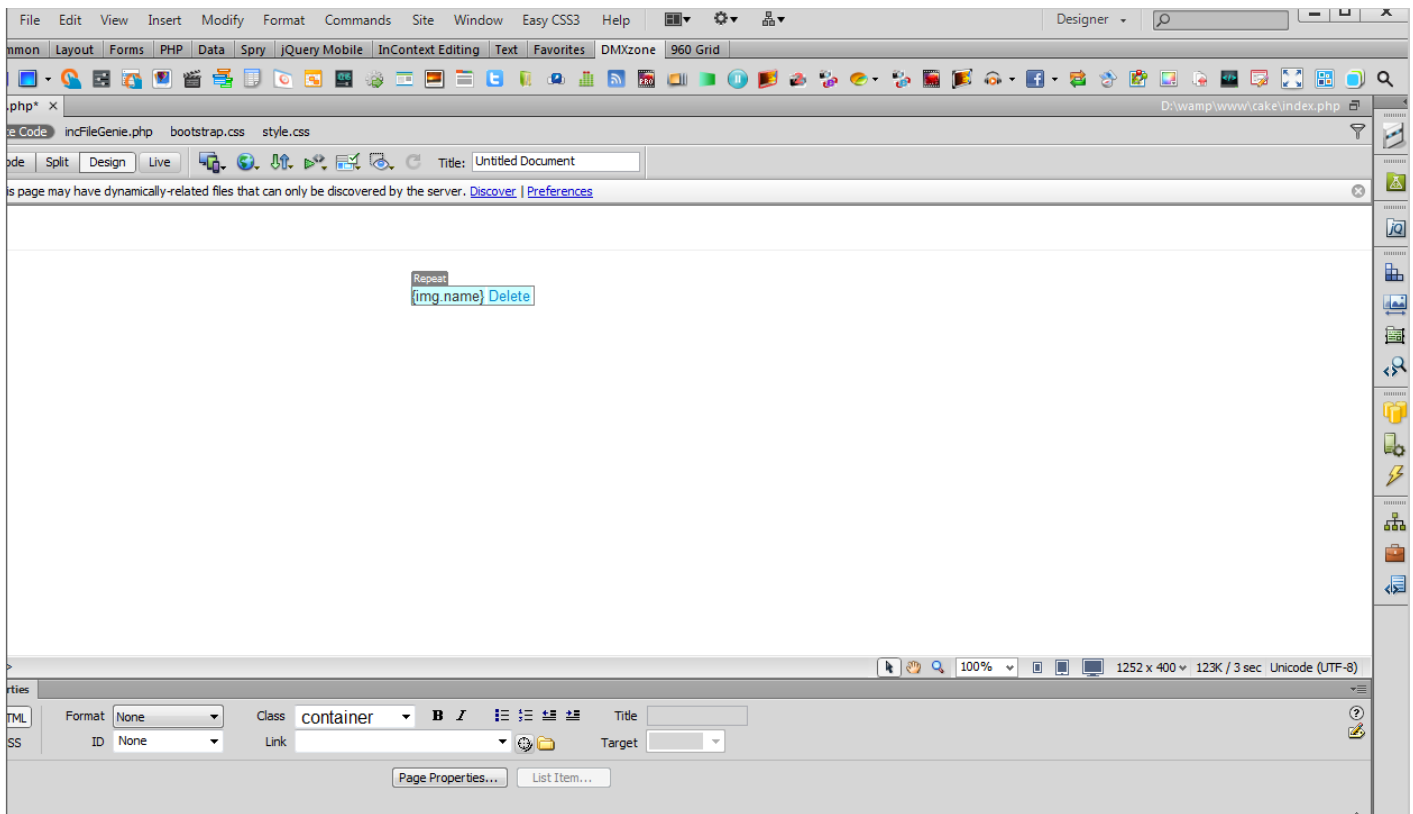
5. Select both the binding and the link. From the **Server Behaviors** menu (1), click the **Add item button** (2), select the **DMXzone Menu item** (3) and choose **File Genie** (4) **Folder List Repeater** menu item (5).



6. In the **Folder List Repeater** window, click **All Records** radio button.



7. Now you can save your work and preview the results in your browser.
